MAINSTREAM LEVEL EXPERIMENTAL

The lack of new experimental basics has led me to review a couple of really nice experimentals. CHECKMATE THE COLUMN and TRADE THE WAVE.

CHECKMATE THE COLUMN We first reported Checkmate in 1975. The figure has remained on St an Burdicks Pulse Poll for a long time and I feel as do our dancers that it really has a place in the Mainstream Plus Clubs. Easily mastered from all positions and the ending formation of a two face line lends itself to nice follow up calls such as Couples Circulate, Ferris Wheel, Cross Fire, Tag the lines etc.

THE STARTING ACTION FROM A COLUMN II suggest setting up from a 1P-2P line with a curlique or Touch 1/4. Have the lead two dancers in the column walk single file around the adjacent dancers and walk to the far end of the line and face IN. The Trailing Two Dancers NOW will walk ahead single file past the on coming two, then once past each other face right and as a pair step ahead to form the end of the two face line facing out. I urge the following teaching hint - Once the Trailing dancers have walked past the on-coming two and have faced to the right have themioin inside hands and step ahead together. When you get involved in all positions this will help as they won't walk out alone and transpose positions.

BASIC DANCING EXAMPLES

• 1P-2P Curlique - Checkmate the Column Boys cross run - girls trade Bend the line 1P-2P •1P-2P Touch 1/4 - Checkmate the Column Boys trade - boys cross run - girls trade Wheel & deal - pass thru - left alle.

•1P-2P Right & left thru-rollaway 1/2 sashay Touch 1/4 - Checkmate the Column Bend the line 1P-2P

TRADE THE WAVE With the Dixie Style becoming a popular Mainstream figure the Trade the Wave action which really fits into the Trade Family is a really handy basic as it takes the Left Hand wave set up by the Dixie Style and changes the dancers back into a normal wave right handed with the boys on the ends and the girls as centers.

THE ACTION OF TRADE THE WAVE.

From a Dixie Style (or any wave) have the dancers look at who is facing the same direction as they are. Now have them lean forward and "Peek" at the one facing the same wave. Next have them step thru the wave and trade places with the one facing the same way as they are and reform the wave. You can even clue the dancers a bit by saying Take A Peek Trade the Wave
