Last month we looked at material that moved the dancers from Box 1--4 to 1P2P. This month's material reverses the process.

I would like to point out that last month's material can also be used to move dancers from the Box 3--2 formation (heads star thru, pass thru; get-out with square thru 3/4, trade by) to a 2P1P formation (heads lead right, circle to a line, right and left thru; get-out with crosstrail thru). Likewise, this month's material will take dancers from 2P1P to Box 3--2.

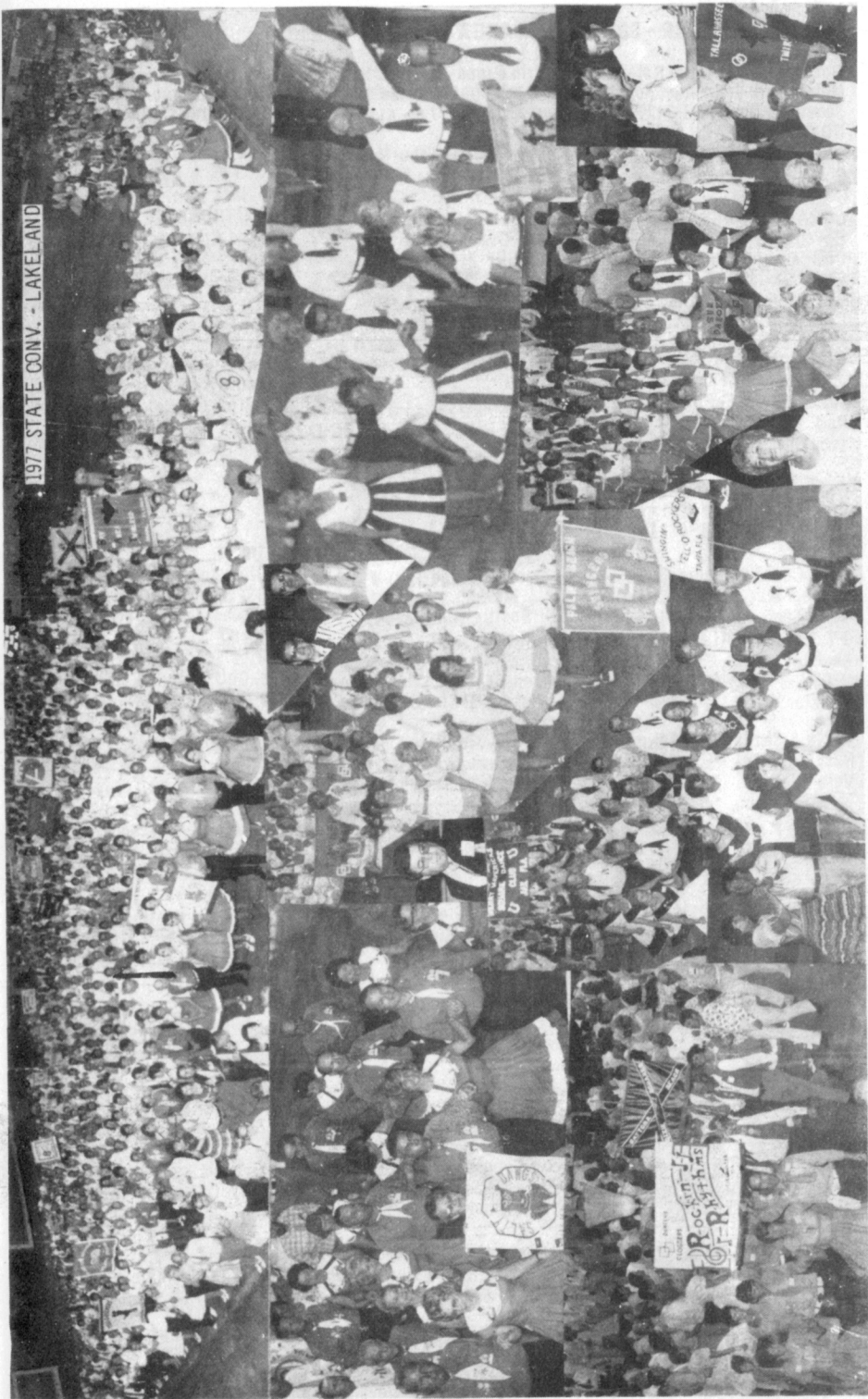

LEGACY (International Assembly of "Trustees" of the Square Dance Activity) With delegates coming from 36 states of the U.S., from two provinces of Canada and from Germany, the 1977 meeting of Legacy trustees was held at the Hyatt Regency Hotel, in Memphis, Tenn. May 5-8, 1977. The 200 trustees present represented square dancers, square dancer associations, caller associations, Callerlab, round dance teacher associations, National Square Dance Convention Executive Committee, square dance publications, square dance record companies, square dance suppliers and the various foundations and special interest groups that make up the Legacy involvement program. Legacy, which two years ago spawned the now active association of square round dance suppliers, this year witnessed the formation of the International Association of Round Dance Teachers. Considerable time during the four day meeting period was spent by the trustees in solution-oriented discussions and projecting plans for a smaller Legacy or mini-Legacy sessions around the world. The Legacy sessions, such as this one recently held in Memphis, are constructed largely to receive the input from square dance veterans with ten years or more experience in the field. The main purpose of a mini-Legacy is to bring leadership awareness training and communications into various square dance population centers.

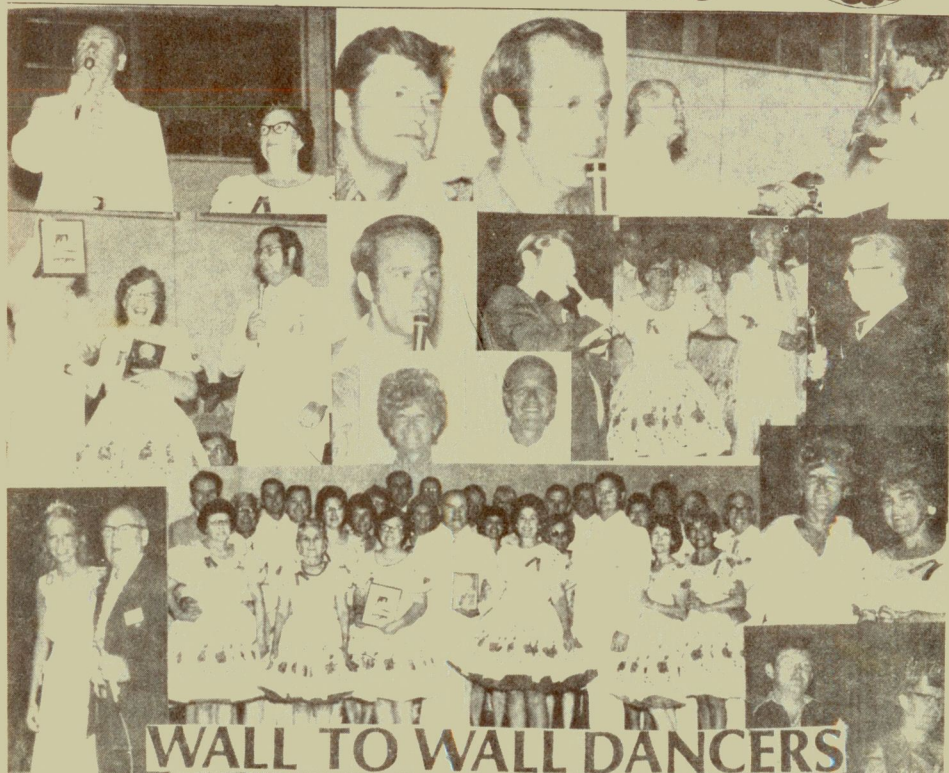
