They Made History On The Lawn

Three Valdostans literally danced their way into the White House grounds and Beb Bennett, his wife, Vivian, and their pretty blonde daughter, Debbie, termed the experience "Fantastic!"

"This tops it all," said Mrs. Bennett, who has danced in at least seven states and such unlikely places as the ocean, on a train, in a swimming pool, a boat, and at the mansion of the Governor of Georgia.

"It was unreal," said Debbie, 16. "I danced with the President of the United States. I couldn't believe it.

"He said something to me and I was so awed by it all I just mumbled something. He danced with me and then with mama."

At the same time, Bennett was swinging the First Lady on a wooden stage set up on the White House Lawn.

"Mrs. Carter asked her husband if he was going to dance and he said, 'No, I don't think so,' " recalled Bennett, "and she said, 'Well, I am. Come on Bob, let's dance.' And we did."

The three Bennetts were all smiles as they recounted their experience of July 20. They were part of a 48-square dance group from Georgia invited to dance on the White House lawn at a picnic arranged by the Carters for members of Congress and other dignitaries.

Bennett and Rod Blaylock of Albany were the callers. From all parts of the state the dancers gathered in Atlanta for the night-long bus trip to Washington.

They talked all night, the Bennetts said, and pulled in the nation's capitol about 10 a.m.

women the With all peach colored wearing dresses dance square with lace trimmed in dogwood blossoms painted on the skirts over voluminous ruffled petticoats and the men in peach colored vests,

the Georgians assembled at the White House well ahead of their scheduled time for dancing at 6:15 p.m.

"Nervous?" he repeated in answer to a question. "Well I would say a little.

"We were only part of the entertainment. There were the Redskins playing volley ball, a little choochoo train running around the back lawn, a fire truck for the kids to play on, a calliope with music just like a fair or a circus, and a young magician.

"There were also the Ralph Case Cloggers of Washington who put on a good show. Amy (Carter) got up there and clogged with them and that kid is good."

It was time to eat and the Georgians, along with everybody else paid \$3.50 each for hamburgers, hot dogs, baked beans, all from a cookstove set up in a tent, potato chips, relighes, pickles and tea.

Part of the fun of being there, said both Mr. and Mrs. Bennett was recognizing politicians and chatting with them.

"Tip O'Neil was standing right by me when we were eating and I said, 'This is good hamburger,' said Bennett.

"He said, 'It oughta be. We had to pay \$3.50 for it."

Before the dancing started, the President shook hands with all the Georgians and it was just prior to their second appearance after supper that the Carters decided to join in the fun.

"I guess I'm the only square dance caller in the world who's danced with a First Lady of the U.S. and I guess Debbie's the only teenage girl who's ever swung the

President in a square.

"The Carters hadn't danced in a long time but square dancing is like riding

a bicycle - once around the

block and it all comes back to vou."

The trip cost each of the dancers \$62.50 but it worth a million in memories. The group is planning an exclusive club with a picnic every year in July to reminisce about dancing at

the White House. It's a sure bet all of them will be wearing their special badge which reads, "First In History, White House Square Dance, By Invitation of President Jimmy Carter, Georgia Caravan of Dancers."

In spite of the fact that few of Debbie's friends at Valdosta High School participate in this form of dancing, she's completely sold on it, now more than ever.

"When I get married," she said, smiling, "I'm going to have a square dance at the wedding and Daddy's going to swing me off."

I've observed two interesting things while calling around the state during the past few months. One is that many dancers have trouble with Square Thru if they are half-sashayed when the call is given. The other thing is that many dancers have less trouble with a four boys or four girls Square Thru than with a half-sashayed Square Thru. This month's material uses Square Thru A. F. C.
