





ATTENTION CLUB OFFICERS AND OFFICERS WHO HIRE CALLERS FOR THEIR CLUBS It has been mentioned many times that Callers come into the clubs and often call basics that are not on the Callerlab Mainstream list, or introduce more experimental material then the club can absorb, or introduce many experimentals that are not Callerlab Quarterly selections. What is the solution! May I suggest the following . . . The club needs to establish its interest and experience plateau. This is done by working with the caller and dancer committee to determine if the club is using all the Callerlab Mainstream List of basics. If so, do you use them from the standard Positions only or from All Positions. Are all the Callerlab Quarterly experimentals used by the club. At this point lets say the above program fits your club and you enjoy an experimental tip as part of the evening program. May I suggest that you inform the guest callers that your club dancers enjoy a Callerlab Mainstream Dance based on Standard Positioning and we use the Callerlab Quarterly experimentals. Add this to the fact that you would like a workshop tip based on - (1) Callers choice of Experimental (2) A review of the present Quatter experimental from Callerlab (3) No Experimentals, just dancing. If the caller is informed of your wishes he should comply. What to do if he insists on flooding the dance with experimentals . . . I would inform the caller that he will no longer be invited to guest call for the club and any dates on the books are cancelled. Lots of clubs enjoy a plateau of dancing and experimenting with basics as part of their dance program. Let the caller know what you expect and for the most part he will come pretty close to your wishes. Callerlab is working to establish assitional plateaus above Mainstream We have a Mainstream plus one plateau and hope to establish a Plus Two plateau along with an Advanced Dancing and Basic Challenge plateau at the April Callerlab Convention. We hope clubs will begin to label themselves along with Callerlab guidelines so Callers and Dancers can enjoy their Square Dance Fun even more. Jack Lasry







MAINSTREAM PLUS WORKSHOPS - SET BACK 1,2,3,4 - RON SCHNEIDER, Bradenton, Fla. An interesting variation of the Chase or Drift Around type action with four possible ending formations that follow the Tag Endings. I like the action of this one, however it is a variation and only time will tell.

The action starts with lines facing out, our examples will be from normal positioning

Set Back 1 - The girls position will make a right about face as if starting to zoom.

The girls will start across the set but in Set Back 1 they will stop as they form a wave thru the center of the set. The boys will run right into the vacating adjacent position to end facing in. The ending formation is the 1/4 tag formation with the girls in the wave & the boys facing in.

Set Back 2 - The girls will start their zoom action and walk across the set as the boys run right to end in two parallel ocean waves, boys facing in and the girls fac-

ing out. The 1/2 tag type ending for Set Back 2. Set Back 3 - The dancers dance thru a set Back 2 then extend so the boys form a wave thru the center of the set while the girls end facing out. The 3/4 Tag ending Set Back 4 - End in a completed double pass thru formation. From the Set Back 3 ending the dancers extend which leaves the girls as leaders and boys as trailers in the completed double pass thru formation. Set Back 4 is the full tag ending

Needless to say each formation is arrived at with continous motion. I have included an exam-Dancing Set Back 1P-2P - Pass thru - Set Back 1 ple of each.
