



CALLERLAB - QUARTERLY MOVEMENT SELECTION FOR 1ST QTR 1977 - EXTEND. THE TAG - By Jimmy Davis - The present use of Extend The Tag is best descrided as the ability to move from one ocean wave formation to another ocean wave formation. All dancers in the ocean wave will step thru and form an ocean wave with the couples they are facing. If your extension leaves you facing out, then remain facing out. The action most common from a wave between two couples as in the formation set up by having the Heads Pass The Ocean. Also used after a fractional Tag the Line figure to extend into different formation.

GET ACQUAINTED EX AMPLES

Heads pass the ocean-extend (to a wave). Heads pass thru-around one to a line. Girls trade-recycle-pass to the center Pass thru-left all.

Pass thru - wheel & deal - girls swing thru Extend (to a wave) - scoot back Boys run - pass thru - bend the line

Heads square thru four-swing thru-boys run-Right & left thru-flutter wheel-crosstrail 1/2 Tag the line - balance - swing thru Left all.

Extend the tag - centers swing thru - turn thru Center in - cast off 3/4 - left all.

May I suggest that if you do decide to use Follow Your Neighbor that you acquaint your dancers with both Follow Your Neighbor and Follow Your Neighbor & Spread. The easiest formation to start with is a Box 1-4 then Curlique. Have your dancers do a few scoot backs then start your explination. Tell the Boys Facing in that they will step ahead and join right forearms for a 3/4 turn (castoff). Not Yet . . Girls will run to the right into adjacent dancers position and Roll, that is make a 1/4 turn to the right on a dime. They will end holding the same man they have by the right But with a left and be in a Left Hand Ocean Wave. Now lets all do it together. Boys turn 3/4 . . Girls run right & Roll Catch him by the left. The teach should be repeated when the Girls are facing in and the boys facing out.

FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR & SPREAD

The variation starts exactly the same as the basic, with the facing in dancers turning 3/4. After completing the 3/4 turn they will slide apart to allow the facing out dancers who were doing the run & roll part to enlarge the "loop" of their run & roll action to end squeezing in between the center dancers. You will end back in a normal right hand wave. The action is very smooth and the ending formation of a normal wave is easier to use then the left hand wave.





1 small can of pineapple chucks, drained.

1 stick butter or oleo; melted.

1 pkg. large yellow cake mix.

1 cup coconut

1 cup shopped nuts if desired.

Place in layers in a long oblong pan. Bake 350 35-40 minutes.

#### BLACK CHOCOLATE CAKE

Sift togetther

l cup sugar

l cup flour

cup cocoa tsp. salt

1 tsp. baking soda

Add:

1/3 up melted shortening

1 cup boiling water

1 egg thoroughly beaten

1 tap. vanilla.

Put in 8 x 8 pan and bake at 350 for 30/35 min. When cool cover with a thin vanilla icing.

POOR MAN'S FRUIT CAKE This is what they called Liberty Cake during World War I, as there were no eggs or milk used.

1 cup sugar

1 cup water l cup coffee

 $l^{\frac{1}{2}} - 2$  cups raisins

cup shortening, butter or eleo

tsp. cinnamon tsp. cloves

1 tsp. nutmeg

tsp. allspice BOIL all above together until thickened (about 15 min.) When cold

add the following well sifted.

2 cups flour, ½ tsp. salt, 1 tsp. baking soda, ½ tsp. baking powder. Bake at 350 for 45/50 min. You can add nuts, chopped dates, figs, memon or oragne peel etc. If you do, put them in first and boil with top ingredients. You can use either Bundt or Angel Food pan to bake it in.

CALLERLAB PRESS RELEASE In April 1976, Callerlab passed a resolution providing for the accreditation of all callers. The Callerlab committee, chaired by Bill Peters of San Jase, Ca., has now provided the administrative detail necessary for the implementation of the Accreditation program. The procedure is as follows: a callers desiring to be accredit ed, must first seek an application from the Executive Secretary of Callerlab by writing to John Kaltenthaler, Executive Sectretary, Callerlab, Pocono Pines, Pa. 18350. The caller then must obtain three acreditors in each of several categories to achieve a total of 20 points. Points are obtained in the following categories: General Calling Skills (teaching, timimg, music, diction, choreography and figure construction, command techniques, programming etc.), Maximun earnable points - 5: Specialty Calling Skills (One Night Stands 1 point), (Round Dancing 1 Point), (Contra Dancing - 1 point), (Advanced Dancing - 1 point): Training & Experience Points awarded based upon the training of the individual as well as as the length of time actively calling (actively calling means an average of once a week 52 times per year and does allow for summers, natural disasters when the caller must temporarily skip some weeks) Maximum earnable points provide for 1 point for successful completion of an appropriate caller training program and 3 points per year of active calling not to exceed 15 points for experience. The signatures of three accreditors are required in each category except the Training category. Currently only Callerlab members may act as accreditors and no individual may accredit a caller who has accredited him (or her). There is a small administrative fee associated with the certificate of accreditation - \$15.00. The method of peer accreditation should have widespread appeal to all caller. We should point out that all current members of Callerlab must also pass the same Accreditation Procedure in order to remain active members of Callerlab. There was no ''grandfather clause'' in the resolution. The accreditation procedure is not limited to Callerlab members but rather is for all callers everywhere. Forms for accreditation are available now by writing the Callerlab office.
