



NATIONAL ROUND DANCE BOARD OF REVIEW (continued from last month) To help provide a type of guidance program, twenty-five highly qualified and experienced couples have pledged to work together to offer assistance to the round dance movement as a whole. This group have been named "National Round Dance Board Of Review". The goal of the board is to study all aveunues of the round dance activity and set standards to help all phases of round dancing, such as: (1) Establish what constitutes the easy or 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th levels of round dancing and help set up standards for teaching for each (2) Provide a reference manual which may be used by all teachers and dancers. (3) Establish standards for cueing basics. (4) Set up teacher classification guidelines to help teachers understand the knowledge and training necessary for the various levels of dance teaching. (5) Assist choreographers to improve their cue sheets (6) Dance publications will cover information pertaining to the items evaluated by the Board. Many couples who are qualified are not included in the present Board, as it is impossible to include all leaders in the first Board, and it is intended that others will be added as membership is rotated. Included in this Board are two couples from Florida; Frank & Iris Gilbert, Largo and Jim & Norma Trulock Winter Park.



IN MEMORY OF JOE MIESZALSKI

President of Southeast Square & Round Dance Association

Joe passed away Tuesday, April 12th, after four months stay in the hospital due to Cancer. Joe was also a delegate to the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, a member of the

Palm Swingers Club, and a member of the Southeast Stars Exhibition Group.

Joe and Ann graduated from Frank Bedell's square dance cless in Dec. 1970 and there was no holding them back after that. They danced all over Broward and Palm Beach Counties, visiting other clubs and soon became well known by many dancers in those areas. Because of this they were asked to be delegates to Southeast Assn. & Joe good-naturedly took a lot of kidding when he was introduced as Joe "Smith" because people couldn't pronounce his name. In the beginning Joe (normally a very quiet man) didn't have too much to say & would sit quietly and listen when others discussed the politics of square dancing. he went to the National Convention at Salt Lake City and attended meetings, forums and workshops and really became enthused about pushing square dancing more and working for if to try to give others some of the enjoyment he got out of it. All of a sudden he became of age, politically, and declared that he wasn't going to just sit back and say nothing anymore, that he was going to speak up also when he had an idea or felt things were not being done the right way. Joe and Ann worked hard, going from delegate on up the ladder from Secretary, Treasurer, Vice President and to President. By this time Joe had been fighting a battle with Cancer for a couple of years or more, but was determined to do all he could for S/Ding right up to the last. During his stay in the hospital he would tell all who would listen about the wonders of square dancing and try to recruit the nurses into getting involved in it.

At times he was in a great deal of pain you could ask Joe how he felt and he would just give that big grin of his and say "fine". One such time was at the Knothead Konvention last year when the Southeast Stars were lining up backstage for their performance. looked like he was in a lot of pain and someone suggested that he sit down till it was time to start. His answer was that if he got down he would never get up because of his hip and leg were bothering him so. He was proud to be part of the group and he went out and performed beautifully, smiling all the time. As recently as three weeks before his death, Joe expressed the wish to at least get strong enough to perform in the Stars again, reven if he couldn't square dance as much as he used to. He also requested that Ann finish out his term of President if he was unable to and he felt she would be capable of doing it for him Joe was a worker when it came to putting the 4 W's together. He was always one of the

first there and the last to leave, usually taking stacks of papers to deliver up the I road to

Joe was sothankfullfor square dancing and all the friends and enjoyment it had brought him and the chance to travel and see other parts of the country that he would not have seen

Joe in a lot of ways was a simple and uncomplicated man and one of his recent requests of Ann was that his funeral services be simple with a square dancer friend saying a prayer. His services were simple, but eloquent, with the eulogy being delivered in part by his oldest son, Joey, a square dancers friend, Len Levitt, and caller friend, Tom Trainor, ending with a prayer.

We will all miss Joe's quiet smile and hard work in behalf of square dancing and our

sympathy goes out to Ann and her family.



MORE ABOUT CALLERLAB QUARTERLY MAINSTREAM EXPERIMENTAL 🛩 CROSSFIRE . . RON SCHNEIDER

The experimental Crossfire seems like the best choice of the available experimentals when considering the Mainstream Dancer. The action can easily be mastered and the ability to use the figure from all positions is there but certainly not necessary for all our dancers. The action starts from a Two Face Line. The Teach is important so establish that the ends will Cross Fold (this is the same as a recycle ending for the ends) after the ends have completed the cross fold then teach the centers their part. The centers will trade then extend (step ahead) to join right hands with the awaiting dancer. Have the dancers walk the action two or three times seperately then both starting their action at the same time. Easily mastered. From parallel two face lines you end in columns and from end to end two face lines you end in parallel ocean waves. NOTE It is important for the dancers to establish the two face line and the end of any action such as couples circulate or coordinate. The centers of the line should join right hands to establish the two face line formation. This will assist their reaction to the crossfire.

BASIC EXAMPLES . . FROM PARALLEL TWO FACE LINES . . BOYS AS ENDS, GIRLS AS CENTERS

- Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run Crossfire - trade & roll Right & left thru-flutterwheel Slide thru-left alle. zero Box 1-4
- Box 1-4 Swing thru boys trade boys run Crossfire - 8 circulate - boys run Do sa doe to a wave-girls trade-recycle-veer L-Couples circulate - Crossfire 8 circulate - boys run - do sa doe to a wave Recycle - left alle. sd Box 1-4

•1P-2P Curlique - coordinate - couple circulate Crossfire - girls run - pass thru - grand right & left

Examples starting from normal two face lines end to end

-1P-2P Swing thru-boys run-Crossfire Split circulate - boys run - crosstrail -Left alle.

•1P-2P Swing thru - boys run - Crossfire Walk & dodge - chase right - boys run. Left alle. zero 1p2p

Examples with Girls as ends and Boys as centers of two face lines •Box 1-4 Swing thru • boys run • tag the line right

•Box 1-4 Do sa doe to a wave - girls run Crossfire - boys run - left alle.

Crossfire - boys run - do sa doe to wave Recycle-pass to the center-square thru 3/4-left alle.

-1P-2P Touch 1/4 - coordinate Tag the line right - Crossfire Boys run - dive thru Square thru 3/4 - left alle.

Crossfire works quite well, the dancers will like it but it will remain to be seen if it has the quality to pass the test of time.



Challenging Mainstream

Another CALLERLEB Convention is behind us and several important resolutions were considered. Of these, perhaps the most important were those concerning

Level Identification.

As you know, last year CALLERLAB established a Mainstream Plus plateau of dancing. Following a minor revision, this plateau was given permanent endorsement as the Mainstream Plus One Program. In addition, a Mainstream Plus Two Program consisting of twelve movements was established. (If you would like a copy of these programs, write me and I'll be glad to send you a list of calls involved.)

Beyond these levels, CALLERLAB has endorsed the existing lists of basics for three additional levels: Advanced Dancing, Challenge Dancing, and Extended Challenge Dancing. It is hoped that clubs and weekend festivals will use these

terms only to indicate dancing involving the movements on these lists.

The Quarterly Movements list was reviewed and all but one movement was retained. Half, Tag, Trade & Roll was dropped as a movement, but the concept was kept as a combination of calls involving Roll. Roll was retained only in such combinations as result in facing the person the previous call was done with, e.g., Trade & Roll, Touch & Roll, etc. Two movements (Recycle and Coordinate) will be referred to the Mainstream Committee next year. (I would appreciate hearing from dancers and callers as to whether you feel these should be included on the Mainstream List.)

Split Circulate was added to the Circulate Family in the Mainstream Program An important project now underway is a clarification of definitions for the Mainstream Basics. Nearly half of these movements have been published in more

than one form.


