MAINSTREAM EXPERIMENTALS TRACK | Dick Bayer, Michigan

Track I was born in controversy and somewhat lost in the shuffle with the popularity of Track II. I feel that the absence of worthwhile Mainstream material for experimental workshops that Track I is worthy of your giving it another look. The action starts from the completed Double Pass Thru Formation. Teaching the Tracks I use the tandum partner trade method, that is to have the trailing boy place his hand on the shoulder of the lead boy and the trailing girl so the same to the lead girl. Locked together in a tandum formation you do a partner trade which brings us back to a double pass thru formation. For a Track I the lead couple will step into an ocean wave. The set is then in the 1/4 tag formation and certain popular calls such as Ping Pong Circulate, Chain Reaction can be called.

NOTE: If your starting set up is 1P-2P lines, Pass thru - Wheel & deal, Double pass thru, Track I, you are in the same set up as calling from a 1P-2P line, pass thru, wheel & deal,

centers step to a wave.


