NATIONAL ROUND DANCE BOARD OF REVIEW In the middle 1940's ideas were born to

NATIONAL ROUND DANCE BOARD OF REVIEW In the middle 1940's ideas were born to use some of the dance steps and figures from folk, ballroom and square dancing to create line or folk type dance patterns and/or mixers. A little latter Dr. Lloyd (Pappy) Shaw began to see the potential of this new form of dancing and introduced his ''The Round Dance Book'' in 1948, which was followed by publications promoting basic standardization by Ginger Osgood and ''Doc'' Alumbaugh. Also, the expertise of Frank & Carolyn Hamilton, Manning and Nita Smith, plus many others who traveled around the country conducting clinics and workshops, brought round dancing through many years of beginning struggles. In the late 1950's Latins were introduced to round dancing and again more struggles and problems, which always happens as we progress forward. Change is the only thing we can be sure of. We must always strive to assure the change is forward. As we progress and larger participation developes, certain organizational functions should be developed; otherwise, some go one way and others another. In developing unity by organizational efforts, it is logial that we can move together in the same direction, benefitting everyone, and the round dance movement will continue to grow more mature. Any program must include constant attention to all phases, not just the bottom or the top. Like a plant, the root needs as much attention as the stem or truck and the flowering top and vice versa. Therfore, a successful round dance activity needs all sectors functioning equally well in a unified mannor to acheive complete enjoyment for all dancers. (Continued next month)

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP... EASY MAINSTREAM.. Relaxed Dancing
STAR THE ROUTE - DON WILLIAMSON, TENN.

Don asked that the term Route is pronounced as a rhyme with out, not root. To start the action the command Heads Right Hand Star The Route will get them started. The heads will right hand star 3/4 to meet the couple on their right with a Left hand star one full turn. Heads will meet back in the center of the set to star right 1/2 way to meet the other sides with a left hand star one full turn. Heads meet in the center for a right hand 3/4 star back to home o't to the corner for a left alle. The action times out at 32 beats so if it fits the singing call breaks nicely. For the relaxed level dancers or for a break in the 'thinking hard'' portions of our dance this will give your dancers the feeling of "really dancing" A minimum of patter, only cues will add to the flavor. GIVE IT A TRY...

MAINSTREAM WORKSHOP LEVEL

STRETCH RECYCLE . . RON SCHNEIDER . . Fla.

The idea to "Stretch" your recycle is really nice one that your mainstream dancers will find easy to learn as they are not really learning a new figure but using what they already know in a different manner. Lets start with a get acquainted set up. . as the figure can be used from two basic formations. Heads pass the ocean . This sets up the $1/4\,$ tag formation of the wave thru the center of the facing in couples. The STRETCH RECYCLE is aime at the dancers in the ocean wave who will do a recycle but extend or street the size of the action to end behind the couples facing in. The outside couples can step forward into the center to keep the stretch from getting to far. I suggest using this get acquainted with the stretch idea a couple of times then move to the two parallel ocean waves set up where Stretch Recycle will have the set up in a double pass thru formation. The end dancers facing out of the set along with the adjacent dancers will do normal recycle while the others, the ends of the wave facing in and their adjacent dancers will do the Stretch recycle to end in the far center position. Somewhat in a ferris wheel type ending. Note It is important that the dancers properly execute the recycle action. If the girls or centers of the wave are being "dragged" into position the figure is going to be un popular but if the center of the wave dance their action as a turn and follow the ends of the wave then the figure Really is nice.

Heads pass the ocean - Stretch Recycle Centers pass thru - swing thru - Turn thru - left alle.

IP-2P Pass thru-Wheel & deal Centers do sa doe to a wave-Stretch Recycle Double pass thru-cloverleaf Centers square thru 3/4-left alle.

Heads pass the ocean - Ping Pong Circulate
Stretch Recycle - Double pass thru
Cloverleaf - Centers swing thru - turn thru - left alle.
