Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami



VIEWPOINT: Attention to all who enjoy writing your own choreography, I have accepted the position as Workshop editor for Square Dancing and we are looking for good smooth material to be published in the workshop section. Please submit your dances to Ken Kernen, 464 N. Robertson Blvd., Los Angeles, Ca. 90048. Please place a label on each dance to let me know the following information. Is the dance made up of mainstream basics or quarterly experimentals or experimentals, is the dance standard position or A.P.D.? Let me know if one figure is central theme so we can feature 'scoot back' dances on a single page.

THE ALL POSITIONS CONCEPT has created alot of conversation. In reality it is nothing new, years ago we called it position dancing. How does it fit into your dance program? A.P.D. is not necessary for a successful dance program. Most dancers like dancing the role they really are, A Man or a Lady. If your program is made up of dancers who attend twice a month and thats all the square dancing they have time for then a heavy A.P.D. program will be very difficult for them. If you have a group who like to try unusual formations and situations then the All Position Dance can provide you and the dancer with lots of Challenge. The big question is to what extent should A.P.D. be part of the beginners program. The Callerlab program calls for a 41 week lesson program, If you can run 41 weeks then there is time to develop a basic understanding of A.P.D. If you try to complete the Callerlab program in 30 weeks then there is no time available for A.P.D. Lets face it to do it right it takes 40 weeks to cover the program we call Mainstream. Don't have 40 wks. then why not stop at the extended level and form a club for them. A.P.D. means that you will accept 1/2 sashayed positioning for many couples figures as well as reaction to four boys or four girls in action. With Mainstream Dancers my feelings are that A.P.D. can be used very sparingly but can add a bit of 'spice' to the program. Like spice it goes along way.

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP - MAINSTREAM PLUS LEVEL

'ANYTHING' EXPLOSION - Several Callers

The evolution of this call is interesting, the call is in two parts, the 'anything' is any figure or combination of calls that end in a column, and the explosion follows. The explosion action from a standard column is as follows. The lead dancer, a girl in the normal column will stand pat, the boy who is second in the column will step up to the outside in front to form a couple, the third person a girl will step ahead and trade with the girl from the other column, the last position a boy in the column will step out to the outside of the girl in front of him. Now the action continues with the two face line in the center extending as the lead couple does a couples trade or wheel across to end with the set in parallel two face lines. The explosion action is the same as 'solar' circulate which was an experimental idea about a year ago that was lost in the shuffle. I feel it is the combination of the two calls that seems to have caught the dancers fancy. They are still getting two distinct calls but they are tied together with good flow and comfortable dancing. Calls that can set up the column are Ah So, Cross Fire, Curlique, 1/2 Tag the Line, Touch 1/4. Why explosion not solar circulate?? I'm thinking that the action follows another so closely yet has an element of surprise with the variety of ways to set up the column has as much to do with it as any. Try it and see what your dancers think.

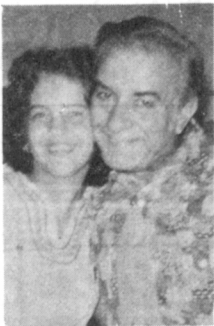

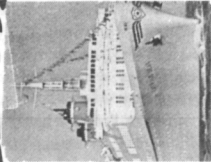

THE Challenging Mainstream

What to do after an 8 Chain Thru? Actually there are plenty of things to be done after an 8 Chain 2, 4, 6 or 8 for we have facing couples with right hands free. 8Chain 1 happens so fast there's little time to say much other than Left Allemande. But what about 8 Chain 3, 5 and 7? Here are some possibilities.

If the appropriate CALLERLAB approved terminology could be specified in his contract, a caller would have a quite good idea of what to expect on a given night. This would permit advanced planning of material he would like to feature as well as the selection of an appropriate workshop figure. And who benefits from this advanced planning? The dancers who get a dance tailored to their level of dancing.
