



LEGACY REPORT The age-pld problem of competition in square dancing was met head on at the recent Legacy biannual meeting in Memphis, Tenn. As a result of much serious consideration the following resolution was passed. "Be it resolved that Legacy go on record as being opposed to contests that pit dancer against dancer or caller against caller. Legacy endorses the concept that square dancing is a cooperative and not a competitive activity". Among other noteworthy accomplishments at the recent meeting was a resolution to encourage support of all youth groups who wish to engage in square dance activities. Legacy went on record as recognizing the good work of Central Registry of World Dancers (CROWD) organization and encouraged public support of this group by square dancers everywhere. 

FIRST NATIONAL ROUND DANCE CONVENTION brought together for the first time in the history of round dancing the largest assembly of highly experienced and knowledgeable round dance teachers on staff, who presented a full program of rounds from the intermediate through the very latest challenge dances. This highly successful convention was attended by 658 dancers (329 couples), who have unanimously expressed their pleasure and satisfaction in the program presented. The response was so exuberant that arrangements were completed to hold the 2nd National Round Dance Convention in Kansas City July 20,21,22, 1978. A third ballroom in the Muehlebach Hotel has been added for 1978 to allow expansion of the entire program. As soon as the announcement for the 2nd National was made over 200 dancers immediately registered. The completely air-conditioned ballrooms were superb. The sound left nothing to be desired. This staff of some 70 teacher couples, together with other dancer couples, provided a smooth, well organized affair. The National Carousels are to be commended for spearheading and doing a great job on this First National Round Dance Convention. One of the exciting developments at the convention was the formation of a new teacher-dancer organization to be called Universal Round Dance Council. This is the culmination of a concept that was originated in October 1976 and was confirmed at the Teachers Seminar July 27,1977, by an overwhelming vote of 149 to 3. A membership of \$8.00 per year was established and includes the monthly news report. Two hundred and thirty-eight teachers and dancers joined before the convention ended. It can be seen from this that the organization is well on its way to do the job that has been needed for so long in all phases of round dancing. The Trail's End Dance on Wed. evening July 27, was sponsored by several Kansas City area teachers, with Vernon & Mary Tobaben (Carousel Club No. 38) as chairmen. A great party was provided in a ballroom just one block from the Muehlebach Hotel and was attended by 173 dancer and teacher couples. The income from this party was \$692 with \$433.50 expenses for rental, printing, etc. The balance of \$258.50 has been turned over to the Universal Round Dance Council to help pay the expenses covering the 1978 National Round Dance Convention. The Trail's End Dance for next year will be held in the Imperial Ballroom of the Muehlebach Hotel. A full accounting of the income and expenses of the First National Round Dance Convention will be released for publication as quickly as all the details have been completed. 



No additions or deletions were made to the Callerlab Mainstream List. The "Mainstream Plus" list was discontinued and two (2) new Plateaus were created: "Mainstream Plus One" and "Mainstream Plus 2". The "Plus One Plateau" is the new name for what we previously identified as "Mainstream Plus", except that RED HOT and GRAND PARADE have been deleted and that any command on the current Experimentals List could also be called at a "Plus One Plateau" Dance.

THE PLUS PLATEAU Dancers should be very comfortable dancing at the Mainstream level and be familiar with all the quarterly selections prior to getting involved in a workshop to reach the "Plus Plateau" Groups.

Knit Cape

2 4oz. Keins of Knitting Worsted (4 ply)
2 long size 10 needles on one 20" (circular needle. (I use an 8 because I find it fits my knitting better.)

Cast on 72 stitches.

ALWAYS knit first 6 and last 6 stitches.

Row 1: K 6, then ~~inc.~~ inc. in next st. (place marker) K 1, inc. in next st.
K 4, inc. in next st. (place marker) K 1, inc. in next st.
K 18, inc. in next st (place marker) K 1, inc. in next st.
K 4, inc. in next st (place marker) K 1, inc. in next st.
K 11, then K 6 sts. (80 sts. on needle)

Row 2: K 6, Purl back every other row now, Knit 6

Row 3: On this and all other knit rows, knit to within 1 st. of marker, inc. in this st. and slip marker, K. 1, inc. in next st. Work to next marker and repeat across.

Continue to increase in every other row until there are 208 stitches on needle. On purl row now add 2 sts. to make 210 sts.
Now, pattern as follows with right side towards you.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K 2 tog. 3 times; *Yarn over and K 1 for 6 times, K 2 tog. 6 times. Repeat from * across row and end Y.O. and K 1 for 6 times, K 2 tog. 3 times and then the usual Knit 6 for edge. (be sure and K.6 at beginning of row)

Row 4: Knit

These 4 rows make pattern. Continue in pattern 6 or 8 inches, or desired length (12 sets of pattern - 4 rows each.) Knit garter st. for 2 inches and bind off.

Pick up 56 sts. around neck and knit 1 row, purl 1 row for one inch. Then, purl 1 row, knit 1 row for 1 inch. Bind off, fold over and sew down.

Following is a variation if you wish to start at the top and make the fold-over first. You cast on 56 stitches. Purl 1 row and K 1 row for one inch. Knit 1 row and P 1 row now for one inch. This folds over and makes the collar - or necklin

Knit first and last 6 stitches on every row and now: K 6, inc. in next st, K 1 (*Inc., 2) repeat from * across row to end in Inc. K 1 inc., Knit 6. (72 Sts. on needle)

Now you can start as above from *** and continue.

Note: if a larger cape is desired, knit to 224 Sts. on needle and on purl row increase 4 sts. to make 228 sts. on needle and then do the pattern.

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami



FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR - FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR & SPREAD

These two calls are not new calls, in fact they have also been placed into a Plus level of dancing. The figures have been very popular in many areas of the country with experienced Mainstream dancers so I feel it is time to explore the figure across the nation and find out if it is really a Mainstream call, or if it proves out that it belongs in a plus grouping. Note that the variation has been more popular than the root call because it ends back into normal waves. I find also that relating the figure to Scoot Back helps the dancers accept the action.

BASIC TEACHING POSITION . . Box 1+4 . . Touch 1/4 An ocean wave, with boys facing in and girls girls facing out.

THE ACTION OF FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR Boys will step forward and meet with right hands and turn 3/4 (cast of 3/4) to end as centers of a left hand ocean wave. Girls will run right into the vacating adjacent position then 1/4 right face turn (roll) to end as the ends of the left hand wave. Note the original adjacent dancers in the right hand wave with boys facing in and girls facing out will end up holding left hands.

THE ACTION OF FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR & SPREAD is very much the same but the boys after completing the 3/4 turn will spread apart to allow the girls who are running right and rolling to make this action into a little larger loop to end between the boys forming a normal right hand wave. The girls will end joining right hands with the same adjacent boy. You will find the figure smooth and one that can be used A.P.D. (all position) with very little problems.

The greatest beneficiary of the CALLERLAB Level Identification System will be the individual dancer. Once this system is fully implemented and a dancer has learned his level of dancing competence, he will be able to attend festivals and visit clubs anywhere in the country and know that he will be dancing the level he enjoys. No longer will a dancer attend an "intermediate" club and find that this term equals Mainstream in one area and Plus II in another area. And whose responsibility is it to educate the dancer? The primary responsibility must lay with the caller, and this education should begin in class. Club officers and other dancer leaders should assist the caller with this educational process---not just in classes, but with club members as well.


