Chris recorded on 'Top & Scope' & had written for other recording companies MacGregor, Malinda, Sets & Orders, Windsor and most recent with F.T.C. Label. Fred belonged to the Florida Caller's Association, South California Caller's Association and a past member of the Suncoast Caller's Association. His word to other callers was - - - -

"KEEP 'EM SMILING", "KEEP 'EM DANCING"

IN MEMORIAM

Jay King was born in New York City, September 16, 1921. Served in W.W. 2, Army Air Corps, 5 years, as First Lieutenant. Married Ann (Cuneo) April 13, 1945. Jay is survived by wife Ann and four children; Nancy, Margaret and Tom King and Susan Vinhosa.

Jay started square dancing, Eastern Style, in high school. He and Ann learned Western square dancing from Dick Steele in 1960. They learned quickly and advanced through their classes. Jay then became interested in calling. Once he had mastered the fundamentals of dancing he became a freelance caller, 1962, and then formed a square dance club, the Straight Eights of Bedford. He also called for the Seaside Steppers and Westford Ho's. He recorded for McGregor Records in the mid-60's. He pursued his interest in choreography as he had the opportunity to submit articles to square dance magazines. He felt that there was a need for manuals training callers and diagramming movements. This is when he began writing his books on how to train callers. His first book, "How To Teach Modern Square Dancing" was written in 1965, followed by THE FUNDAMENTALS OF HASH CALLING in 1968. His monthly notes for callers were called "Hashing it Over" and he began publishing them in 1967. He called for dances in New England States, New York, and New Jersey. He was on the staff of caller's clinics in New York, Arkansas, Virginia, Kentucky, and throughout New England. Jay's final book, for callers and dancers is, THE SQUARE DANCER'S DICTIONARY.

The square dance fraternity will sorely miss him and extends sympathy to the King family in their loss.

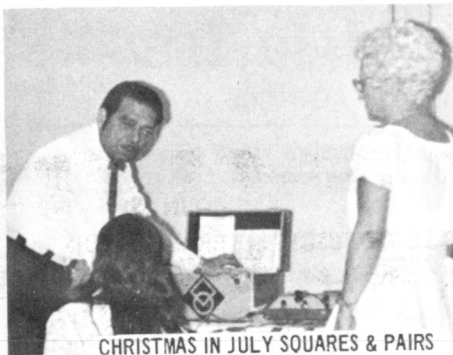

A major project of CALLERLAB has been the development of a standardized system of square dance level identification. It is hoped that the CALLERLAB terms (Mainstream, Mainstream Plus 1 & 2, Advanced, Challenge, and Extended Challenge) will be used to identify dance levels at festivals, conventions, and clubs throughout the world. A number of dancers and callers are not yet familiar with this new system and how it can benefit the square dance activity. During the coming months I will be commenting on the system from time to time. Why does CALLERLAB consider level identification so important? How will it benefit callers, dancers and clubs?

If you have questions or concerns about level identification, please send me a note so I can respond to your questions. All frequently asked questions will be discussed in this column.

WALK & DODGE is a popular Mainstream action that can be easily used from columns. The normal 1P-2P line followed by a curlique sets up a basic column from which a Walk & Dodge is the same Boy Walk and Girl Dodge that our dancers are used to. The column formation can cause some hesitation for some dancers so I find it best to "lead" them into the action, by saying "each group Walk & Dodge" or same four Walk & Dodge, or "in your own box Walk & Dodge" or Do-a Normal Walk & Dodge, Boys Walk, Girls Dodge. Once the action is again recognized you are home free.

1P-2P to Left Alle.

Touch 1/4 - each group - Walk & Dodge
Centers square thru 3/4
Centers in castoff 3/4
Star thru - centers pass thru
Swing thru - turn thru - left all.

1P-2P to Corner

Touch 1/4 - Walk & Dodge
Trade by - swing thru
Turn thru - left alle.

DANCING MAINSTREAM

1P-2P to Grand Right & Left
Heads spin the top - turn thru
Circle to a line - 1P-2P
Spin the top - boys run
Ferris Wheel - centers pass thru
Box the gnat - grand right & left

1P-2P to Box 1-4

1P-2P Right & left thru - heads only
rollaway 1/2 sashay
Touch 1/4 - 8 circulate
Trade & roll - star thru
Centers pass thru - left alle. Box 1-4

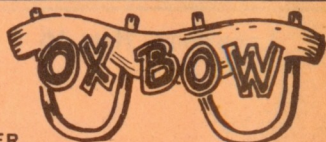
