Love of square dancing developed into business

The petticoats — full of ruffles, ruffles and more ruffles — lay in soft stacks in the little shop. The layers of thin flounces shine in a rainbow of shades ranging from unusual pastels such as coral, daffodil and aquamarine to strong, deep red, gold and blue.

Made with up to 100 yards of material, these fancy underskirts have but one purpose — to make a dress stand out during a square dance.

Both the do-si-doe perfect dresses and petticoats are designed by square dance lover Bea Rae at Chez Bea Creations, 650 NE 128th St.

"I like to twirl an awful lot," says the 65-year-old woman as she spins rapidly. "I like to twirl, twirl, twirl." As she turns, a bright crimson crinoline peeks from beneath her red and white polka dot dress.

She estimates that she has made 12,000 pieces of finery during the past 17 years. She has even taught her 78-year-old bookkeeper husband, Richard, how to run the speeding, rufflemaking sewing machine where the needle blurs while whirring out yards and yards of ruffles in minutes.

But this business will end soon.

"I'm crowding the 80 mark," Rae says. "We're in the process of selling out. We'll be gone by fall."

"We went into this business because we had heart and soul into square dancing," he explains.

His wife will stop taking orders April 17, but she hopes to train someone to replace her.

She never studied sewing. One of 12 children, she practiced on her younger sister but she wouldn't let them wear the home-made outfits to school. "I used to dye white flour sacks and trim them with rick rack," she said.

Mrs. Rae sews in her own special way. For example, she doesn't measure anyone with a tape. Instead she makes a vest then tucks that with pins to indicate measurements. She makes all of her own patterns and cuts every dress, though five girls help her part-time.

A dress takes from two days to two weeks to make. Dresses start at \$32.95, she says. Petticoats are sold separately by the yard — the smallest in the shop is a full 30-yarder — the widest is a 100-yarder which sells for about \$45.

Although the dresses vary in pattern and color, the styles have one thing in common — ruffles — at the hem or the sleeve, or running the length of the outfit.

Mrs. Rae has rules about her designs. She refuses to make a short dress or petticoat.

"They want to wear them like tutus but that's not the style. Even if I lose a \$100 sale, I wouldn't make them shorter than the middle of the knee," she said.

She made her first square dance dress for herself in 1956. Three years later, her husband who had retired as a furrier, coaxed her to sew dresses to sell.

"So many dresses I have in my mind to design," she laments. "I hate to get out of it." But then she explains they are getting older — but not old enough to stop dancing.

"I just love dancing," she said.

"It's the best thing to keep a couple closer together. We don't change partners except to swing."

She's seen retirees, she says, "who start square dancing when they're 78. They come down here, they're retired but they dance every day."

The Raes say they dance three times a week, though Mrs. Rae acknowledges that her husband sometimes tires "because of his heart."

"I will always dance," she laughs, "even if I have to bring him a wheel chair and he can watch me."

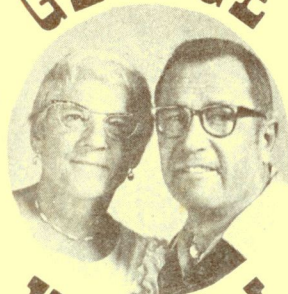

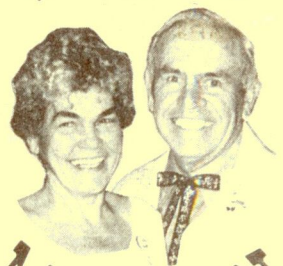

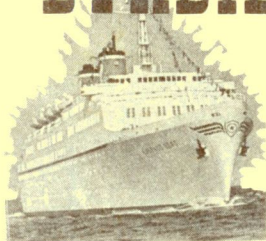
