In Mainstream dancing, 1/2 Tag the Line is used primarily from parallel two-faced lines. This month's material will use this basic from 1) back-to-back lines of four (which will result in parallel ocean waves) and from 2) end-to-end two-faced lines (which will produce columns).

## PLUS PLATEAU EXPERIMENTAL..

### SHAKE DOWN.....Lee Kopman

Shakedown falls into the Chase Family Figures as the action starts with couples back to back...The Dancers start a chase type action but stop as the rotation brings them 1/4 of the way around then 1/4 turn to face the couple who were behind them. From lines facing out you end in an 8 chain thru set up 1/2 sashayed...The action is short and flowing, easily mastered and is easily adapted to the A.P.D. concept. If you start from the trade by set up you will end in lines facing.....

## TRADE THE WAVE & ROLL.

The term ROLL as an extension to Trade The Wave flows nicely and the ending formation of a double pass thru set up is easily used... Place the dancers into a Dixie Style Wave and suggest they feel the flow of a trade the wave by calling a few simple combinations then review the fact that a roll implies that you complete the action of the root call then make a 1/4 turn in the direction of body flow....

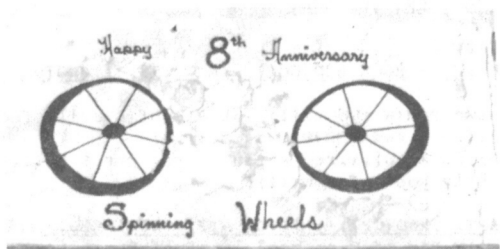

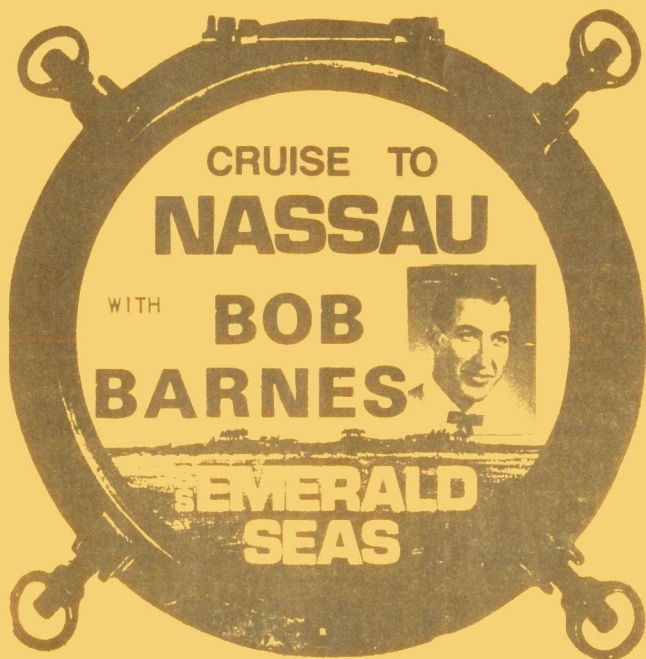
