In Mainstream dancing, 1/2 Tag the Line is used primarily from parallel two-faced lines. This month's material will use this basic from 1) back-to-back lines of four (which will result in parallel ocean waves) and from 2) end-to-end two-faced lines (which will produce columns).

Shakedown falls into the Chase Family Figures as the action starts with couples back to back....The Dancers start a chase type action but stop as the rotation brings them 1/4 of the way around then 1/4 turn to face the couple who were behind them. From lines facing out you end in an 8 chain thru set up 1/2 sashayed...The action is short and flowing, easily mastered and is easily adapted to the A.P.D. concept. If you start from the trade by set up you will end in lines facing....


