## Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami

RIGHT & LEFT THRU & 1/4 MORE. A Mainstream Extension.

Right & Left Thru & 1/4 More is not a new idea but quite an old one, The search for additional ways to set up two faced lines for use with Stroll & Cycle brought us back to this old timer and we find it again a useful and smooth extension of a basic. The action is really a basic Right & Left Thru and the Courtesy Turn is continued until the girls lock right hands to form a two faced line. You can almost talk the dancers into the call and only the "sloppy" dancers will find it gives them problems. The need for a proper courtesy turn without short cuts is really the answer...l often add the words "hook four in line" after the call Right & Left Thru & 1/4 More is called...

✓Box 1-4....SLIDE THRU....RIGHT & LEFT THRU & 1/4 MORE... (hook 4 in line)
COUPLES CIRCULATE....BEND THE LINE...SLIDE THRU..LEFT ALLE.

✓ 1P-2P....RIGHT & LEFT THRU & 1/4 MORE....FERRIS WHEEL...

CENTERS PASS THRU .DO SA DOE TO A WAVE...GIRLS TRADE...

RECYCLE.... SWING THRU...TURN THRU...LEFT ALLE.

To set up the Stroll & Cycle 1/4 line formation:

HEADS RIGHT & LEFT THRU & 1/4 MORE....STROLL & CYCLE....
COUPLES CIRCULATE....WHEEL & DEAL...PASS THRU,...LEFT ALLE...

NOTE: While working out some material for the Right & Left Thru & 1/4 More I have made an interesting discovery. You can from any normal eight chain thru box use the following combination to become a technical zero, the same as the Magic Module......SLIDE THRU....RIGHT & LEFT THRU & 1/4 MORE...COUPLES CIRCULATE....BENID THE LINE....SLIDE THRU....

EXAMPLE OF THE ABOVE:

BOX 1-4....SLIDE THRU....RIGHT & LEFT THRU & 1/4 MORE...
COUPLES CIRCULATE....BEND THE LINE....SLIDE THRU.... Sides Box 1-4.

EXAMPLES OF POOR CHOREOGRAPHY:

Our summer filled with callers schools and listening to callers has led me to attempt this approach to call to your attention some examples that I have been hearing all summer and which I feel have real flaws if you are interested in calling smooth flowing dances.

From a Box 1-4 or similar boxes I have heard the following:

1. Curlique..Walk & Dodge to a BEND THE LINE

2. Curlique. Walk & Dodge to a TAG THE LINE

3. Curlique. Walk & Dodge to a WHEEL & DEAL

The above three examples have the center Boy Danciers forced into a back up motion or a quick side wards change in motion...Poor Dancing.

4. Curlique...Walk & Dodge..CAST OFF: 3/4....

From facing couples; Star thru to a FLUTTER WH'EEL....

From facing couples .. Pass Thru. . Partner Trade to a FLUTTER WHEEL.

From an 8 Chain thru Box. Dive Thru. to a FLUTTER WHEEL

From lines facing out..Bend The Line to a FLUTTER WHEEL

The above examples to a Flutter Wheel also include the starting action to a LADIES CHAIN or to a DIXIE STYLE TO AN OCEAN WAVE;

The flow is fine for the girls but causes an abrupt stop for the men, this can easily be eliminated by adding a right & left thru prior to the flutter or ladies chain etc...

In addition to recommending Grand weave as the quarterly Selection for Mainstream Workshops, CALLERIAB has suggested callers review the following two Mainstream Basics during the October - December quarter: Fan the Top and Feel Off. This month's naterial themes around these two basics. Be sure the dancers understand that the body flow of Feel Off is away from the dancer beside them or the follow up Tag the Line or mend the Line will be unconfortable. Also, stress that Fan the Top is a centers 3/4 turn, not a boys or girls 3/4 turn.


