





Challenging Mainstream

BY GIL T. CROSBY - Gainesville

With the current CALLERLAB Quarterly Movement Trade the Wave getting increasing usage, it is perhaps an appropriate time to take a look at the Mainstream Basic Trade. For some reason dancers often want to back up and come in the back door on a Trade rather than moving forward to their next position. Dancers should be reminded to walk forward, passing right shoulders, and end facing the opposite direction from which they started. With this in mind the following figures should provide some interesting dancing.

1P2P Right and Left Thru Pass Thru - Boys Trade Girls Trade - Slide Thru Alle. Left.

Box 1--4 Split Two Around One to a Line Pass Thru - Boys Trade Swing Thru - Centers Cross Run Boys Trade - Slide Thru Alle. Left.

Heads Pass Thru - Separate Around One to a Line Pass Thru - Girls Trade Ferris Wheel - Girls Pass Thru Touch 1/4 - Boys Trade Boys Run - Bend the Line Star Thru - Pass Thru Trade By - Alle. Left.

1P2P Pass Thru Girls Trade - Centers Trade Swing Thru - Boys Trade Slide Thru - Alle, Left.

Four Ladies Chain Heads 1/2 Square Thru Touch 1/4 - Walk & Dodge Boys Trade - Girls Turn Back Star Thru - Trade By Alle. Left.

Four Ladies Chain 3/4 New Head Ladies Chain Sides Pass Thru - Separate Around One to a Line Pass Thru - Girls Trade Couples Circulate - Wheel & Deal Touch 1/4 - Trade the Wave Alle, Left.

NOTE: I again have been receiving questions regarding the meaning of 1P2P and Box 1--4. 1P2P refers to the two facing lines formed when Heads Lead Right and Circle to a Line. Box 1--4 refers to the formation resulting When the Heads Square Thru. When used at the beginning of a figure, these terms indicate the postions of the dancers when the figure begins.

For the first quarter of 1978, the CALLER-LAB Quarterly Selection Committee has voted TWO movements to be used for Mainstream dancing. These moves are for the months of January, February and March of 1978

CALLERLAB QUARTERLY SELECTION COMMITTEE

The two movements selected are:

1. Trade The Wave

2. Ping Pong Circulate

TRADE THE WAVE (Harry Ed Dunkle, 1967)

From any 4-handed ocean wave, dancers facing the same direction in the wave exchange places (Trade) with one another, walking in a semi-circle and passing Right shoulders at the half-way point. Right-hand waves change to Left-hand waves and vice versa. All dancers change their facing direction.

NOTE: It sometimes helps to have the dancers bend forward slightly and look at the other dancers with whom they will exchange places. Everyone moves simultaneously, so everyone has to know exactly where they will end up.

The value of this movement is that it is a natural follow-up on Follow Your Neighbor which was a recent quarterly selection. It is a convenient was to change from a Left handed wave to a Righthanded wave.

EXAMPLES

Box 1-4 Touch 1/4 Follow Your Neighbor Trade The Wave Trade The Wave (again) Left Allemande

Box 1-4 Swing Thru Trade The Wave Ladies Run Wheel & Deal Left Allemande

PING PONG CIRCULATE (Don Beck, 10/75)

This movement starts from a 1/4 Tag Position which is an Ocean Wave in between two couples facing in, and parralel to those couples. The following description is based on a squared up set having Heads Pass the Ocean:

The Center dancers in the Ocean Wave step thru. Everyone does a Pass To The Center and the new center dancers step directly into a Right-Handed Ocean Wave. Caution remember that the dancers moving towards the outside of the set do an automatic Partner Trade in executing the Pass To The Center motion. Original Heads are now the Outside Couples and the original Sides are now in the center Ocean Wave.

EXAMPLES

Four Ladies Chain Heads Pass The Ocean PING PONG CIRCULATE Center Ladies Trade Centers Recycle Pass Thru - Left Allemande Heads Pass The Ocean Extend - Hinge 1/4 Follow Your Neighbor Trade The Wave - Pass Thru Trade Ry Left Allemande

The author of the move PING PONG CIRCULATE desires that the term CIRCULATE be stressed as an integral part of the move. He states that PING PONG CIRCULATE starts from a 1/4 TAG set-up where the path followed by the dancers is the same as if the dancers in an ocean wave did a Step Thru and then all did a Pass to the Center and the new centers Step to a wave. When the figure starts from a Left Hand Wave set-up, all action is with the opposite shoulder. NOTE: For Mainstream Dancing, only the Right Hand Wave is recommended.

A REVIEW OF THE EXPERIMENTAL DANCE PROGRAM FOR THE YEAR 1977 Good experimentals were extremely scarce in 1977. Very few ideas came from the choreographers that had real Mainstream potential. This is brought to center ring by the Callerlab Mainstream Quarterly selection committee. Only four selections were made during 1977 and only one Crossfire, was rather new, Extend and Follow Your Neighbor along with Follow Your Neighbor & Spread are old calls in for a second look. As expected, the majority of experimentals seemed suited for the Plus plateau and on into advance level. Several caught on pretty fast and have gained universal acceptance. By Golly and Stretch Recycle seemed to be the most used by Callers across the country. Here are my picks for the year.

The above lists are in order of selection. Only Time will tell if any of the experimentals basics will find a long life. I feel that there is still a place for experimentals But there needs to a portion of the evening devoted to giving the Right Group of dancers the opportunity to help you evaluate the new ideas. It is impossible to try them all out. The note service that you respect the most should screen the monthly ideas and provide for you an idea of which ones' are the most dancable and for what plateau of level of dancing. We keep trying to do this for you and square dancing.

ALL POSITION DANCING Practice using Slide Thru

I suggest a good review of the Slide Thru Rules so that the dancers completely understand what is going on. Remind them that the Boys will Always Pass Thru & 1/4 turn Right. Girls will always Pass Thru and 1/4 turn Left. Boys are Boys at all times as are Girls playing the part of a Girl at All times.


