The Boys stepping to the Girls on the Outsides perform a RECYCLE and veer slightly left to face in as a couple. The Boys stepping to the center of the set join the Girls who traded to form a momentary two-faced line and then step ahead as a couple. The movement ends in parallel two-faced lines.

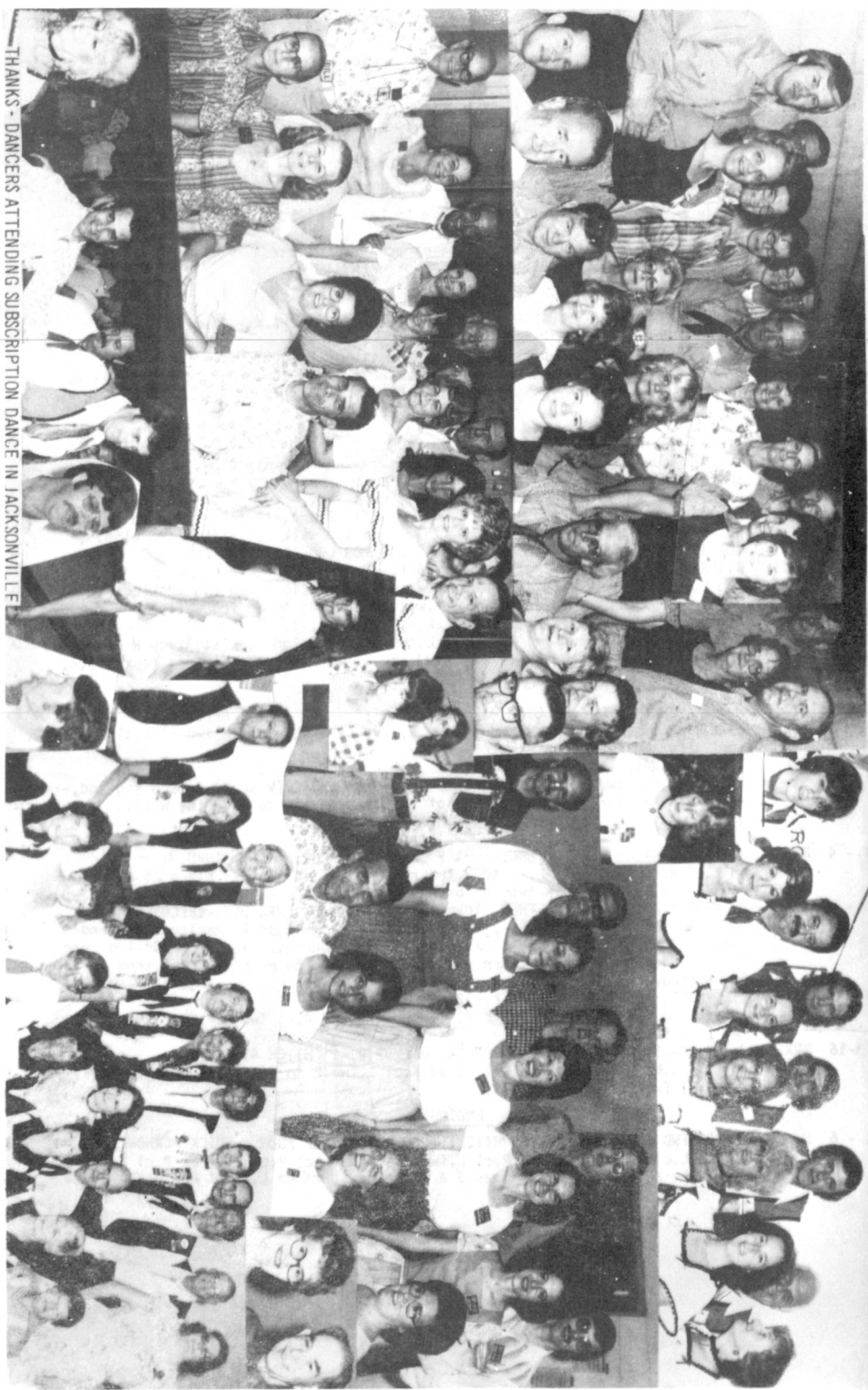

We feel that next year's convention will not be supported if held in Orlando. 75% of those questioned stated, "I will not be back next year!" Extreme dissatisfaction was expressed over inadequate air conditioning. Halls were too small, overcrowded and spread out to far. Insufficient paved parking area and lack of adequate shelter between halls would create havoc in case of heavy rain. Spectator handling was terrible. Several hassled, no possible way for dancers or non-dancers to view choreography. Remember the spectator facilities and seating arrangements during the 1977 State Convention? The view of the Grand March was spectacular. No comparison to the 1978 Convention. On the positive side, consenses of opinions, callers and round dance que'ers program excellent. Too bad sound not better so more people could have heard - would have almost made dancing in the arena bearable. We acknowledge the 1979 Convention committee has worked many long hours in an attempt to make their convention as successful as the limitations of the Orlando site will allow. The interest of Fla. dancers will best be served by abandoning this inadequate site. We propose that the convention be moved to the Lakeland Civic Center. Assurances have been made that the roof has been fixed and the center is available for Memorial weekend 1979. We feel that Lakeland has much superior facilities for the 1979 Convention.
