

The Boys stepping to the center of the set join the Girls who traded to form a momentary two-faced line and then step ahead as a couple. The movement ends in parallel two-faced lines.



Too bad sound not better so more people could have heard - would have almost made dancing in the arena bearable. We acknowledge the 1979 Convention committee has worked many long hours in an attempt to make their convention as success ful as the limitations of the Orlando site will allow. The interest of Fla. dancers will best be served by abandoning this inadequate site. We propose that the convention be moved to the Lakeland Civic Center. Assurances have been made that the roof has been fixed and the center is available for Memorial weekend 1979. We feel that Lakeland has much superior facilities for the 1979 Convention.
