Challenging Mainstream

BY GIL T. CROSBY - Gainesville

Now that Recycle has been added to the Mainstream Program as Basic #69, let's begin using it from more than just the standard position. If your dancers have formed the habit of the boy reaching across and pulling the girl around with him, this habit will have to be broken before using Recycle from other positions. It is helpful to have the ends give a gentle push with their right hand as they start to Crossfold; this will remind the centers to Fold right and follow.

Box 1--4 Spin the Top.
Recycle - Pass Thru
Tag the Line
Centers In - California Twirl
Slide Thru - L. Alle.

Heads Pass the Ocean.
Ping Pong Circulate
Centers Swing Thru - Recycle
Pass Thru - Touch 1/4

The Plus II changes include the addition of Dixie grand, Cross fire, Load The boat and Anything & Spread. Deleted are Trade the wave to the plus I, Diamond circ. & Flip the Diamond to Plus I and Checkmate Deleted.....
THE ONLY additions to the total program are LOAD THE BOAT & ANYTHING & SPREAD....

LETS TAKE A LOOK AT THE NEW ADDITIONS TO THE PLUS PROGRAM:

BOX 1-4....STAR THRU....PASS THRU....BEND THE LINE....
LOAD THE BOAT....LEFT ALLE...

Note be sure you teach the action from Heads Lead Right as well as Sides lead Right lines to give the dancers a chance to learn both parts...The figure will present a learning challenge so drill and keep the combinations simple until the pattern is mastered....
