



FONTANA VILLAGE, N.C. For the fiftieth time, square dancers will gather at Fontana Village Resort, alongside the Southern edge of the Great Smoky Moutains National Park, to cavort to the lively music of the Fontana Ramblers. This venerable institution, known as Swap Shop, is a weeklong square dance festival, the Grande Dame of the family of square dance festivals which are held spring and fall at Fontana Village. Fontana, self proclaimed as the square dance A Capitol of the World', has been hosting these dances since the fall of 1953, when Swap Shop began. "We have making this claim for many years and it has not been disputed" stated R.J.Immel, General Manager of the mountain resort. John Brendle. Rec. Dir. at Fontana in 1953, conceived the idea of square dance festivals as a marketing tool to develop increased occupancy during off season. He invited some of his square dance caller friends to come to Fontana for a week end, urging them to bring along a few square dance friends. Many of them came and soon they were (CS) Swapping calls' for the dancers. In this manner Swap Shop was named. By 1954, Spring Swap Shop came about, and instead of a week end the dancers came for a full week. Within a year, some 400 dancers were attending on a regular basis. Three of the original callers are still on the Swap Shop staff: Fred Goodner of Athens Tenn.; Helen Pate of Anderson, S.C.; and Lib Williams Hubbard Atlanta, Ga. Fred Goodner was the first caller on the stage the night Swap Shop began. Joe Mays of Fairfield, Ala. helped John Brendle organize the first dance festival. Tex Brownlee, the long time Rec. Dir. of Fontana Village Resort and Jean his wife act as host. Tex, as he called by his friends is one of the best known callers in the United States, he made regular tours until 1976 when his duties at the Resort precluded this activity. ### Caller's Corner



JACK LASRY - Miami

PING PONG CIRCULATE ... Don Beck.

The action starts from the 1/4 tag formation, most easily set up from a static set by having the heads or sides pass the ocean. This sets up the ocean wave thru the center and the outside couples behind the wave facing in. The Action is simply explained by telling the dancers in the wave to step thru, with the outside dancers all will pass thru...the new center dancers will step into an ocean wave while the new dancers facing out will partner trade. The action ends with a similar starting formation, with the original wave dancers as the outside couple and the original outside couple as the wave in the

The author sees the action as a circulating rotation into the new position. I find that you can only confuse the dancer by associating the action to a circulate....The name is no problem for the dancers, if there is a problem at all it is what to do after the Ping Pong Circulate and keep within the Mainstream program.....Here are a few ideas,

1. Centers extend to a wave.

2. Centers recycle.

Centers Swing Thru...Turn Thru.
 Centers spin the top

5. Centers turn thru.

6. Centers Fan the top to a square thru...

# Challenging Mainstream

This month's material consists of two-couple zeroes which can be inserted into a dance routine at any point when couples are facing in order to extend the length of the routine. These zeroes can be used for heads or sides from a squared set, for the centers of a double pass thru or trade-by formation, of for all dancers from an eight chain thru formation or from lines of four facing. The sequences will, of course, zero out, i. e., return the dancers to their starting positions. Further, these zeroes can be used anytime two dancers are facing two other dancers, whether of the same or opposite sex.

Spin the Top - Centers Run New Centers Cross Run Bend the Line Pass Thru - U-Turn Back.

Touch 1/4 - Scootback Cast Off 3/4 - Centers Trade Centers Run - Wheel & Deal.

Pass Thru - Partner Hinge Centers Trade - Swing Thru Centers Run - Bend the Line.

Pass Thru - Partner Trade & Roll 1/2 Square Thru - U-Turn Back.

Square Thru - U-Turn Back Fan the Top - Centers Run 1/2 Tag - Trade & Roll.

Veer Left - Centers Trade Bend the Line - 1/2 Square Thru Partner Trade.

Fan the Top - Centers Run New Centers Cross Run Bend the Line.

Veer Left - Fan the Top Ends Run - New Centers Trade Centers Run - Bend the Line.
