Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP: TWO STEPS AT A TIME.....Lee Kopman



Lee has given us a Mainstream quality experimental that our dancers find quite comfortable and not to complicated but well timed and as a bonus it could bring some emphasis to peel off which is a neglected call by many mainstream callers....Starting from columns, the lead TWO dancers will do a normal peel off then as a couple extend (move ahead) to the middle of the column and bend to face in. They will become the trailing couple in a double pass thru formation when the action is completed... The Trailing TWO dancers in the column will move ahead to a 1/2 tag position then trade & Roll to end as the leaders in a Double pass thru formation... A helpful hint might be to start in columns with two girls as leaders and two boys as followers so in your teach you can explain the parts to the girls do this as the boys do that....If your dancers are weak with peel off then you may wish to review and dance some peel off routines for a couple of dances prior to trying Two Steps at a Time....

You will note that I have used curlique to set up the columns rather then Touch 1/4...The column set up with girls in the lead will take advantage of the flow of the curlique leading into the peel off part of two steps at a time. An all 8 circulate into the two steps at a time is a neutral action that works well....

Lee has some variations of two steps at a time which are explored in the Plus section and the advanced supplement.




DANCING SHADOWS R/D Club Port Orange September was an active month







The Quarterly Selection Committee announces the selection of One figure for the fourth quarter beginning October 1, 1978. The figure is GRAND WEAVE by Ross Crispino, Nampa, ID GRAND WEAVE -- FROM A STATIC SQUARE, 4 LADIES WALK TO THE RIGHT (SPLITTING THE CORNER) CROSSING IN FRONT OF THEIR CORNER AND FOLD DIRECTLY BEHIND HIM TO BECOME 4 SINGLE FILE COLUMNS AT RIGHT ANGLES. ALL EIGHT WILL DO A WEAVE THROUGH THE CENTER AS A TAG THE LINE MOVEMENT -- EACH MAN ALLOWS THE MAN ON HIS LEFT TO PASS IN FRONT BUT CUTS RIGHT BEHIND HIM AND IN FRONT OF THE LADY FOLLOWING HIM. THE LADIES PASS IN SIMILAR FASHION, ALLOW THE LEFT HAND LADY TO CROSS IN FRONT. MEN MAKE A RIGHT FACE U-TURN BACK AND STAR THROUGH (ORIGINAL WAS WRITTEN AS SLIDE THROUGH) WITH THE LADY THAT FOLLOWED HIM COMING INTO PROMENADE POSITION AND ALL PROMENADE EXACTLY ONE-FOURTH (ONE POSITION) AND WHEEL IN AS A COUPLE TO REFORM THE SQUARE. FOUR MEN HAVE PROGRESSED 1/4 TO THEIR LEFT.

THIS IS 1/4 OF THE FIGURE AND HAS TAKEN 16 BEATS. REPEAT SAME ACTION 3 MORE TIMES FOR A 64 BEAT MANEUVER. THE LADIES FOLLOW IN THEIR OWN FOOTSTEPS 4 TIMES.

CAN BE USED AT "1/4 GRAND WEAVE" OR "1/2 GRAND WEAVE". CAN ALSO BE DONE AS LEFT GRAND WEAVE WITH MEN WALKING TO THEIR LEFT AND FOLDING BEHIND. THE LADIES, ETC.

Since this figure requires exactly 64 beats to execute properly, there is no need to

Since this figure requires exactly 64 beats to execute properly, there is no need to list sample figures in order to be able to use it. It can be called for any opener, middle break or closer in any singing call that has a 64 beat musical phrase or story. However, we urge you as callers and dancers to dance it with feeling for the music and for the callers, we urge you to call it on phrase for better enjoyment.

Some helpful teaching hints would be to have the men wait four beats before they start and urge the dancers not to rush it. As the call is written, the girls should walk around the gent and then fold in behind him as the gents start to walk forward. The girls then step forward and they start to walk across as the gents clear the center of the square. It is this weaving through the center that makes this a smooth and fun call when everyone moves together. It is also helpful for the caller to start on the musical phrase and prompt the action of the girls, the men, the girls etc. on the first few times through.

Please remember that this call is not to be introduced to Mainstream Dancers until October 1. 1978.
