#### THE CALLERLAB PLUS II PROGRAM.

EXPLORING RELAN THE DEUCEY.

Relay The Deucey is a BIG ZERO no matter where you start, it will bring you back to the same formation and dancer relationship. Example is that if you start in a Box 1-4 wave and call relay the deucy you will end back in a Box 1-4 wave...

Most of the plus II dancers will do relay the deucy from the standard wave easily but from other waves it is often a difficult call...Lets explore the set up where you have a Box 1-4 and call a swing thru....We know that if we use relay the deucy here we have a zero so we can follow with a boys run wheel & Deal and you have your Box 1-4.

DON'T expect your dancers to do a relay the deucy after the swing thru cold...You will have to re-teach the action and drill with the opportunity to dance it......

# CALLERLAB Grievance Procedure

CALLERLAB has established a Grievance and Review Board as an aid in implementing its "Code of Ethics". This Board has developed procedures for dealing with complaints concerning the professional conduct between CALLERLAB members, or between a non-member of CALLERLAB (caller or dancer) and a CALLERLAB member. The intent of this procedure is to provide a means of settling grievances on a professional level as quickly as possible.

A grievance is a complaint by a caller, group of callers, dancer, or group of dancers concerning the professional conduct of a CALLERLAB member. A complaint is not considered to be a grievance until attempts towards its solution have been made by one or more parties involved, without satisfaction to the aggrieved.

It should be emphasized that the Grievance and Review Board will act only on grievances which appear to be in violation of the CALLERLAB "Code of Ethics".

Any one who feels that they have reason to avail themselves of this procedure may obtain additional information from the CALLERLAB Executive Secretary, Pocono Pines,

Recently, a number of inquiries and sample programs have been sent to this office which dealt with the subject of danse level Identification. As you know, CALLERLAB has been publishing a recommended stratification system for several years which we feel properly defines the various dance levels being danced throughout the country And the world. There is some misunderstanding on the part of some as to our purpose and some misuse on the part of users of the terminology we established. Therefore, we are making this release in hopes of helping a wider understanding of dance levels, their use and limitations, and guidelines for all square dancers and callers.

CALLERLAB has identified the following Dance levels:

Basic Level consisting of CALLERLAB list 1-39.

Extended Basic Level consisting of CALLERLAB list 1-54.

MS Mainstream Level consisting of CALLERLAB list 1-69.

- QS Quarterly Selections consisting of MS plus the current Quarterly Selections. +1 Plus One Level consisting of QS and the 12 calls listed in the +1 Program.
- +2 Plus Two Level consisting of +1 and the 12 calls listed in the +2 Program.
- Al Advanced Level One consisting of +2 and the calls listed on the Al list.
- A2 Advanced Level Two consisting of A1 and the calls listed on the A2 list.
- C1 Basic Challenge Level consisting of A2 and the calls from C1.
- C2 Extended Challenge Level consisting of C1 and the calls from C2.

As can be seen from this listing, all levels include all calls from previous lists. It is not the intent of CALLERLAB to try to force anyone to call or dance at any particular level. Clearly, Programs or levels beyond QS are not for all dancers. As a matter of fact, CALLERLAB encourages clubs and callers to provide dance programs aimed at the B or EB levels for those dancers who dance less often than once a week.

CALLERLAB encourages clubs, callers and festivals to label their dances for the calls that are to be used in that hall. For instance if a hall (dance) is to be labeled QS, then the caller could use any call found in the Mainstream Program (MS) and the current Quarterly Selections. He should not use calls on a +1 or +2 list.

If, on the other hand, a hall is labeled +1 level, the caller can use all calls in the +1 list, the QS list and the MS list. He (or she) should not use calls from the +2 list even for a workshop. If the caller is workshopping a +2 call, the hall should be so labeled. In short, the hall should be labeled for the level of the list from which the most difficult or intricate call is selected.

If there is a doubt as to how a hall should be labeled, please write the CALLERLAB office and we will answer your questions according to what calls are to be used. By labeling halls during festivals, dances during the regular dance season and specials for the visiting callers, etc, we hope to have a better dance program where the dancers will be able to dance more and enjoy their dancing and fellowship to a greater degree than when they break down because some dancers came to the wrong dance not knowing what was to be called. No one likes to feel that they have wasted their money. CALLERLAB is suggesting that the use of labels, in accordance with our recommendations, will help alleviate this concern. Regards,


