Challenging Mainstream

Fall is with us once more and that means the new dance season is about to begin. It also means that beginner classes will start and with them will come the challenge and fun of helping non-dancers become square dancers. Not only has CALLERIAB standardized the list of basics which should be taught in classes, but they have divided this list into three segments: the Basic Program (1 - 39) should be taught before beginning the second segment (39 - 54), and this extended Program (1 - 54) should be completed before the final segment (55 - 69) is taught. If all callers in an area will follow CALLERIAB's recommendation, then all classes will be dancing about the same material at certain points. This will permit callers to combine there classes for Jamboree type dances two or three times during the year. The first such dance could be a Basic Program (1 - 38) dance in early December. With this in mind, this month's material features routines which could be used at such a dance.

Heads 1/2 Square Thru
Square Thru - All 8 U-Turn Back
Star Thru - Calif. Twirl
Circle 4 to a Line
Right & Left Thru - Ladies Chain
Star Thru - L. Alle. (Box 1-4)

Heads Rollaway - Sides Square Thru Split 2 Around 1 to a Line Star Thru - Calif. Twirl Centers Pass Thru - L. Alle. (Box 1-4)

Sides Follaway - Square Thru Split 2 Around 1 to a Line Star Thru - Centers Pass Thru Split 2 Around 1 to a Line Ends only Box the Gnat Centers Star Thru Everybody Pass Thru - L. Alle. Heads Box the Gnat Square Thru 3/4 Separate Around 1 to a Line Star Thru - Dive Thru Fass Thru - L. Alle. (Box 1--4).

Try this for an opener: Heads Rollaway - Circle Left 4 Boys Square Thru Star Thru - Calif. Twirl Promenade.

Here's another opener: Head Men & Their Corner Forward & Bac Pass Thru - U-Turn Back Star Thru - Right & Left Thru Rollaway - Pass Thru Right & Left GRAND.


