THE 1979 CONVENTION || The July 1978 Bow & Swing carried a couple of well written and well intentioned letters on the choice of Orlando as the site of the 1979 State Convention. These people should be congratulated on speaking out with their views. However, I wonder if talk like this can lead to more trouble than good. The State Coordinating Committee, made up of representatives from the Fla. Federation of Square dancers, the Fla. Callers Assoc. and the Round Dance Council of Fla. recommended to the delegates to the Fla. Federation that the 1979 convention be moved to Lakeland. You may be disappointed, sure, but swallow that disappointment and work toward great meetings in 1979 and later years. They are palning things that will be new to Florida State Conventions and I think they can put on a great one. So why not get behind them and push and quit sniping. They want and need the support of all of us.

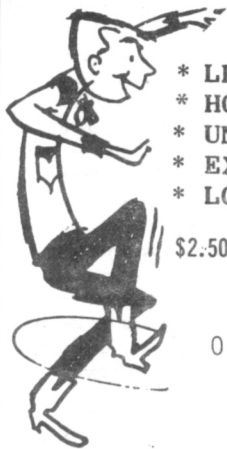

Challenging Mainstream

Fall is with us once more and that means the new dance season is about to begin. It also means that beginner classes will start and with them will come the challenge and fun of helping non-dancers become square dancers. Not only has CALLERLAB standardized the list of basics which should be taught in classes, but they have divided this list into three segments: the Basic Program (1 - 39) should be taught before beginning the second segment (39 - 54), and this Extended Program (1 - 54) should be completed before the final segment (55 - 69) is taught. If all callers in an area will follow CALLERLAB's recommendation, then all classes will be dancing about the same material at certain points. This will permit callers to combine their classes for Jamboree type dances two or three times during the year. The first such dance could be a Basic Program (1 - 38) dance in early December. With this in mind, this month's material features routines which could be used at such a dance.

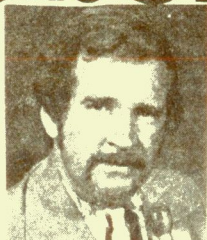

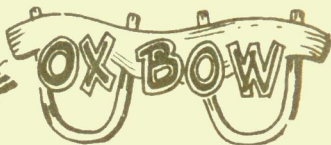
