## EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP:

LOAD THE WINDMILL...Ron Schneider.

From lines facing the end dancers start circulating and as they meet the third dancer they touch 1/4...( have the ends start forward and count the dancers they pass)  
The center four will swing thru then cast right 3/4 as the figure ends in normal columns.  
The action allows for easy adaption into A P D positioning...You may try calling this one directionally...Note to those who take the advanced supplement. You can call this figure directionally but have the centers Left swing thru & left cast 3/4 ending in a magic column....

1P-2P..LOAD THE WINDMILL..COORDINATE..  
COUPLES CIRCULATE..WHEEL & DEAL..PASS THRU..LEFT ALLE.

BOX 1-4..SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..TAG THE LINE IN..

## PLUS PROGRAMS:

The use of Fold and Roll in combination to set up Diamonds: From standard parallel ocean waves have the girls fold & roll and you have normal diamonds set up...The girls are holding left hands and facing in opposite directions so the fold implies a step forward and a left about face to end with the girls face to face, they continue with the roll action or another left face 1/4 tumcreating the girls with a with the wave thru the center and the boys on the points of the diamonds.. You can easily place the boys as the centers of the wave and call for the boys to fold & roll also ending in diamonds.. If the fold & roll action is by the centers of a two faced line you end in facing diamonds.

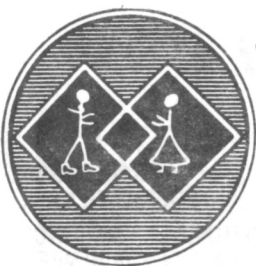

He promoted Boots & George Olgesby to go into the publication of the "4 W's". In the early sixties Dick was President of the S.E. Dancers Assoc. The callers of the S.E. Callers Assoc. also informed me of his help in their organization. Needless to say for a good number of years he supported the State Magazine, Al Cody, Henry Purcell, and myself are all eternally grateful for this support. He was a Knothead for almost 20 years. Dick & Bea danced with Jack Lasry's Cracker Jacks & Cloverleafs, and the Silver Spurs with George Campbell. The rounds were with Ted & Lois Mack, Bill & Betty Beattie and the Holiday Steppers. In October 1975 Dick celebrated his 75th birthday by having a dance at the Trails End S/D Center where almost everyone in the southeast attended and many friends from all over Florida. The Miami paper did an article on Dick & Bea and their Square Dance Shop and this article was reprinted in the State magazine. Dick was almost 80 years old. Our hearts are sad, I know I speak for all who knew Dick, that his passing leaves a void and we feel as we also have lost one of our family. Our sympathy goes out to Bea and family.

For the quarter beginning July 1, 1979, CALLERLAB has selected two calls for their Quarterly Selections. The two calls are TRACK & TRADE written by Ed Fraidenberg in 1976 (also rewritten by Ron Schneider in 1978 as Launch It) and the second call is MAKE ME A COLUMN by Dick Bayer. CALLERLAB urges all callers to use these two calls during the quarter beginning July 1, 1979 and further urges all callers to standardize the name to TRACK & TRADE since this call is more descriptive to the dancer. As an aside, you might mention that dancers may sometimes hear the call Launch It and they should do the TRACK & TRADE action. The descriptions and examples follow.

**TRACK & TRADE:** Starting from columns: Lead two dancers Promenade around the outside as in TRACK II; trailing two dancers Extend to a Half Tag Formation and TRADE, ends in two faced lines. (For ease of learning our examples use Boys in leading positions).

Examples: From static square:	From 1p2p lines:
Heads star thru, Double Pass Thru,	Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Double Pass Thru,
Girls do a "U" Turn Back,	Centers In, Cast Off 3/4, Pass Thru,
TRACK & TRADE, Ferris Wheel,	"U" Turn Back, Touch 1/2, TRACK & TRADE,
Centers Pass Thru, Allemande Left.	Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Star Thru,
	Pass Thru, Trade By, Star Thru (1p2p lines)

Heads Pass Thru , Around 1 to line of 4,  
Pass Thru, "U" Turn Back, Touch 1/2,  
TRACK & TRADE,, Wheel and Deal,  
Square Thru 3/4, Trade By, Allemande Left.

**MAKE ME A COLUMN:** Starts from two faced lines: Centers facing in step forward and walk straight ahead to become lead dancer in column, Ends facing in follow along behind to become Number two dancer in column, Centers facing out turns towards the center and falls in behind end who was facing in and follows to become Number three dancer in the column while the ends facing out turn towards the centers and follow the adjacent center to become the number four dancer in the column. (ends in right or left hand column depending on starting two faced lines).

Examples: from static square;	From 1p2p lines;
Heads lead right but veer left	Pass Thru, Girls Fold, Star Thru,
MAKE ME A COLUMN,	MAKE ME A COLUMN, Single File Circulate,
Everybody Trade & Roll, Allemande Left.	Boys, Run, Allemande Left.

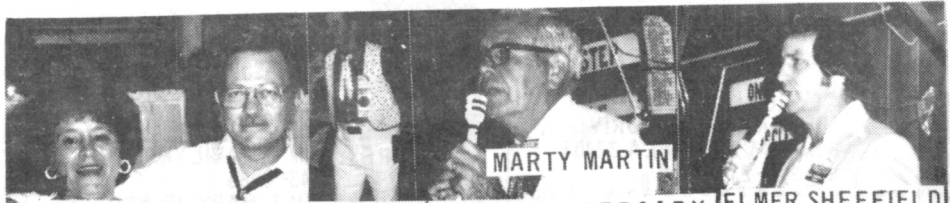

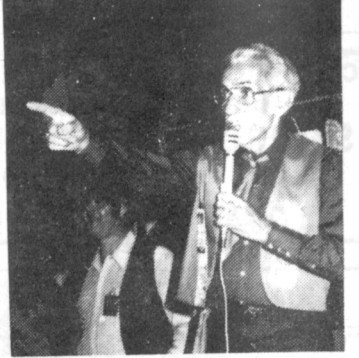

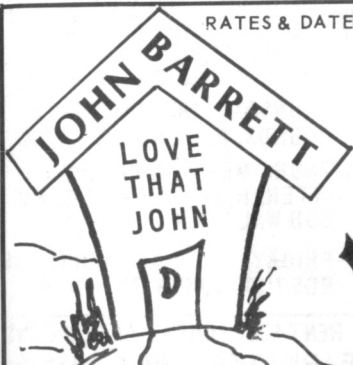
