CALLERLAB QUARTERLY EXPERIMENTAL...DIXIE DERBY...Paul McNutt

The action starts with the dancers doing a Dixie Style into an ocean wave...Then the Girls Fold as the boys trade & slide apart, then the girls step forward to form a two faced line... Caution the girls to make a LARGE fold this will eliminate a crowding of the actions that will cause some problems... Because the last motion of the call is the girls stepping ahead into the center position of the two faced line you should be aware of what calls can follow the dixie derby smoothly...Here are a few:

1. Girls trade....
2. Boys circulate..Girl Trade...
3. Couples Circulate..
4. Girls Cross Run..
5. Girls Cross Run..Girls Circulate..Boys Trade...

Be careful of calling a Wheel & Deal right after the Dixie Derby, The action is abrupt as the girls are moving forward and the boys are stopped....In order to get a nice DANCING WHEEL & DEAL...Call the Boys Circulate..Girls Trade then Wheel & Deal and you have a smooth flow.....

The starting action of dixie derby is the Dixie Style to a wave, check out our Basic Choreo section for some hints to smooth entry into the dixie style.....It should make Dixie Derby Dance better...

Without teaching the figure I can direct the action with directional usage of the basics...Show it, Dance it and evaluate it so we all can express our feeling when it comes time to review the experimental quarterly selections at the Callerlab Convention.....

Speaking of the Callerlab Convention to be held in the Miami area next April, if you have been calling three years and average calling at least once a week and would like to attend the convention and see just how Callerlab works let me know and I will see that you get an invitation.....
