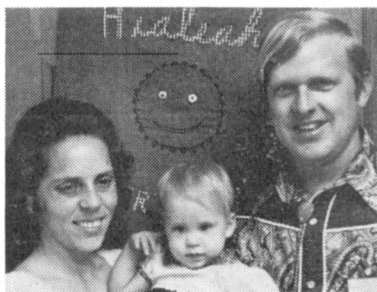

EXPLORING CLOVERLEAF:

Once a very much used basic, Cloverleaf has fallen a bit in popularity since Track II became a Callerlab Quarterly Experimental. Lets NOT forget the flowing and un-entangled qualities found in a Cloverleaf. The basic formation for a cloverleaf to start is from the completed double pass thru set up. You can also have only two couple do the cloverleaf. Example would be to have the Heads Pass Thru. Then Cloverleaf or from the Trade By Formation have the outside couples Cloverleaf as you direct another call to the center couples.

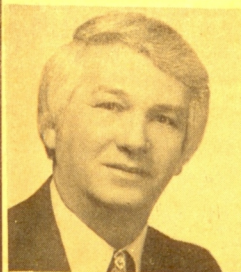
