Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami

MAINSTREAM REVIEW; PEEL OFF, FAN THE TOP.

Each quarter the Callerlab Mainstream Basics Committee will select two figures to review and feature during the three month period, Peel Off and Fan The Top have been selected for the present quarter and here is some action material for your program.

PEEL OFF has a basic starting formation from the completed double pass thru set up. The lead couple will start the action by individually turning away (peeling) from each other and complete an about face action. They will become the ends of a forming line of four By turning away from each other they leave a wide opening between them for the trailer to step ahead into the vacating position then the trailers about face turning away from each other to end as the centers of the forming line. Note that the action of the PEEL Off is always an about face turning away from the center of the set up, like Peeling a Banana, the peeling falls away from the center.

The second basic formation for a peel off at Mainstream is the "Z" formation, that is the formation set up from an ocean wave by having the ends fold. You can easily see the leader and trailer in the Z and they respond to a Peel Off by having the leaders about face away from the center of the Z as the trailers step ahead and turn away from each other to end in a two faced line formation.

The other two formations I consider "floor stoppers" and feel they are best unused at mainstream thru plus level dances. The two formations are the double pass thru set up with the action ending in lines facing out and from columns.

The following action after a peel off from the completed double pass thru set up can

1. Include all forward figures like pass thru, star thru etc.

2. A bend the line works very smoothly.

3. A tag the line works well if properly timed.

From the Z formation the following actions work well:
1. Centers trade.

2. Couples Circulate.

3. Wheel & Deal.

4. Ferris Wheel.

5. Tag the Line(1/2 Tag the line)

6. Ends run to form waves.

7. Centers Hinge to form diamonds (plus 1)



This month's material is arranged in a slightly different format. Each figure consists of a Set-up which will leave the dancers with two boys facing two girls; the Get-out will resolve the square. One or more of the Zeroes may be inserted at the point labeled (ZERO) to lengthen the figure.



Try to get in a square with people who have been dancing while you were away so they can help you. I've noted a lot of grabbing and pushing, and possibly those offenders do not know the proper way to touch someone while dancing. This of course is 90 % of the time. Try this! Hold your hand with your fingers flat and together, tuck your thumb down against your fingers and rotate your hand with your little finger down. This stops sprained fingers and broken nails, and finger bruises on arms. The other dancer can also move away easier when the movement requires. I danced Tuesday and found, a not too sure person, grabbing and holding my arm. I can imagine the damage to a ladies arm. I also found myself out of position a number of times by this persons actions. The square broke down three times. So be careful. On other thing, everyone makes mitakes so don't cut someone down for one. I've people snobbing other dancers and this is not proper. Start again, think about the moves and don't worry about it. When the moves are finished the caller can show you what you did wrong, if you have not already discovered your error yourself. I have discussed these problems with Chuck Leamon. Chuck relates that these two problems seem the hardest to master. Chuck also said, "the more you dance, the more you learn". Dancing is for you and you make the dance what it is. Remember the Sunshine Festival, Golden Nut Convention and all the other dances away from home. You may find reservation difficult to arrange if you wait too long. Poetry: Dancers are fun people, so I have surely found, whether dancing home, or, gone eithersquare or round.
