Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami



MAGIC COLUMN... Dave Hodson.

The Magic Column is an irregular column which I will describe starting from a 1P-2P line all Touch 1/4 to set up normal columns then have the center two pairs slither. This set up with the ends of the column holding right hands and the centers holding left hands. The column is made up of the first and last dancers in one column and the center two dancers in the other column. Have your dancers look this over. Now to teach a MAGIC COLUMN CIRCULATE from the set up I gave to you have the last dancer in each column look for their original partner, she will be the one he will replace, she is in the other column and to get there the #1 man moves on an angle. The action is the same for the #3 man and lady. The Number 1 & 3 ladies will simple move ahead one position. the #2 & 4 men follow their original partner & circulate

on an angle, the two lead girls (one in each column) will simply turn the corner as in a regular circulate. NOTE: The traffic pattern for the dancers facing each other and who must circulate in an X pattern, the center dancer in the column goes first. HAVE the dancers MAGIC COLUMN CIRCULATE four times keeping track of each circulate slowly so they have an opportunity to see where they are going. A few simple routines will have them catching on quickly. Another teaching hint is to have each dancer reach out and touch the dancer they are following. Do this at each circulate position and you will save some confusion. In the examples note various ways of setting up the Magic Column.
