## THE PLUS PAGE:

Continuing with our program of Plus Calls lets look at PEEL THE TOP...The basic learning formation for Peel The Top is the "Z" formation, that is the set up from an ocean wave and call an ends fold....From the Z, the leaders will peel off as the trailers in each Z step ahead and all fan the top...The "standard" fromation is to set up a Z with boys as leaders and girls as trailers so the fan action has the girls turning 3/4 as the boys move forward. Box 1-4...SWING THRU..GIRLS FOLD....Have the dancers prepared to learn Peel the Top by having used Peel Off from the Z so theyare aquainted with leaders and trailers and a peeling action......The teach on Peel the Top should go easily from here, tell the leaders Boys, to peel off and the trailers Girls to step ahead and take left hands with the adjacent girl and from here we fan the top with the girls turning 3/4 as the men move up....Note that the ability to relate to a fan the top is helpfull....

From parallel ocean waves you end in an eight hand tidal wave set up and when started-from waves end to end you will end in parallel ocean waves...



# Challenging Mainstream

BY GIL T. CROSBY - Gainesville

CALLERLAB '79 was held in April and passed several resolutions affecting Mainstream and Plus level dancers.

The Mainstream List was revised as follows: Dropped from the list—Couples Lead Left (#19), Swat the Flea (#25), Shoot the Star 3/4 (#33), Couples Backtrack (#38), and from the Cast Family (#56) Cast 1/4, 1/2, In, Right and Left; Added to the list—Pass the Ocean (as part of the Ocean Wave Family #42) and Ferris Wheel (as #53). In addition to these changes in the list, a suggested All Position Dancing List was developed.

The Quarterly Selection list was reduced in size with the following movements being retained for an additional year's use as workshop material for Mainstream dancers: Track II, Touch Family (To a Wave, 1/4, 1/2, 3/4), Extend the Tag, Roll (as an extension only to face), Ping Pong Circulate, and Two Steps at a Time. Two of the Quarterly Selections (Ferris Wheel and Pass the Ocean) were added to the Mainstream List, while three of the selections (Chase Right, Coordinate, Trade the Wave) will become part of the Plus 1 Program for the coming year. The final two movements (Stroll and Cycle, Grand Weave) were dropped from continued use at either the Mainstream or Plus levels of dance.

CALLERLAB also finalized the list of definitions for all Mainstream calls and urges all callers to refer to these definitions when teaching any basic.

Finally, when a dance is advertised at a particular level, dancers have every right to expect the caller to use material from that level and to refrain from using material beyond that plateau unless it is part of a workshop program. Callers have a responsibility to the dancers to remain within the advertised level. Accordingly, CALLERLAB has adopted the following resolution: "Be it resolved that CALLERLAB adopt a policy of suggesting that members call movements within the advertised/designated plateau and use calls from any plateau other than that which was designated, and/or unlisted experimentals, only after walking or workshopping that call, and be it resolved that conducting a designated level workshop shall mean workshopping the calls listed for that plateau."

Square dancing will continue to be a part of the Girl Scouts activities as the girls expressed a desire to con-Jinue their dancing.

CALLERLAB recently completed its sixth International Convention in Los Angeles and there were several significant actions taken by this prestigious group. A revision of the Mainstream Program, a revision of the Quarterly Selections List and a minor revision of the Plus I list. These are attached for your review.

The committee on Definitions has provided clarifications and some minor revisions to the definitions of terms for the basics numbered 39 through 69 on the CALLERLAB list. These definitions will be distributed to all CALLERLAB members within a month. More important, however, is the vote taken on the Basic "RECYCLE". The membership of CALLERLAB voted by a large majority to keep "RECYCLE" as a NO-HANOS move. We would urge all callers and dancers to emphasize this during 1979-80 in order to give it a fair shake.

CALLERLAB also discussed the subject of Dance level identification. The result was that a resolution was passed which should help clarify what is recommended for all clubs and callers. The resolution provides guidance and yet affords sufficient latitude so that all clubs and callers can operate effectively within the wording. For your interest, the resolution follows:

"Be it resolved that CALLERLAB adopt a policy suggesting that members call movements within the advertised/designated plateau and use calls from any plateau other than the which was designated, and/or any unlisted experimental, only after walking or workshoping that call, and be it resolved that conducting a designated level workshop shall mean, workshopping the calls listed for that plateau."

While this reads "Members", CALLERLAB hopes that all callers, clubs and festivals will follow the spirit of this resolution and make it easier for dancers to know if they are attending the correct dance for their particular comfort, confidence and skill level. It does not brand anyone (club or caller) as a particular type of person, but rather indicates what the calls for that program will include. When everyone follows this guidance, the callers will be able to program better and thus improve the enjoyment of all dancers.

We would like to remind all callers that CALLERLAB is conducting the Callers' Seminar at the National Square Dance Convention in Milwaukee on June 28, 29 & 30, 1979. Ther will be two sessions daily and the staff includes several of the outstanding trainers within the calling profession. There is no charge for this seminar.
