WEST COAST "WILLIE" did not appear or the square dance scene without much trial and tribulation. Briefly, I will retell my story as told to Hugh & Jean Fultz. I began when the West Coast Association was looking for a novel method of promoting the Association and square dancing on the West Coast as well as Nationally. the brain-child of John & Susie Petrauskas. This was early in 1976. As with all new ideas, some of the members of the Association weren't too sure they were ready for a child. They just could not grasp my potential as a salesman and good will ambassador. John & Susie prevailed and with the help of John Zellner, acting as mid-wife, I was born July 15,1976. Law and correct usage dictate that a boy must be attired properly so, with the help of Cal & Rosy Heinlin and Minnie Zellner, I was firnished with a splendid square dance outfit. At the urging of many members of the Association I became a full fledged member of most of the clubs here on the West Coast and I proudly wear their badges. I began my travels after my debut at the Knothead Konvention on Labor Day, 1976. I was adopted by West Coast President Ken & Mae Ford. They provided me with a very good home. However, I did not stay at home all the time-I really traveled. By the end of their term, I had visited 60 clubs and affairs.
