## WEST COAST SQUARE AND ROUND DANCERS ASSOCIATION

The exact origin of the West Coast Square and Round Dancers Association is shrouded in antiquity but as near as can be determined it appeared about Membership has been on an individual basis since 1970 and at the end of 1978 stood at 2,180 making it the largest Association in Florida. The following 14 presidents have been: Hink Smith, Matt Bryan, Walter Stoltz, Mori Sogolow, Warren Hyland, Barney Weatherford, Ron Van Valkengurg, Een Hamilton, Tom Caviness, Ernie Powell, John Zellner, Kon Ford, High Fultz, and George Burcham.

The area served by the West Coast Association encompasses 13 counties on the West Coast of Florida from Hernando County in the North to Collier County in the South. The counties to the East are Polk, Highlands, Glades

About 100 clubs dance in this area.

In 1965 the West Coast Association, was host to its first convention under the capable chairmanship of Mori Sogolow. In 1969 and 1976, Walter Stoltz chaired the convention. Ron Van Valkenburg was chairman in 1973. Each of these events has been bigger and better under the guidance of the

Florida Federation.

The main purpose of the Association is to keep the dancers informed of ewents and happenings in the Square and Round Dance picture on the West Coast of Florida. This is accomplished through the publication of The West Coast Dancer, a monthly magazine devoted to club news, feature items of interest, and a complete schedule of open dances in the area. The Dancer was started in 1968 by Mori Sogolow and has had seven editors. These editors have been: Chuck Gernheuser, Bill Shellman, Ron & Mary Lee Van Valkenburg, Al & Isabelle Ratliff, John & Susie Petrauskas, Carolyn Mercer, and Virginia Haller. The present press runs average 3,250 copies per month This magazine is supported by the dues of the Association members and is distributed free throughout our area.
West Coast Willie is the Association mascot. Since he came into being

at the Knothead Konvention in September of 1976, he has visited 150 clubs and functions. He was engaged to Central Florida Millie at the Pirates Bal. in Orlando in 1978 and they were joined in matrimony at the Fall Pun Fest

that same year.

One of the most worthwhile projects of the Association is the Plood Bank. It was started by John and Susle Petrauskas in 1976 and now has 70 units on deposit. All members and their dependent children are eligible after they have been members for 30 days.

# Caller's Corner

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP FOR PLUS LEVEL DANCERS:

CONNECT THE TOP.....Carl Hanks

Connect The Top is an interesting combination of calls that fit together very well. I have had the opportunity to use it for several weeks now and the dancers like the You do need alot of room to dance the figure and if you are on a crowded flood you may have some problems...

Starting from an eight hand tidal wave....IP-2P...Do Sa Do to a wave.....Tell the extreme end dancers and the adjacent dancer to each end to drop hands and to walk forward as .. to trade to the other end of the long wave...At the 1/2 way point in their trade they will meet a dancer coming at them, with that dancer join right forearms and trade, this will place the boy close to the center and the girl on the outside.... The center four dancers left in the wave will spin the top then the boys will connect their left forearms and arm turn 3/4 (cast off) as the outside girls move forward to become the end of a forming wave the center girls drop hands and move to their right to become the other end of forming parallel ocean waves...Ends with boys as centers & girls as ends of the wave... Note the two key teaching points: Tell the end & adjacent dancer in the tidal wave to stay out wide as they do their 1/2 trade action, if they get in close the center four are crowded by their spin the top action...Also the center girls as they complete the spin the top action should at the completion of the spin the top drop hands so they can easily move forward to their right and become one of the wave ends ...

1P-2P..DO SA DO TO A WAVE....CONNECT THE TOP ... BOYS RUN. BEND THE LINE .. STAR THRU .. PASS THRU ... TRADE BY ... LEFT ALLE ...

Some nice ways to set up the tidal wave:

- 1. Box 1-4...Swing Thru..Spin The Top....
- 2. Box 1-4 Wave....Fan the Top....
- 3. 1P-2P. RIGHT & Left Thru. Dixie Style To a Wave.. Trade The Wave...Fan The Top....

It will take about three walk thrus to smooth out the action but the fact that all the flow is forward and if the dancers keep their distance it will dance very smoothly

The material this month is all set-up by using the much neglected basic couples Backtrack. All figures begin from Fromenade and Heads (or Sides if you prefer) Backtrack to establish facing lines with the boys in the center and the girls on the ends.

Promenade - Don't Stop:

Heads Backtrack - Fass Thru. Tag the Line - Face Right Girls Trade - Wheel & Leal Square Thru 3/4 - Left Alle.

Heads Backtrack . Pass Thru - Wheel & Leal Centers Square Thru 3/4 Dosido - Swing Thru Boys Run - Crosstrail Thru Left Alle.

Heads Backtrack - Touch 1/4. All 8 circulate - Centers Trade All 8 Circulate Two Steps at a Time Centers Fass Thru Swing Thru - Boys Run Bend the Line - Crosstrail Thru Left Alle.

Heads Backtrack - Touch 1/4 All 8 Circulate - Boys Run centers rass Thru Left Alle. (Box 1--4)

Heads Backtrack . Boys Square Thru Girls Fass Thru & Face the Boys Touch 1/4 - Boys Circulate Recycle - Square Thru 3/4 Trade By - Left Alle. (Box 1-4)
