Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami



I get a bit upset when I here of cases where a caller teaches an advanced basic from standard position then without any opportunity for practice calls the figure from every possible position and expects the dancers to respond....Learning calls requires an opportunity to get a walk thru from the position you must react from....A few folks may be able to figure out where to go but most will require a walk thru and drill time....PLEASE consider the fact that it takes a long time for dancers to be trained well and for them to appreciate the advanced dancing picture so don't run them off with a dislike for advanced dancing only because YOU have been in a hurry

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP:

MAGIC TRACK & TRADE ...

An extremely nice Magic Column Figure. If you are using the Magic Column Figures give this one a good look..... From Magic Columns, the lead two dancers will do a Track II action as the trailing two will do the magic column circulate into a left handed 1/2 tag formation & trade, ending in right handed ocean waves... Remind the dancers that the inside dancers of the face to face dancers in the magic column have right of way as the action starts...

> 1P-2P. ENDS TOUCH 1/4. CENTERS LEFT TOUCH 1/4. TRACK & TRADE... (girls do the track 11, boys magic column circ. & trade) TURN THRU..LEFT ALLE ...

1P-2P.. PASS THRU.. U TURN BACK. ENDS TOUCH 1/4. CENTERS LEFT TOUCH 1/4. MAGIC TRACK & TRADE...(boys track II girls magic column circ.& Trade) RECYCLE..VEER LEFT..COUPLES CIRCULATE.. BOYS RUN..GRAND RIGHT & LEFT ...

MINI CHASE..Lee Kopman.

From couples back to back, the girls position will do a 3/4 zoom action as the boys position will partner tag into the vacating position....From lines back to back you end up in columns and from the trade by formation you end up in parallel waves... 1f you experimented with shake down a few years ago, the girls action of a 3/4 zoom is the same action as a shake down....The call is smooth and easily danced.....I found myself reviewing and dancing shakedown then moving into Mini Chase... I don't think that is 100% necessary to do for the dancer to accept the action easily but it did work well

1P-2P...PASS THRU...MINI CHASE... BOYS RUN...RIGHT & LEFT THRU... SWING THRU. TURN THRU. LEFT ALLE

1P-2P...SQUARE THRU FOUR...MINI CHASE... SCOOT BACK .. WALK & DODGE. PARTNER TRADE & ROLL. GRAND RIGHT & LEFT
