EXPERIMENTAL BASIC

COUPLE UP...*Lee Kopman*

Couple Up is a simple combination call that can be called directionally, but under some conditions it is better flow to use the non-directional name. The action is really only a split (box) circulate, and the dancers facing out of the box will then U turn back.

The figure sounds like we really don't need this experimental. However, think of the possible usage from the centers of columns, the centers of waves or two-faced lines doing a Couple Up while the others do something else???

GET ACQUAINTED FIGURES:

BOX 1-4: TOUCH 1/4...COUPLE UP...BOX THE GNAT...
RIGHT & LEFT THRU...PASS THE OCEAN...RECYCLE...
PASS TO THE CENTER...SQUARE THRU 3/4...LEFT ALLE.

BOX 1-4: TOUCH 1/4...SCOOT BACK...COUPLE UP...
PASS THE OCEAN...RECYCLE...LEFT ALLE.

1P-2P: RIGHT & LEFT THRU...DIXIE STYLE TO A WAVE...
BOYS COUPLE UP & SQUARE THRU FOUR...
GIRLS CIRCULATE ONE & FACE IN...ALL CURLIQUE...
GIRLS TRADE...RECYCLE & VEER LEFT...
COUPLES CIRCULATE...BOYS RUN...GRAND RIGHT & LEFT.

HEADS PASS THRU...AROUND ONE TO A LINE...

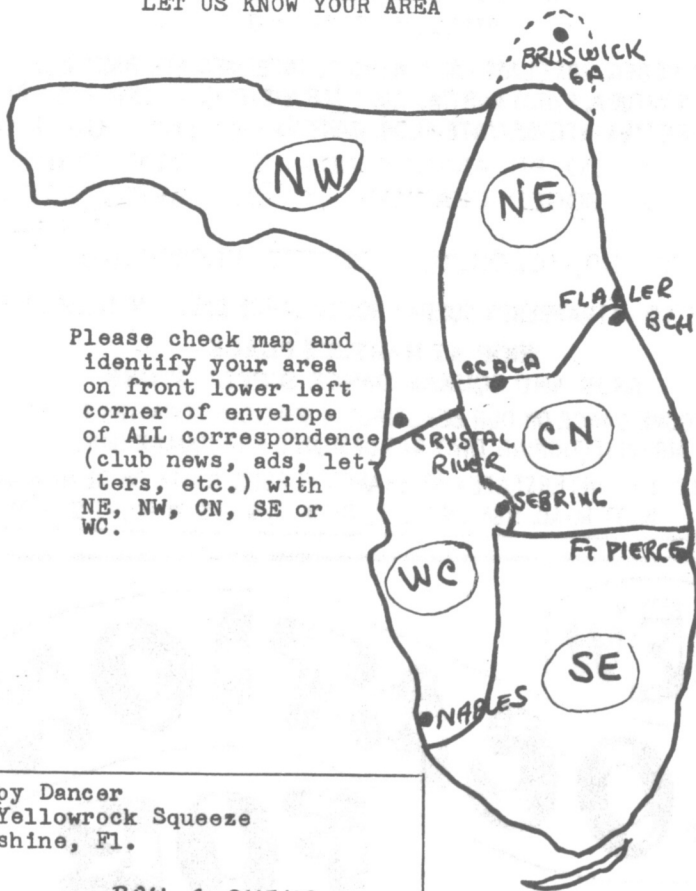

A SERIOUS MATTER

by Nick Corsano, Boston, Mass.

We prepare for the fun, friendship and pleasure of Square Dancing by learning the maneuvers and once we acquire the confidence in our ability we don't hesitate to travel to nearby clubs and to other states and countries to further our fun. Very seldom is any other thought in our minds as we dress and head for the dance.

However, we must prepare to be ready in case of fire, explosion, physical damage to the building or whatever emergency to leave these dance or assembly areas quickly, safely and without panic and to evacuate the building as soon as possible in order to prevent injury or loss of life to any of the occupants.

Most of these dance and assembly areas, especially those in the United States are regularly inspected and when all code regulations have been approved by the duly legally authorized personnel a maximum capacity for the specified occupancy is allowed to use the building. This approval in most of the United States certifies in a posted notice on the premises that the egresses, main and emergency are sufficient, proper and unobstructed, have approved hardware, that exit signs are visible, that a source of emergency lighting is installed and operable and other code regulations too numerous to enumerate have been provided to allow for safe occupancy. Therefore, it is imperative that all dancers and occupants acquaint themselves with any unfamiliar area especially the location of all required exits, that they are unobstructed and ready for immediate use in case of emergency and that a second means of lighting is installed and working properly.

No one should hesitate to inform whoever is in control of the assembly area of any violations observed and insist they be corrected immediately. We must never assume someone else has performed this chore. We must be especially concerned where stairs up or down must be travelled in order to leave the building from an as-

sembly area as this egress path presents an additional hazard for emergency evacuation.

For whatever reason, although a certificate of inspection is posted, it is no indication that the owner or occupant have not violated the law by permitting one or more code infractions to exist, inadvertently or otherwise, when the assembly area is occupied.

In my travels here in Massachusetts and in other states and countries, I have noted serious and extremely dangerous violations of legal regulations in dance areas. Having dealt with the inspection and enforcement of code regulations for assembly areas I feel it my duty to inform and alert all occupants of these assembly areas of the inherent danger therein, especially where people dance and the possibility of overcrowding is not only possible but quite often allowed.

Some of the most common violations are the use of slide bolts and other illegal locking devices on designated exit doors, the lack of directional exit signs, either a lack of emergency lighting or a system that doesn't work, overcrowding and blocked exits.

We must never forget that history repeats itself and although the Coconut Grove night club holocaust occurred in Boston thirty-seven years ago with a loss of almost 500 lives in the fire and panic that ensued, we must be prepared and extremely alert to see it doesn't happen again.

NEWS FROM CENTRAL

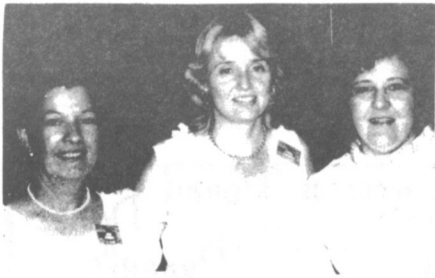
On May 31st, the Central Florida Square and Round Dance Association held their Annual Meeting, preceded by a Pot Luck Dinner and followed by a dance.

GETTING THE MOST FROM THE DANCE

(The following thoughts on suggested Do's and Don'ts for Square Dancing, Author Unknown, were found by Danny Robinson, and were printed in his Oct-Dec 1978 issue of THE SQUARE DANCE BULLETIN.)

GETTING READY FOR THE DANCE

DO: Eat a light dinner; you'll have less weight to carry while dancing, have more pep, and will enjoy your after-dance snack much more.

DON'T: Forget that shower or tub, AND that bottle or jar of deodorant. Hoedown is hot work and it is only good taste to make sure that you don't offend.

DO: Dress gaily and comfortable. Fancy and expensive costumes are not at all necessary, but bright and colorful clothes help to add flavor to the dance and it's nice to know that you look right. The gents shouldn't overdress and the ladies shouldn't underdress. The men should always wear long sleeved shirts. Leave off any accessories that might come loose or fall off unexpectedly. Who wants to stand out half a dance while someone looks for a lost earring, or ties up a stubborn shoe, or slipper lace?

DON'T: Take a drink of any kind for at least twelve hours before a dance; even a short snort, a single highball is enough to affect your coordination, slow your reflexes and (what is more important) make your presence objectionable to others. Furthermore, leave your bottle at home - Alcohol and allemandes just don't mix. The After-Party is just as much a part of the dance as the first allemande in this respect so make that last drink coffee.

DO: Leave home early enough to get to the dance in time for the very first "Honor your partner." Don't be that tardy twosome that deprives three other couples from dancing because you aren't there to fill the set.

WHEN YOU GET TO THE DANCE

DO: Forget about business, financial, social and family cares (even taxes) and concentrate on enjoying the dance and helping others around you to enjoy it.

DON'T: Fail to be friendly and sociable with everyone; a neighborly attitude will make you a

lot more popular than perfect technique.

DO: Form your square promptly and welcome anyone who joins the set. If you don't know everyone in the square, introduce yourself before the call starts. Always thank everyone in the set for sharing your fun when it breaks up at the end of a tip.

DON'T: Ever walk away from a set because some of its members may not be the best dancers in the State. Help them along and they'll be your friends forever. If necessary, change partners to further strengthen the set. Never flaunt your superior knowledge; remember you were once a "clunk" yourself.

DO: Listen closely for walk-thrus, instructions and calls - and let others in the square also listen to them by keeping quiet. People who talk constantly and try to instruct others in the set can become very unpopular, very quickly.

DON'T: Take dancing too seriously (yours or others). Mistakes are half the fun of dancing provided you don't make too many mistakes of the same kind. If someone "goofs", just laugh it off and keep pitching.

DO: Mix your sets and partners freely and constantly. Why get stuck in the old square all evening? Change squares each tip and see how the "other half" dances. Change partners as often as you can - a variety is the spice of a hoedown!

DON'T: "Hedge" about serving on a committee or accepting an officership in your club or group. It is a peck of fun and you'll find that the small amount of time and responsibility it requires is more than paid for by the satisfaction of doing something for others.

DO: Make it a point to get acquainted with everyone at the dance that you've never met before, and renew your acquaintance with those you haven't seen for awhile. You don't need a third party to introduce you to a stranger; just walk right up to him or her and tell them how glad you are to have them there. Every square dancer should be a self-appointed, one man welcoming committee.

DON'T: Make yourself obnoxious by "cutting-in" or "cheating" into a square by objectionable means. "Cutting" is something of an art if it is to be done right, so be sure

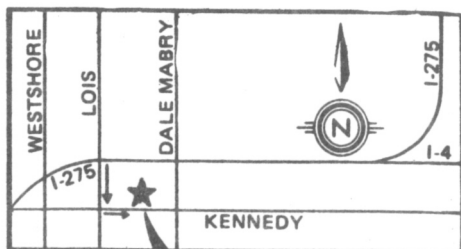

you know how to "cut". If in doubt, ask the caller if it is O.K. to cut in as some clubs and groups don't approve of it.

DO: Stick to the style of dancing used by the group and refrain from showing off with fancy twirls and figures. Avoid jerking, pulling, and bouncing and try for smoothness in your dancing.

DON'T: Grumble and gripe if a less capable couple fills in your

set when you signal for additional members. Take whatever comes gladly and willingly and do your best to have fun with them. Rudeness certainly has no place in square dancing, but tolerance and kindness rank high.

DO: Remember that good dancing ability is nice to have, but that the greatest contribution you can make toward the enjoyment of a dance is friendliness, good humor, cooperation and a genuine desire to have FUN!!
