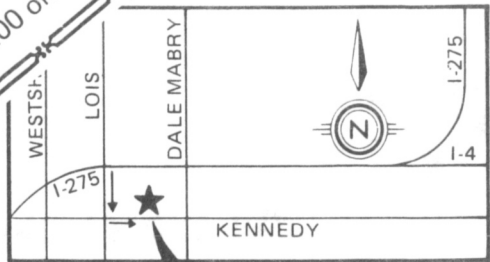

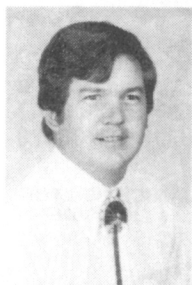

The Annual Fall Clinic of the Florida Callers Association was held at the Altamonte Springs Inn on October 17th, 18th, and 19th, with excellent attendance from throughout the state.

The Clinic was conducted by Jack Murtha of Sacramento California. He brought with him a wealth of calling and teaching experience. He reviewed the fundamentals of teaching, using both highly sophisticated and down-to-earth techniques. Sprinkled throughout his presentation were videotaped examples of new teaching methods, portraying dancer reaction in real class situations.

He advocated dancers having a solid foundation in basic movements, and not keeping them on a schedule to graduate by a certain date with a predetermined number of lessons. He presents each new class dancer with a Century Book, and before graduation, the dancer must show that he/she has danced to at least 12 different callers. To accomplish this, weekly Class Level Dances are held throughout the

Sacramento area.

Congratulations are in order for those who attained Full Membership in the F.C.A. at the Clinic: Jim Morgan, Buzz Nocera, Jean Gaskins, Mike Akers, Whit Brown, Charlie Sellie, Larry Graham, Don Jochum, and Jerry Barrett. Don Wiley passed his Critique and will receive his white badge in 6 months when his tenure is reached.

At the Florida Callers Association Annual Meeting Sunday morning, the following officers were elected and installed: President-Gil Crosby; Vice-President-John Barrett; Secretary-Art Wilson; and Treasurer-Bob Bland.

Retiring President, Bill Roundtree, was given a standing ovation for his untiring efforts and excellent leadership during his term of office.

Besides the hard work at the Clinic Sessions, those in attendance enjoyed the usual good fellowship and exchange of ideas with fellow callers and taws.

REPRINT FROM WEST COAST DANCER

1. You invite graduates to your dances then call above their level and try to push them to higher levels too fast. SO THEY QUIT.
2. Several callers love to workshop a dance. You also workshop figures no one will ever hear again. A waste of time. *They want to dance.* SO THEY QUIT.
3. Some callers have dancers running through dances. A majority of Florida dancers are middle aged or older. Too Strenuous. SO THEY QUIT.
4. The majority of dancers want callers to call mainstream, plus 1 & 2 as advertised and do not care for all position dancing. SO THEY QUIT.
5. A minority like a challenge. So, keep all position dancing at an advanced level. This minority love to workshop anything new or years old but keep it out of the general stream of dances.
6. Use what is in Mainstream plus 1 & 2 level in your patter calls and singing calls. THERE IS PLENTY, IF YOU USE ALL OF IT.
7. Dancers come for relaxation, enjoyment and fun. How about it fellows? You are a great group of guys. *LET'S KEEP THEM DANCING.*

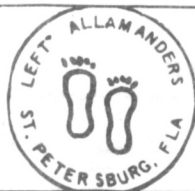

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

RELEASE RECYCLE.....*Dick Kenyon*

From the 1/4 Tag Formation the action starts with the end of the wave extending to the girl in the outside couple as the boys in the outside couple extend to become the ends of the wave in the center, then the centers recycle as the outsiders in their mini wave will do a recycle action ending with a double pass thru set up... From standard position the figure is easily mastered, with the APD usage it requires dancers who are familiar with APD recycles or else you will be asking for trouble.....With mainstreamers I suggest keeping this one standard position....

The Sewing Seminar AND ALSO The Simplest of Circle Skirts

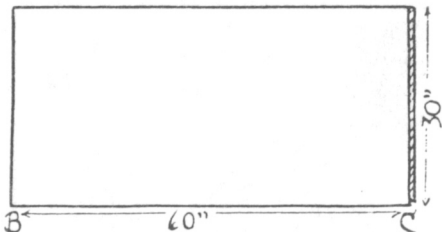

This was a super success put on by members of the Framingham Fairs and Squares and other interested people, and another first from this club for New England. They must be congratulated for such a fine affair, and those attending (the hall was very, very full) expressed many desires for a repeat of this for next year. Perhaps another New England club will volunteer to do this in another area next year.

I was very grateful to be asked to be part of this event, and was delighted to meet so many talented square dance people. There seems to be endless talent among the square dance population, and so many of these people are extremely generous in sharing all they can. No wonder square dancing is so great!

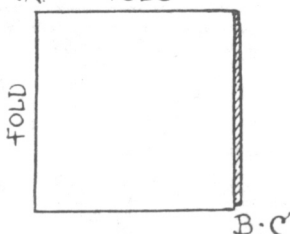
Among the fine people attending this affair was Dorothy Stark who told me of the easiest way to make a circle skirt. It will require a material that is 60 inches wide, and you will need 60 inches of it. You will also need some good quality elastic belting in a co-ordinating color.

To begin, you will fold you 60 inch square of fabric in half, and then in quarters as shown below.

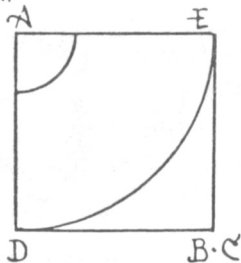
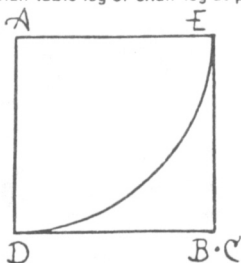

Next, place on a cutting board, if you have one, and pin in a few places. Tie a soft pencil or piece of chalk to the end of a piece of string that is more than 30 inches long. Secure a thumbtack at point A on the fabric, and knot the free end of your string around the tack so that your pencil just reaches point D. Draw your quarter circle from D to E. Next, measure up from D to A the finished length of your skirt PLUS one and one half inches (point F). Remove the string from the tack and re-knot it on the tack so that your pencil will correspond with point F. Make another circle here for the waistline..... NOTE, if you don't have a cutting board, lay the fabric on the floor and place a small table leg or chair leg at point A in place of a tack.

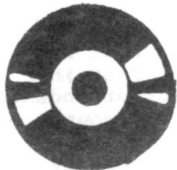

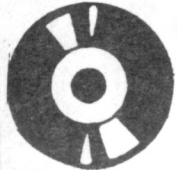

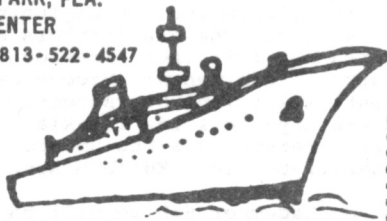

The International Association of Round Dance Teachers

One hundred and sixty two Round Dance Leaders from 25 states, 2 Canadian Provinces and the Netherlands attended the 4th annual ROUNDALAB (The International Association of Round Dance Teachers, Inc.) Convention in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, October 26 thru 28. The interest and willingness of leaders to share their knowledge, expertise and talents is highly evident in the accomplishments of this convention.

A standardized cue word list, an abbreviation list, and the teaching aids requested by CALLERLAB for Phase I & Phase II of Round Dancing were adopted for a one year period. The format for the selection of a ROUNDALAB list of classic Round Dances was approved.

ROUNDALAB members present voted to eliminate the attendance requirement necessary for maintaining membership for teachers who have been teaching for more than three years.

A Publications Committee, an Ethics Committee, a Committee on drafting contracts, and an Accreditation Committee for both schools and teachers were established. The Education Committee provided educational sessions and two teaching clinics on Monday.

Most areas of Phase I thru Phase V of Round Dancing, including the Latin Rhythms, as defined by the Standard Definition and Description Committee were accepted by the membership.

Jack Chaffee of Arizona was elected Chairman for a second term. Also serving on the Board of Directors are Bruce & Roberta Bird (KS), Edith Capon (TN), Darlene Chaffee (AZ), Irv & Betty Easterday (MD), Dave & Shirley Fleck (OH), Don & Pete Hickman (TX), Harmon & Betty Jorritsma (CA), Charlie & Madeline Lovelace (FL), Clancy & Betty Mueller (IN), Bud & Shirley Parrott (OR), Corky & Paulette Pell (TX), Doc & Peg Tirrell (NJ), and Wayne & Norma Wylie (AZ). Charlie Capon was elected Executive Secretary.

The fifth annual meeting of ROUNDALAB will be in San Antonio, Texas, October 25th thru 27th, 1981.

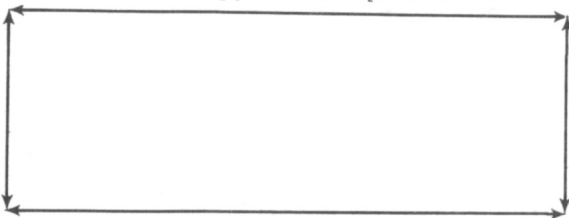
