CALLEHLAB was held in Miami Beach March 31 through April 2 and made several important changes which concern Mainstream dancers and callers.

The Mainstream Program has been revised in the following manner: Inside Out and Outside In along with Single File Turn Back have been dropped from the list; Touch to a Wave and Touch 1/4 have been added to the list. The list has been somewhat rearranged and renumbered so as to provide levels of dance below the Mainstream Level for rural areas and infrequent dancers. The following calls have been moved from the Extended Basics Program to the Mainstream Basics Program: Alamo Style/Balance; Turn Thru; Eight Chain Thru; Sweep a Quarter; Pass to the Center; and Spin the Top. Touch and Touch 1/4 were placed in the Extended Basics Program. The list is now numbered as follows: Basic Program (1 - 34), Extended Program (35 - 47), and Mainstream Program (48 - 68). Copies of the list are available from CALIERLAB, Box 679, Pocono Pines, PA 18350.

The following calls were dropped from the Quarterly Selection list:
Make Me a Column; Two Steps at a Time; Touch 1/2; Touch 3/4. These calls
were not added to the Flus 1 or Flus 2 lists. The current Quarterly Selection
list consist of the following calls: Roll (as an extension); Track II;
Extend (the Tag); Dixie Derby; Ping Pong Circulate; Track and Trade; and
Linear Cycle. In the future there will be no new Quarterly Selections
during the summer quarter so time can be spent reviewing all current calls
with new graduates.

There were no changes made in the Plus 1 or Plus 2 lists. These lists are up for revision at next year's convention.

A final non-convention note: CALLERIAB has recommended a review of Cloverleaf and Spin the Top during the current quarter. Come on now, guys (and gals), find yourself three new, interesting, flowing ways to use each of these two calls.
