INTRODUCING FLORIDA'S ROUND DANCE LEADERS

- EARLE & LEE KASTNER



The Kastners came to Boynton Beach from New Jersey in 1967. Having taught dancing to pre-teens and teenagers, they just naturally took to round dance activity, and, after many lessons and lots of practice they joined the Holiday Steppers Club. This meant a 70 mile drive every Sunday night. When they moved to Bonita Springs they found very little round dancing. so they took up square dancing. The club caller Lloyd Hill, asked them to teach and cue the rounds at the square dances, thus starting a

trend which mushroomed rapidly. A round dance club was formed, the Tamiami Steppers, and from basic to EZ rounds to Intermediate was only a matter of time. From this beginning the Kastners started a number of Basic Classes in this area, and 90% of the round dancers are either Basic or EZ round dancers of the Kastners teaching. They have been an inspiration with their enthusiasm and patience in teaching round dancing. Their activities over the years have included the following: Chairman of the Pageant of Light S/R Dance since 1974, and also cued the rounds since 1971; [this is an annual event held in Ft Myers in honor of Thomas Edison]; participated in several week end dance festivals [cueing and teaching]; held exhibition dances with the Tamiami Stepper members at various Civic organizations and Convalescent Homes [Christmas, Thanksgiving, 4th of July, etc.] Were co-chairman of the Florida Round Dance Council Festival and will be again in October 1980. They now have two basic, two EZ and two Intermediate classes, and also cue the rounds at three square dance clubs each week, besides the Tamiami Steppers each Sunday. They are members of many Round Dance Organizations.

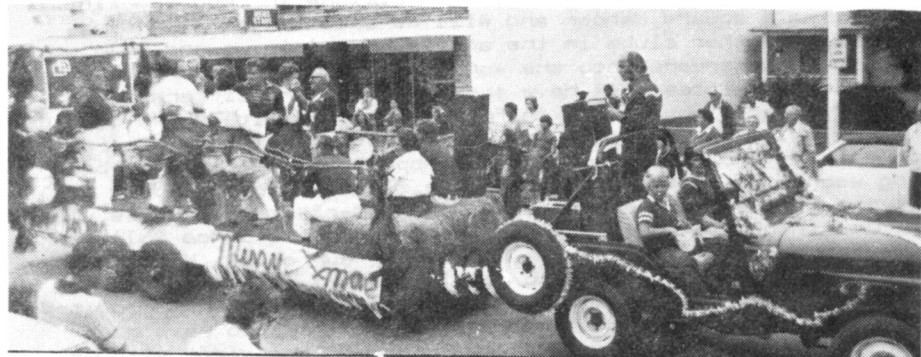
