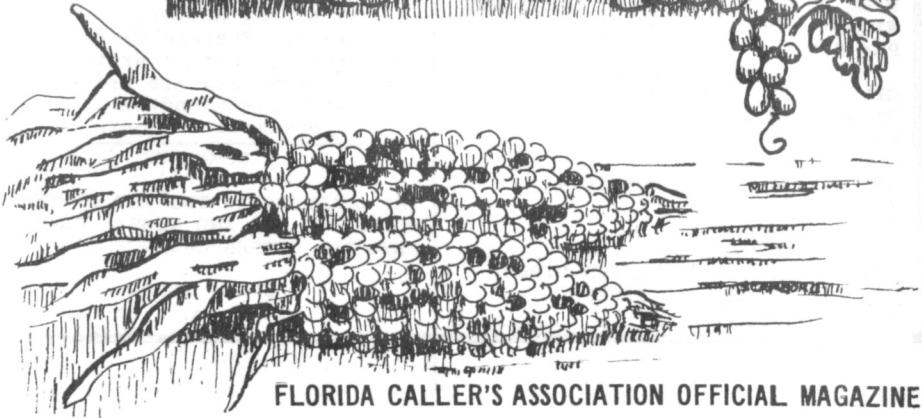

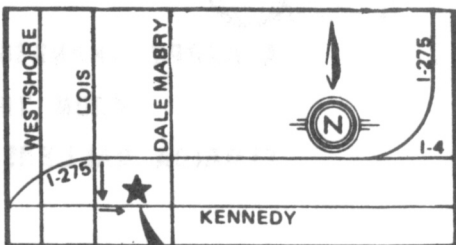

President's Message



found it to be worthwhile. This clinic was devoted to teaching, and I would like to briefly comment on this aspect of calling.

It is very satisfying (and quite ego building) to stand on the stage of State Convention and call to 200 squares, but I think callers should continually remind themselves that State Convention would not be a reality if callers did not teach classes. Square dance classes are the very foundation upon which all other aspects of the activity depend. There are callers who will spend hours practicing a singing call or working on workshop material for a festival (material they may never call again!), but who never stop to analyze the way they teach a particular basic in class. Somehow this seems to be a case of putting the cart before the horse.

I would like to ask all callers to pause for a few minutes to think about their classes: What is your attitude toward classes? Do you

consider them an important part of your program, or are they a nuisance you would prefer to do without? Can your teaching order be improved? Is there a better way to teach a troublesome basic? Are there ways you can make your classes more fun? Are there ways to improve interactions between club members and class members now that will make the class-to-club transition easier later?

I would also like to ask something of dancers reading this column; You would not be enjoying this activity unless a caller had taught you to dance. You may not be dancing to that caller anymore -- it is a truism that the best teachers are not necessarily the best callers (and vice versa!) -- but the next time you see him, take a moment to thank him for teaching you to dance. It'll make his teaching seem more worthwhile; he may even spend more time on improving his teaching; and if he does, he'll produce better dancers.

And that is good for square dancing.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE FLORIDA FEDERATION

The Federation meeting at Tampa was well attended by delegates from each of the five areas in the state. From the Area reports, square dancing activities, blood banks, and area associations are doing well. It's by reports such as these that we know what is going on in the other areas of the state. Reports were also given on the next State Conventions through 1983. These committees are already hard at work on their conventions.

Alan and Bertha Ashcroft gave the final report on the 1980 Convention. Alan stated that attendance was excellent, dancers enjoyed the activities, and that it was also a financial success. The proceeds are divided between the Federation, the Florida Callers Association, the Round Dance Council, and the host association, which was the Southeast this year.

Joe Vaccari reported on the formation of the National Square Dancers Association to which he is a delegate from the Federation. This organization was formed to

enable the promotion of square dancing on a broader scale than is now possible and to provide a line of communication between the various state organizations which does not now exist. It creates a united front from which to better represent the entire square dance movement in important issues and generally assist in the areas of education, promotion, and furthering the enjoyment of square and round dancing. I feel that any organization that helps dancing is an asset to the square dance movement and hope that the National Square Dancers Association is a great success.

As you can see from the above, the topics reported on and discussed are many and varied, so if you have not attended our meetings, please plan to do so in the future. Ask your Association when we are having our meetings and they will be glad to tell you.

CALLERLAB ANNOUNCES NEW QUARTERLY SELECTION

For the quarter beginning on October 1, 1980, CALLERLAB has selected one new movement for use in workshops at Mainstream Dances. This move was written by Lee Kopman and is called COUPLE UP. The definition and some dancing examples follow:

COUPLE UP: From any Box Circulate Foursome, ALL BOX CIRCULATE one place and, without stopping, those facing out turn back in the direction of body flow to end in facing pairs. (For Right Handed Boxes, the flow is to the right and for Left Handed Boxes, the flow is to the left.) Timing is 6 steps.

DANCING EXAMPLES

From Box 1-4: (Eight Chain Thru #23)
Touch 1/4, Scoot Back,
Couple Up, Pass Thru,
Wheel & Deal, Zoom
Centers Pass Thru, Allemande Left

From 1P2P: (facing lines #22)
Pass Thru, Boys Run,
Scoot Back, Couple Up,
Pass the Ocean, Girls Trade,
Boys Run, Everybody Promenade Home

From Static Square: (#14 on formations list)
Side Ladies Chain,
Heads Cross Trail Thru Around One
Make a Line of Four, Slide Thru,
Touch 1/4, Scoot Back,
Couple Up, Allemande Left

From Static Square: (#14)
Head Couples Slide Thru
Pass, Thru, Circle Four,
Head Gents Break and Make Two Lines
Pass Thru, Boys Run,
Couple Up, Allemande Left

Please remember that this is in the Quarterly Selection category and does not mean that all Mainstream dancers must learn the figure but only those groups that enjoy something extra. It should be workshopped before being called at any dance advertised as a Mainstream Dance.

It appears to be another good way to get into facing couples from waves. It can be varied as to girls or boys doing the turn back and can be called from any of the formation partner pairings that permit this definition to be used (APD).

Please note, however, that not all groups desire this call in other than standard positioning.

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

BEAU/BELLE CROSS.....*Lee Kopman*

From facing couples the action is as follows: The directed person, Beaus meaning the boys position will extend right hands and "pull by". If the call is Belle Cross the girls position will extend right hands and pull by. At mainstream I have kept the Boys as Beaus and the Girls as Belles so as not to create a challenge situation of APD. From lines facing, the beaus cross ends in a left hand wave and a Belles cross ends in a right hand wave.

The Call is easily taught and mastered and has a variety of starting formations and was very well received by our dancers. Give it a try and follow the examples for ideas of where to start the action...

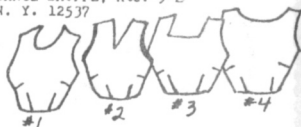

NEEDLE POINTS

Half the fun of square and round dancing is in the costumes we wear. And a good percentage of our dancers keep their sewing machines hot, running up all those little hems on miles and miles of ruffles, etc.

We think it's time for BOW & SWING to have a column for all the seamstresses and tailors to share their clever secrets for making square dance attire.

Our first contributor (of many, we hope) is Bev Whitney, of St. Cloud, Florida, with the following:

LINER OR OVERSKIRT

A good trick of Carol Guyre's which helps in the "travel light" category is to make an overskirt to dress up for evening a plainer dress which you might have worn in the afternoon.

Her directions for an overskirt of this type are:

Finished length: 22" You will need 4 yards of a crisp fabric such as organza or Si Bonne (this is a type of lining fabric).

For the bottom tier, cut a strip 6 yards x 9". This will be folded in half to make the bottom ruffle.

Next cut a 4 yard strip 9" wide.

Cut a 3 yard strip 8" wide.

Cut a 2 yard strip 5" wide.

Use 3/8" elastic in the top of the casing (formed by turning over a hem on the top tier.) Use 1/2" seams throughout.

This overskirt can also be worn as a liner between your dress and crinoline.

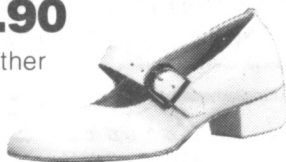

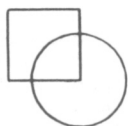

SQUARE DANCING IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The article "Square Dancing in the Public Schools" in the September, 1980 issue of BOW & SWING has evoked much discussion among Callers, Dancers, and Teachers. Whenever possible, letters and excerpts of letters on this important subject will be reprinted in BOW & SWING.

This month, we have two interesting letters -- one from a Teacher, and one from a Caller/Teacher.

LETTER FROM JACK WILLS, LEHIGH ACRES, FLORIDA, TO BILL ROUNDTREE

"In response to the letter from Bob Bland I would like to say that I greatly differ from him.

"Most school teachers are professional teachers to start with. I agree they may not know all they should know about square dancing. If Mr. Bland would talk to dancers who have quit he would learn that most of them are run off by callers. I have seen very few callers who are good teachers. Being a caller does not qualify one to be a teacher.....Looking at the schedules of some of these callers I don't think many of them have time to teach. I differ with Mr. Bland's idea of what a qualified teacher is. Any activity can be over regulated. I feel like I am a well qualified square dance teacher. I have been teaching for over six years but do not call and have no desire to do so.

"I usually have two or three groups per week in season, plus dancing two nights per week myself. After I get them up to about 50 Basics, I try to guide them on to some local callers for the balance of Mainstream.

"I will take small groups usually at mobile home parks where the hall is free, and have two or three squares. If there were one hundred or more people like me in each state there would be twice as many dancers.

"Millions of people in small towns and communities who want to dance do not have the opportunity as no one will teach them.

"If Bob Ruff's advertisement is correct in the Square Dance Maga-

zine, there are a lot more school teachers teaching square dancing than there are callers.

"I do not think at the present time that there is a problem about teaching square dancing in public schools unless Mr. Bland causes one.

"I know of a lot of counties that do not have any square dancing. Would Mr. Bland have them wait until he can get there to teach them? I know of several dancers who are qualified to teach dancing and if all callers had to be qualified and checked by the dancers, the callers directory in Bow and Swing would be much smaller than it is."

EXCERPTS FROM BILL ROUNDTREE'S REPLY TO JACK WILLS:

"Differences of opinion are fine, as of course we cannot all totally agree with one another in everything. Perhaps this is one media to find out opinions of different persons as we do need to do any any subject.

"We would like to compliment you in teaching groups square dancing to the extent of your ability and then turning them over to qualified square dance instructors. Being a dancer, you undoubtedly are definitely qualified to teach the first fifty basics, plus your professional teaching ability also qualifies you.

"May we say that you are an exception to the school teachers teaching still from the Ed Durlacher records that came out many years ago. Bob Ruff's records are great teaching aids, if they were only used nationally in the schools. To our regret, having taught many school children here in Florida myself in the past, I have learned that in many schools they are not taught properly."

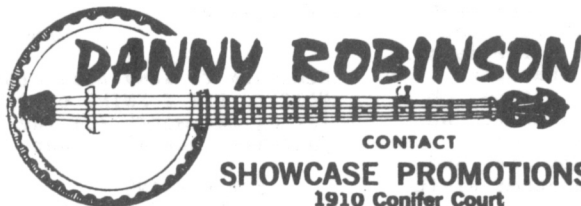

LETTER FROM DON WILEY OF KEY WEST TO BILL ROUNDTREE.

"I am very interested in the Square Dancing in School Systems, more particularly College for Credit.

"Our Florida Keys Community College offered to let me have classes under their sponsorship but *not for credit*. Due to many factors involved, I decided against it for this season but would like to get the course installed in the Fall of 1981 *FOR CREDIT*, probably under *ART* and Sciences.

"The college wanted to try it without credit to see what response there may be. I didn't feel that response *without credit* would indicate response *with credit*.

"I suggest that Abraham Baldwin College (ABAC) in Tifton, Georgia be contacted, since they have a very active program there.

"Also, I received 4.3 credit hours from Western North Carolina University this summer for attending Caller College (Stan Burdick, John Kaltenthaler, and Cal Golden) at Andy's Trout Farm in Dillard, Georgia. This was under their Continuing Education Program.

"Besides this, last year I taught ten one-hour sessions to five classes in Physical Education at Key West High School. Many of the students would have taken classes if it were during school hours, more if it were for credit, instead of Physical Education or other elective.

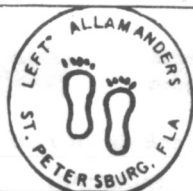

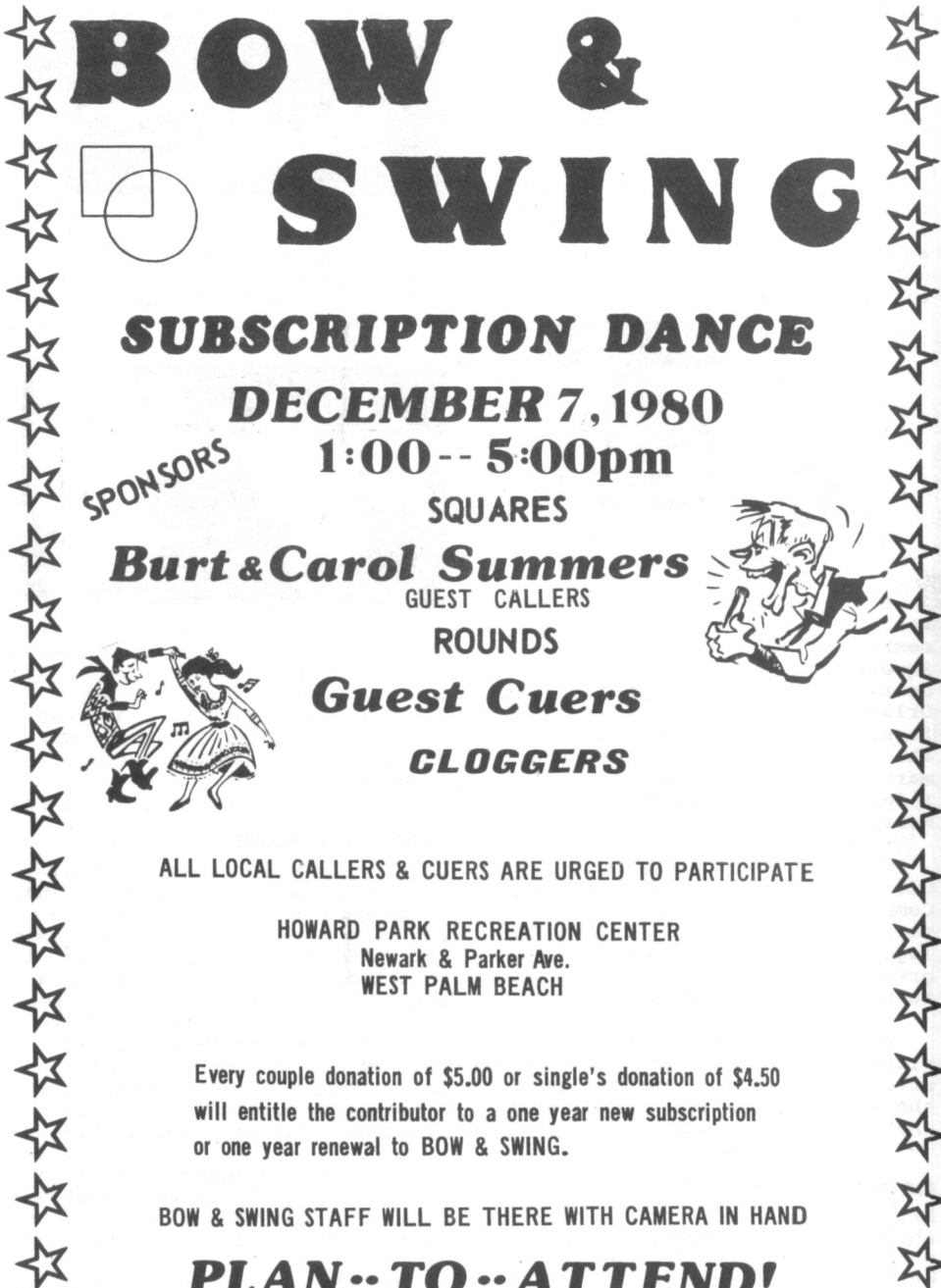

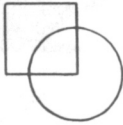
