SQUARE DANCING IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The following is a recent letter from Bob Bland, President of the Central Florida Callers Association to Bill Roundtree, President of the Florida Callers Association.

Dear Bill:

As President of the Central Florida Callers Association and Past President of Southeast Florida Callers Association it has been brought to my attention on several occasions that we as professional callers are faced with a serious problem. I refer to the teaching of square dancing in the Florida Public School System.

First of all it appears to be used in most cases as a "Rhythmic exercise" in athletic programs and taught in the main by unqualified instructors. By unqualified, I refer of course to the teaching of square dancing, *not*, and I repeat, *NOT* the qualifications of teaching athletics. There is no doubt in my mind that the men and women engaged in the sport activities of any given school are highly qualified in their field as coaches and instructors of baseball, football, basketball, tennis, golf and many other related athletic skills.

How square dancing can be related to a sporting activity is highly debatable. Why square dancing any more than any type of ballroom dancing? Ballroom dancing is just as rhythmic and in some cases more so! But I seriously doubt the qualifications of any of the athletic instructors to teach *any* type of dancing. As a square dance caller and instructor I certainly would not be so presumptuous that I could be qualified to teach an athletic program!

Secondly, much of the so-called square dancing that is being used in the public school systems falls in the category of Traditional which is defined by CALLERLAB as to be pre-1950. While there is nothing wrong with traditional square dancing, and we as professional callers know there is a place for it, the public school system is *not* the place for it. If it must be taught in the public schools at all, then it should be upgraded just as any other subject taught should be.

Teachers are required periodically to update themselves and to keep current of the growth of any subject they teach. If they do not, then their teaching certificates are not "current" and therefore they are penalized in the pocket-book!

I speak from first hand knowledge as my wife has been a teacher in the Florida Public School System, and in other state school systems as well. Therefore I question again, if square dancing is to be taught in the schools at all, why shouldn't the instructors be required to be **QUALIFIED** in the subject.

I submit to you the end result are people graduated from the public school system with a very negative impression of square dancing. As square dancing is just as much a part of the history and heritage of this great country of ours, then it behooves us to teach it right so that a person graduated from a course of American History will have a full knowledge of what it is all about.

Knowing that the Public School System is a state level organization and inasmuch as the Florida Callers Association is at state level, it appears that there should possibly be a meeting at that level to see what can be done to rectify the problem. If a meeting at that level cannot be, then I suggest that the Florida Callers Association approach CALLERLAB about the problem. No doubt that if Florida has the problem, then other states have the same or similar problem.

We, as professional square dance callers, know that probably in any given area there is one or more qualified callers that could and probably would gladly be of any help to rectify the problem locally.

Hopefully, there will be a solution to these problems in the near future to the mutual satisfaction of all concerned.

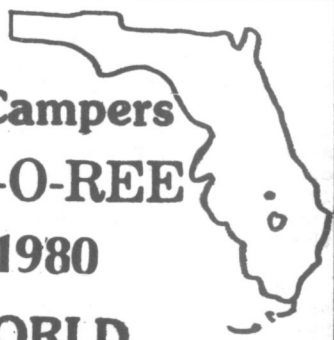

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

STROLL DOWN THE LANE...*Lee Kopman*

Stroll down the lane is one of the family of experimentals that can be fun for awhile but in the long run I doubt that it will last...The action is interesting, mainstream in makeup and times well but do we really need it???

Starting from a 1P-2P line, the action has three parts for the ends and three parts for the centers. Let's start with the ends action. Ends step forward and take a right forearm hold with the opposite then do a recycle action behind the centers and finish with a veer to the left. The ends will finish as the couple facing in, in a forming two-faced line. The centers action has the girls step ahead and touch right hands then hinge 1/4 as the center boys face to the left the girls pick them up as in a flutter wheel, then couples hinge and extend to become the facing out couples in the two-faced line. The center action has an incomplete flutter type action and once smoothes out the entire figure will dance smoothly.

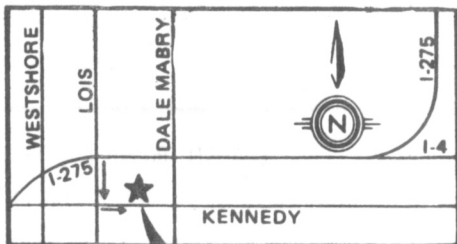

The International Association of Round Dance Teachers

To enable Round Dancers to better evaluate a round dance, ROUNDALAB, the International Association of Round Dance Teachers, has adopted a point system devised by Dave & Shirley Fleck of Toledo, Ohio. Introduced at the 26th National Square Dance Convention in Atlantic City, the Fleck Rating, as it has come to be known, was carefully studied, evaluated, and slightly modified before its formal acceptance by the ROUNDALAB membership.

Basically every dance figure and/or combination, dance position and the repetition and lay-out of sequence are assigned a point value. By using a special formula, a total figure is determined for every dance. The Point System committee is working closely to coordinate its evaluation with the Standardization Committee.

By comparing the dance rating number to the current "guide", a Round Dance teacher and/or dancer can more accurately determine where a dance fits in the total round dance picture. These are the plateaus currently in use:

0-60	easy - for non round dancers
61-125	square dance rounds
126-175	easy intermediate
176-250	intermediate
251-299	high intermediate

The determination for the various plateaus among the advanced to challenge dances falling in the 300 and above rating will be determined at the next meeting of ROUNDALAB.

Some dance record companies and Round Dance Magazines include this point rating on their cue sheets. All choreographers are encouraged to send their cue sheet, and record if possible, to Dave & Shirley Fleck, 3444 Orchard Trail Drive, Toledo, Ohio 43606, prior to releasing their dance, so that the point rating can be included with the final release.

There is no charge for this service.

ROUNDALAB, the International Association of Round Dance Teachers, Inc., will hold its fourth annual meeting at the University City Holiday Inn in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania October 26, 27 and 28, 1980.

The main emphasis this year will be the completion of the Standard Definitions and Descriptions under the direction of Clancy and Betty Mueller, Standardization Planning Committee Chairman.

The Education Committee, under the guidance of Harmon and Betty Joritsma, will move toward becoming one of the primary concerns at our annual meeting. Several workshops and educational sessions are planned for attendees.

Phases I and II of Round Dancing were finalized and defined at last year's annual ROUNDALAB meeting in San Diego. The remaining phases will be further explored, discussed, and defined.

Other items on the agenda include: the formal adoption of a cue sheet format; a report on the establishment of a classic Round Dance list (with updated cue sheets); a review of the Fleck Point System in rating dances & the development of advanced plateaus; discussions concerning cue work standardization and Round Dance term abbreviations; and at the request of CALLERLAB, the development of a suggested teaching progression for Phase I and II of Round Dancing together with suggested routines and/or dances for which clearly understandable cue sheets and records are available.
