NEWS from Fl. Assn. of National Square Dance Campers

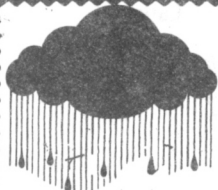

QUARTERLY SELECTIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

RELEASE RECYCLE

For the quarter beginning April 1, 1981, CALLERLAB has selected one new movement for use in workshops at Mainstream Dance. This move was written by Dick Kenyon and is called RELEASE RECYCLE. The definition and some dancing examples follow:

RELEASE RECYCLE: From a 1/4 Tag Formation, the ends of the Right Hand Wave and the outside Boys (beaus) extend to the dancer ahead of them and all finish like a RECYCLE. Ends in a starting Double Pass Thru formation. Timing is 6 steps.

From Static Square

Heads Pass the Ocean, RELEASE RECYCLE, Centers Pass Thru, Touch to a Wave, Recycle, Square Thru 3/4, Trade By, Left Allemande.

Heads Pass the Ocean, RELEASE RECYCLE, Double Pass Thru, Centers In, Cast Off 3/4, Star Thru, Centers Touch, RELEASE RECYCLE, Centers Pass Thru, Pass Thru, Trade By, Al. Left.

From 1p2p (Facing Lines)

Pass Thru, Wheel & Deal, Centers Step to a Wave, RELEASE RECYCLE, Centers Pass Thru, Box the Gnat, Grand Right & Left

Pass the Ocean, Girls Trade, Recycle, Veer Left, Ferris Wheel, Centers Step to a Wave, RELEASE RECYCLE, Zoom, Swing Thru, Turn Thru, Left Allemande.

Please remember that this is the Quarterly Selection for the quarter beginning April 1, 1981. It does not mean that all clubs or all dancers must use the call but rather is for groups that would like to try something extra. It should be workshopped before being used at any dance labeled Mainstream. For the majority of clubs, this call should be used with standard set-ups only (girl on the boy's right). For groups that can handle variations of Recycle, this call can be used from a variety of Boy-Girl arrangements. However, not all clubs enjoy or desire other than standard positioning.

CALLERLAB EXPLAINS ABOUT NEW MOVEMENTS

The CALLERLAB Executive Committee recently considered the following question: WHERE DO ALL THE NEW MOVEMENTS COME FROM? From around the world of square dancing we hear dancers talking about so many new movements. Sometimes they are complaints like "I wish CALLERLAB would quit putting out so many new movements." It is nice that they feel CALLERLAB does influence the selection of dance material, but they are incorrect to blame CALLERLAB for the vast amount of new material being written.

The problem of an overwhelming number of new movements, many of them poor choreographically, is not a new one. It has been with

us for years. CALLERLAB recognized this problem at its first convention in 1974 and took steps to help lessen the problem. Callers were introducing new movements into their regular dances with no thought of standardization or screening for danceability. Dancers might have to cope with several of these in a week of dancing, since one caller might select one thing, and another caller a different thing altogether. CALLERLAB felt that many dancers at the Mainstream level wanted some new material to experiment with but did not want to workshop all of the time. Consequently, CALLERLAB established the Quarterly Selection Committee and the QS Program at the 1974 convention.

CALLERLAB EXPLAINS... *(continued from Page 8)*

The Quarterly Selection Program was established to provide a means of screening new material and presenting selected movements to the square dance public for experimentation. It was not intended for development of movements for addition to the MS list or that all clubs *MUST* dance the Quarterly Selections. The idea was to provide a screening and standardization process so that all callers would have the same material if they wanted to introduce something new into their dance programs.

The Quarterly Selection Program was set up so that no more than two new movements could be selected for each quarter, or a maximum of eight each year. However, it was not mandatory that any new movement be selected, and it is important to note that there have been many quarters in which only one was selected and several in which *CALLERLAB selected no new movements*. According to the rules of the program, there can be no more than 10 movements on the QS list at the start of any year. The membership of CALLERLAB votes on the content of the list each year. Seldom have there been 10 movements listed. After a movement has been on the QS list for 3 years, a decision must be made to: 1) Recommend it be moved to the MS list, 2) remain on the QS list or 3) recommend it be dropped and considered for inclusion on some other list. Additions to the MS list are made with great care, since CALLERLAB is reluctant to expand that list. However,

common usage and dancer acceptance dictate some additions. Since the program began in 1974, we have seen Touch, Touch 1/4, Recycle and Ferris Wheel added to the MS list. Coordinate and Chase Right were added to the Plus I list and several movements used for awhile and subsequently dropped, such as 2 Steps at a Time and Make Me a Column. (Dancer reaction to these calls was negative.) These examples show how the system works.

In recognition that many clubs do not dance during the summer, it was decided in 1980 *NO NEW MOVEMENTS* would be selected for the summer quarter. Consequently, the hundreds of new movements that come out each year are distilled to no more than six under the CALLERLAB Quarterly Selection Program.

Of course, the system works only as well as the callers make it work. CALLERLAB has no control over the individual caller except to encourage him to support the CALLERLAB Programs and work within the system. If he still chooses to flood his dancers with new material, there is nothing CALLERLAB can do. However, in the this case, dancers should look to the source of the problem and not blame CALLERLAB. CALLERLAB is *NOT* responsible for introducing vast amounts of new material into square dancing. Its goal, through the QS Program, is to provide *REASONABLE EXPERIMENTATION* for those Mainstream Clubs and Dancers who desire it.

HOME SEWING FASHION

Here is a beautiful combination of square dance dress and western shirt.

The couple is Libby and Dick Kerns, who dance with the Big Potato Squares in Apopka, Florida.

Libby was the expert seamstress. She used black Coupe de Ville (a polyester fabric) as the basis for both dress and shirt.

The dress consists of an 8-gored skirt with lace (rayon & acetate) trim, and an 8-gored lace overskirt with a pointed hem, coubly accented with a lace ruffle and black ribbon. The dress bodice has lace front and back yokes, also edged with lace ruffling and black ribbon.

Incidentally, Libby used a wide lace edging and doubled it over -- not quite in half -- giving the effect of two tiers of edging.

Dick's shirt has a lace yoke, both front and back, and lace cuffs. The shirt pockets are trimmed with lace piping, and the arrows are hand embroidered.

After much trouble and wasted time looking for just the right lace (I buy when things are on sale), I decided to take time to sort out my lace -- roll up each piece and put them in individual small size BAGGIES. 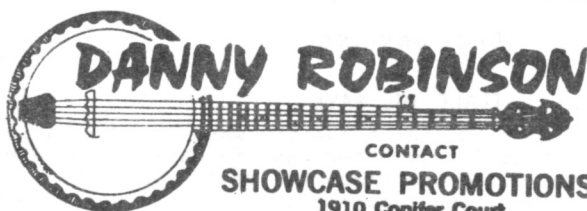

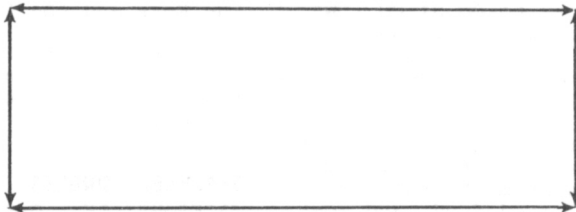

Excerpts from a Letter to CALLERLAB

In the article, "Sound Off for Quality Dancing", it said CALLERLAB is interested in dancers' comments. With that in mind, here goes:

I attend many dances in the Ft. Myers area and I am becoming more and more dismayed at the ever decreasing emphasis on styling for which I think the callers (instructors) must bear most (not all) of the responsibility. I say not

all because there are some who, while they know the figures, will never be more than drillers or plodders. Some examples:

Courtesy Turn - This graceful and elegant movement, when executed with man's palm up, ladies' palm down and attendant skirt work, many times degenerates into a finger grabbing, thumb twisting, wrist lock, forearm clutch gyration.

Swing - This is probably the most exhilarating movement in square dancing when executed properly, but is often executed as a chase around the maypole, leapfrog spin, or a dozen varieties of whirling der-vishes.

Weaving - This should epitomize the supple, pliant flow of dancers passing each other but is used by some to apparently demonstrate the Staggers.

Skirt Work - So coquettish - so feminine. I think some ladies, if asked to use it, would reply, "What is it?" Certainly during classes and workshops, a caller could, and should, emphasize it repeatedly.

Square DANCING should be a thing of grace, elegance and rhythm, executed with elan and panache; not a drill field exercise performed as a chore.

You callers are the nerve center, the command post, the dynamos that make it all work. You ARE square dancing -- without you there is nothing; and so upon you rests the responsibility of teaching it as an art form and insisting on proper styling -- then when you lead a set moving gracefully through a tip, you can throw out your chests, give a happy grin and say, "Now they're doing it our way."

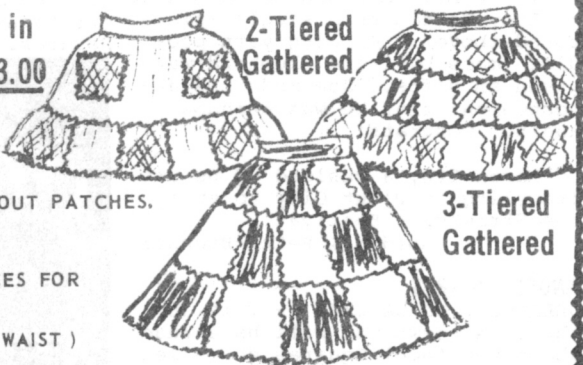
