REPORT OF DENVER MEETING

One hundred and eighty-five leaders from thirty-one states and three Canadian provinces, representing every facet of the square dance activity, gathered in Denver, Colorado May 14-17 for LEGACY V, the international leaders' communications group of the square dance activity.

The LEGACY conference is an invitational meeting of leaders who gather, at their own expense, for the exchange of ideas. The primary concerns of dancers, as shown by the results of a poll conducted by LEGACY Trustees last year, were recruitment and retention; leadership; auxiliary programs and the social aspects and pleasures of the overall activity. These areas were explored in depth.

A Leadership Manual, compiled by a committee of Trustees, was distributed to the attendees. For information concerning the purchase of this excellent manual, individually or in quantity, contact LEGACY, 1812 Pelton Avenue, Bellevue, NE 68005.

Newly elected Trustees to the Board of Directors are Bob & Dottie Elgin, Pennsylvania, Gene & Alice Maycroft, Michigan, John & Vivian McCannon, Texas, Angus McMorran, Canada, and Harriet Miles, Arizona. They join Stan & Cathie Burdick, Ohio, Joe & Phyllis Casey, New Hampshire, Bill & Mary Jenkins, New York, John & Freddie Kaltenthaler, Pennsylvania, Jim & Jan Maczko, California, Bob & Martha McNutt, Washington, Clancy & Betty Mueller, Indiana, Doc & Peg Tirrell, New Jersey, Jim & Ellen White, Georgia, and Wayne & Norma Wylie, Arizona, who are already serving on the Board. Bob & Becky Osgood, California, and Bob & Phyllis Howell of Ohio will serve as advisors. Doc & Peg Tirrell were elected Chairmen of LEGACY; Dick & Jan Brown will continue to serve as Executive Secretaries.

LEGACY V was not all work and no

play. Trustees were invited to participate in an evening of traditional and area dances of a wide variety. The final evening brought an electric performance by the Calico and Boots, a group of young people who dance in the ebullient manner and pioneer costumes of Dr. Lloyd (Pappy) Shaw's Cheyenne Mountain Dancers, who delighted audiences from coast to coast in the '30's and '40's.

The next meeting, LEGACY VI, will be May 12-15, 1983 in St. Louis, Missouri.

SQUARE DANCE WEEK UPDATE

The dates starting with the 3rd Monday and continuing through the following Sunday of September each year are timed to coordinate with the start of new classes throughout North America. Proclamations of local, state and provincial leaders put square dancing into the view of millions.

The goal of this year's observance is 100% participation by all square dancers and square dance groups with the ultimate goal of increasing the interest and participation in this great activity.

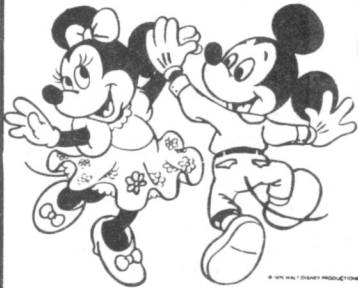

25 Years of Dancing with FLORIDA KNOTHEADS INC.

"To promote fellowship, fun and merriment among square dancers in Florida" is the expression coined in an early bulletin of the FLORIDA KNOTHEADS.

The ORIGINAL SQUARE of Florida Knotheads, Bill & Ruthe Muench, Jim & Helen Galloway, Pat and "Mac" McClumpha, and Kay & Ed Mack obtained a charter and designed the Florida badge.

The Florida Knothead Badge, a black rectangle with stick figures, is our REGISTERED TRADEMARK and belongs solely to FLORIDA KNOTHEADS, INC.

Bill Muench served as chairman for 5 years with Kay Mack, Secretary, and Helen Galloway, Treasurer. Jim Galloway, our 2nd chairman, served in that capacity until his untimely death in 1971. A donation to the Florida Sheriff's Boy's Ranch was made in his honor. Ed Mack is present chairman, Pat McClumpha, secretary, and Helen Galloway, treasurer. In 1969 Bill & Ruthe Muench resigned from the board of directors, citing other interests kept them from putting in the time needed for konvention work.

In 1975, two couples, Billi & George Dermer and Byrdie & Marty Martin were added to the permanent staff. The Dermers handle new membership and konvention registrations and the Martins are responsible for konvention programming.

Florida Knotheads Inc., promote an annual konvention for members only.

The TRAIL DANCE preceding the knothead konvention is open to those who are pre-registered for the konvention and to those dancers who seek membership and who can meet the 100 miles needed for qualifying. (Home P.O. to the Tampa P.O.) After applying for membership, they then register for the konvention.

AWARD STRIPS and BADGES are given to members attending the konvention. the FIRST PIN issued to members is a bar showing 5 stick figures and is given to members who attend the konvention for 5 YEARS IN SUCCESSION. This bar is for the members to keep. The sixth consecutive year, a number bar is issued which in turn can be exchanged the following year for the 7th year pin, etc.

The 25th Annual Konvention will have 14 members who will be receiving their 25th successive year pin. The members with perfect attendance are as follows:

A knothead newsletter was published in our 2nd year, but was of short duration. We soon took up the offer of a column in the state square dance publication, the *BOW & SWING*. First major promotion project was in 1959, when the FLORIDA KNOTHEADS underwrote the HOLIDAY FOR ROUNDS in Clearwater. From this festival the Round Dance Council of Florida was formed.

Another promotion effort of the group in 1961 was the distribution of 20,000 pamphlets on the history and purpose of square dancing.

Clearwater was our konvention home site from 1956 to 1969. When the Jack Tar Hotel changed hands, we lost use of two large dancing areas and so the move to Tampa for the 1970 konvention.

Back to Clearwater for the years of '71, '72, '73 and '74 when the Jack Tar hotel again became available. In 1974 we once

again lost a major hall for our dancing when the Clearwater Auditorium was razed, just two weeks before our konvention. And once again the move to Tampa for the large quarters of the Curtis-Hixon Konvention Center. That phrase, "ALL ACTIVITIES UNDER ONE ROOF" is welcome indeed.

First year records a total of 461 Knothead members. Today we have a record 32,300 members.

At the first Konvention, 392 members registered, an almost perfect attendance.

Memories and more memories! Nevertheless, Knothead history wouldn't be complete without giving thought to "Mac" McClumpha, who

passed away in 1958 and to Kay Mack in 1980. To Jim, Mac, and Kay whose memories will always be with us, we pay tribute.

Four couples or more must travel 100 miles or more to a club or open dance, dance one full tip together, and let it be known the purpose of the visit -- get the club caller to sign the filled-out membership application, and mail to the Florida Knotheads, Inc.

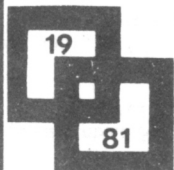

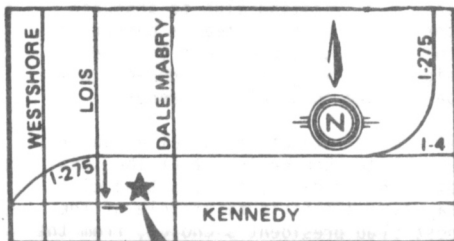

BANNER STEALING

The American Square Dance has always epitomized the best in "good ol' fashioned hospitality and friendship." As we dance "around the square" by visiting many of the area clubs, we discover that getting to know our square dance neighbors is as much fun today as it was 200 years ago. "Stealing" another club's banner has become the standard form of club visitation these days. It has been noted on occasion that some folks are not clear on protocol regarding the stealing and/or retrieving of a club banner. The following guidelines were obtained from the Central Florida Square and Round Dancers Association and presented herewith in the spirit of keeping all our square dance friends informed. One parting thought -- Stealing a banner is fun, but it should not be the only reason for visiting another club. Remember, the original idea, which was a good one, was to share the joy of square dancing with new and old friends. So, whether you come away with a club banner or not, you are the winner if you added to the fellowship of the evening. Happy dancing.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A banner may be stolen by a minimum of one full square, in good standing as club members, displaying club badges of the club they are representing and pay guest admission.
2. The banner can be stolen only on a regular club dancing night.
3. If two clubs appear on the same night to steal a banner from the same club, the first visiting club to announce their intention to steal a banner to the host club's president (or the highest ranking officer present) will be allowed to steal the banner.
4. If a club attempts to steal a banner and if the banner is not at the location of the dance, the visiting club may take a substitute article of the host club president's choice, from the president or his wife. If the president or his wife is not present, then

the substitute article may be taken from the highest ranking officer present, or his wife.

5. The banner may be retrieved by the owner club by observing requirement Number 1.
6. A club cannot retrieve their banner and steal a club banner at the same time, even if more than the minimum visitors are present.
7. No recovering group can retrieve more than one banner per evening.

ETHICS:

1. A club will not steal a banner from another club more often than one time every six months.
2. A club will not travel more than 60 miles to steal a banner, except by the invitation of the intended host club.
3. A club, having had its banner stolen, will make every effort to recover the banner in a reasonably short period of time. If a club does not recover its banner in six months, the banner shall be returned to the owner club.
4. If a banner is stolen, the officials of the host club should be notified of the date, time and place the visiting club has its regular dances.
5. A club will not have more than one travel banner.
6. If a traveling banner has been stolen, the club will not display its club banner, except at special dances.
7. A club cannot steal a banner or retrieve its banner when their club caller is guest caller of the club they are visiting.
8. If a large group is traveling to steal a banner it is strongly recommended that the host club be notified.

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP Mainstream Possibilities

TOUCH & FLUTTER.....Al. Appleton

Facing dancers will Touch 1/4, the in-facing dancers will, as in a reverse flutter, extend left hands as the outfacers right about face and finish as in a reverse flutterwheel. The action is easily mastered and well liked by the dancers.

HINGE & FLUTTER.....Ron Schneider

This is really the same action as a touch & flutter except the hinge is used if the wave is already established. Logical extension and dances well.
