actually expedited the presentation of the Resolution for a Senate vote during Square Dance Week.

SJR #59 has been sent to the Post Office and Civil Service Committee of the House of Representatives, where HJR #151 (a companion resolution which also designates the SQUARE DANCE the National Folk Dance of the United States of America) will come up for consideration in February, 1982. BUT - HJR 151 MUST BE CO-SPONSORED BY 218 MEMBERS OF CONGRESS before action will be taken on either resolution.

The name of the game is GET A CO-SPONSOR. Address side:

### **HOW CAN YOU HELP?**

Write, call, or visit your representative. Ask a friend to do the same. Tell him/her that the Senate passed SJR #59 and ask him/her to Co-sponsor HJR #151 before February 1982. (You may check his/her action by requesting a computer printout of Co-sponsors from his/her District Office in your area.
