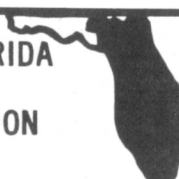

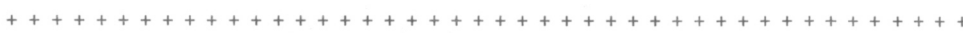

actually expedited the presentation of the Resolution for a Senate vote during Square Dance Week.

SJR #59 has been sent to the Post Office and Civil Service Committee of the House of Representatives, where HJR #151 (a companion resolution which also designates the SQUARE DANCE the National Folk Dance of the United States of America) will come up for consideration in February, 1982. BUT - HJR 151 MUST BE CO-SPONSORED BY 218 MEMBERS OF CONGRESS before action will be taken on either resolution.

"We urge you to Co-Sponsor HJR 151, a resolution to designate the SQUARE DANCE as the National Folk Dance of the U.S.A., introduced in the House of Representatives February 2, 1981 by Congressman Norman Mineta of San Jose, California.
