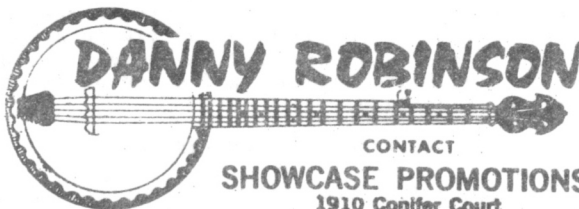

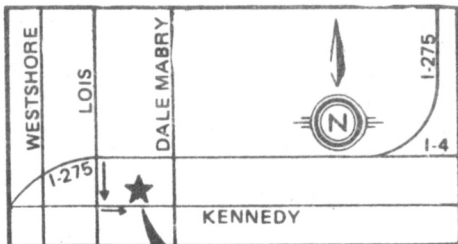

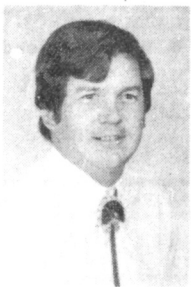

## The International Association of Square Dance Callers

### SOUND OFF FOR QUALITY DANCING

A major thrust of CALLERLAB in the next few years will be in the area of education - training for new callers, continuing education for experienced callers, better teaching methods, etc. After the 1980 CALLERLAB Convention in Miami Beach it was felt that the theme for the 1981 Convention in Kansas City might well deal with education. However, in discussing and planning for the 1981 Convention, the Executive Committee posed the question, "Education for what?" The answer to the question, developed after much discussion, and the theme of the 1981 Convention, is QUALITY DANCING. CALLERLAB'S goal, is, in fact, quality dancing for, what we hope will be, an increasing square dance public. It is a goal in which dancers obviously have an interest and an investment. The attainment of this goal will require caller-dancer participation and cooperation.

We solicit your comments to your local callers, your local callers' association, or to CALLERLAB.

The Plus Lists will come up for review this coming Convention (Kansas City in April) and any comments you may have for the composition of those lists could be sent to CALLERLAB, Box 679, Pocono Pines Pa. 18350, or to Jerry Schatzer, Chairman of the Plus Level Committee, 1021 N. Crescent Hts. #201, Los Angeles, Ca. 90046.

# THE OTHER SIDE OF THE COIN

by Les Gotcher

*Les Gotcher is one of Square Dancing's Pioneers. When memorized patterns were the vogue, he introduced "Hash" calling, and made it an art, and was known as "The King of Hash". He is a Square Dance Hall of Fame member, and a Life Member of the Florida Callers Association. He authored many books on Square Dancing, and at one time produced a magazine, "Square and Round".*

DUPLICATION OF NAMES --  
re: "Couple Up"

I note that Jack Lasry of Hollywood, Florida says that one should not argue with ONE THOUSAND Callers who have voted on the inclusion or exclusion of a certain new basic, and it behooves me to point out that Lee Kopman's new basic, "Couple Up" has not been voted on by anyone yet.

Jack goes on to point out that many hundreds of Callers participate in the selection of the calls and that WE should accept them and work toward making these programs work whether they are right or wrong. Of course, my first question to this would be, "WHY"? Why, if they happen to be a duplication, or wrong in some other way, should we accept them? Why are we not BIG enough to admit that we made a mistake and seek to rectify that mistake as fast as we can do so?

On THE OTHER SIDE OF THE COIN, I ask, are we CALLERLAB members, and our opinions "Sacred"? Let me point out that there are approximately 1100 members in CALLERLAB. There is an estimated 10,000 to 11,000 Callers Worldwide. This means that we CALLERLAB members represent something like 10% to 15% of all the Callers in existence. So the question here is, should we consider ourselves sacrosanct, and without being consistent at all, simply try to cram our choices as to new basics down the throats of those whom we would, or should be trying to, recruit?

In Jack's article, he belittles the Burleson Encyclopedia by stat-

ing that the Burleson book serves no purpose unless you are a CALLERLAB member and want to check and see if something has been used before. In my own opinion, the Burleson book serves much more than just to check something if you are a CALLERLAB member. I think of the Burleson encyclopedia as more of a dictionary. It goes much further than just listing basics. It goes all the way back to the beginning of our modern square dancing picture and gives basics and terms and much more than just listing basics.

I would also point out that this book is used by Callers that are not in CALLERLAB. Thousands of Callers use this book. Each Caller looks at it differently. Jack indicates that the old "Couple Up" was a "Dead and Worthless" Basic. Who is to say which basic is Dead and Worthless? "Load the Boat" for instance, has been revived within the last 10 years. However, it was printed in one of my "copyrighted" books that went out to Callers more than 20 years ago. So it was revived. Who is to decide what other old basic will not be revived?

There are too many names floating around to decide one certain name, and one name only will do for a certain basic. For instance, "Couple Up" could have been called "Pair Up", or "Team Up", or a dozen other names I could list. So there is really no necessity to duplicate names.

Just recently two Callers, -- out-of-state Callers -- came in and called a Convention here in Tampa. Both of these Callers are members of CALLERLAB. However, they introduced things at the Convention that are not in CALLERLAB, and as far as I know have never been sent out as even workshop material by CALLERLAB. The two things that were used at the Convention are "Snake It" and "Climb The Wall". These are not something new and they just might be revived, but at this point they are NOT revived but are being taught by CALLERLAB members. WHY?

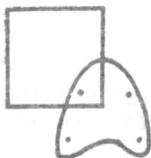

## EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

QUICK CYCLE .... *Lee Kopman*

Quick Cycle is a very smooth experimental that is quite easy to use. I start with the heads doing a pass thru and U turn back to a Touch 1/4. This sets up a split circulate box between the facing in couples. The boy in the center is facing the girl in the outside couple and he will step into a mini wave with her and those two will recycle as the others extend to the center to form another split circulate box between the facing in couples. The figure is easily danced APD as the only "tough" spot could be the apd recycle.

## ADVANCED QUARTERLY EXPERIMENTALS SELECTED BY CALLERLAB

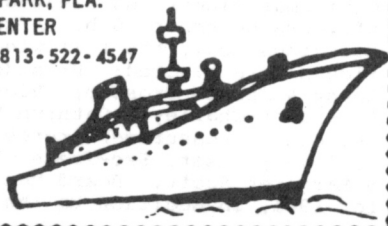

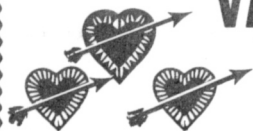

# The International Association of Round Dance Teachers

## CUE SHEETS

For the past several years, ROUNDALAB has studied various cue sheet formats. At its 3rd annual Convention, a Round Dance Cue Sheet Format was accepted for a year's trial basis by the membership. At the Philadelphia Convention, this format was adopted on a permanent basis. To help clarify cue sheets even further, a standardized Cue Word List and an Abbreviation List- ing was accepted for a one year

trial period. Throughout this year the membership will use these lists and carefully note any changes and/or additions needed. To secure the Fleck Point Rating for inclusion on the cue sheet, a choreographer need only send the typed cue sheet and record if possible, to Dave & Shirley Fleck, 3444 Orchard Trail, Toledo, Ohio 43606. There is no charge for this service which will take only a few days.

### ROUNDALAB CUE SHEET FORMAT

#### A. LEAD INFORMATION

1. Name of Dance
2. Composer - name and address with zip; phone number w/area code.
3. Label and Record Number; artist; (Flip side of \_\_\_\_\_ if applicable).
4. Cue Sheet release Date; playing speed (if other than 45);rhythm.
5. Footwork
6. Sequence: (ex. INTRO ABC ABC ENDING) put spacing in for logical breaks.

#### B. CUE LINE

ex. MEAS

1 - 4. (CP LOD) C,U,E,S; I,-,N,-; B,O,L,D; T,Y,P,E:

1. Use ROUNDALAB approved basic terms in CAPS and Standard Round Dance Abbreviations in describing dance steps and positions, taking care to use proper punctuation.
2. Cue words shall be underlined.
3. Space shall be left between each measure for clarity.
4. Supplementary information in parenthesis shall be included when necessary.

#### C. EXPLANATION OF THE CUE LINE

1. Detailed explanation of each measure shall be placed on its own numbered line except for partial or multiple measure patterns.
2. The timing of each measure may be placed to the left side of the explanation when deemed necessary. (ex. QQS)
3. Include body mechanics and posture when appropriate.
4. Explanation shall be such that the dancers can understand it.
5. Supplementary information in parenthesis shall be included when necessary.

#### D. OTHER INFORMATION

ROUNDALAB approved Fleck Point System, if included, should appear at the bottom of the cue sheet page.

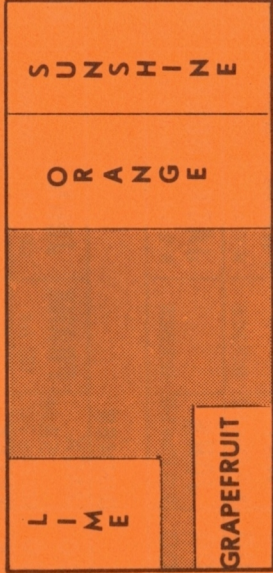

At another very large event in Lakeland they brought in a Caller from Northern California and he made a point, several times, of the fact that he was NOT A MEMBER OF CALLERLAB and that he was not obligated in any way to comply with any of their rules. As far as I can find out at this time, the Dancers didn't seem to care one way or the other whether he was a Member or not. He did call a good dance. The dancers liked him and gave him a terrific ovation, and, as I said, he did call a good dance.

So I guess my question is, "Do we back up things whether they are

right or wrong, or do we try to correct our own mistakes and look good to the thousands of other Callers out there that we are trying to recruit"?

In closing, I would like to point out that I did write some letters to members of the committee that selected "Couple Up" as the Quarterly Selection, and I have, at this point, received several answers, all agreeing that it was a mistake that would need watching in the future. Not one objected to my letters but agreed that they should have been on the ball and that Burleson's book would certainly be checked in the future.

dancers. Because they believe round dancing and square dancing should remain together, both the Richards and Smiths have contributed greatly to various institutes for square dance callers. They have been involved in leadership responsibilities with organizations and associations and have headlined many festivals and institutes across the country.

"Tango Mannita", written in the 60's are still being programmed worldwide. They were responsible for laying the groundwork for Phase I and Phase II of Round Dancing which was adopted by CALLERLAB last year. The Smiths have now gone into semi-retirement, continuing to teach classes at Texas A & M and at their week long institute in Oklahoma.

The Manning Smith Conference on American Round Dance, which began in 1951, was one of the first of its kind to conduct a week long training program for prospective, as well as experienced, teachers. The Smiths "Mannita Waltz" and

Until 1967, the Richards traveled through the United States, Canada and Europe, participating in conventions, clinics and weekends, sharing their enthusiasm and knowledge. Gradually concentrating their efforts closer to home, they retired a few years ago. Their classic, "Summer Breeze", written in 1959, is an all time favorite.

**3. DIFFICULTY LEVEL**

**FUN LEVEL (FUN LV.)** - The caller should use only calls listed for the dance and emphasize standard patterns. If squares break down on the floor, the caller should walk through the calls involved. Keep 100% dancing.

**STANDARD LEVEL (Std. Lv.)** - The caller should mainly use the calls listed for the dance. He should attempt to keep everyone dancing, but should not walk through the listed calls. The caller may teach simple additional calls if he wishes. Keep at least 85% dancing.

**ALL POSITION DANCING (APD)** - The caller will use intricate, reversed and complex variations of all calls on the program. Any other calls may be used or taught.

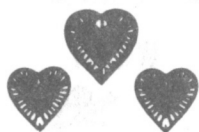

# HOW TO WRITE CLUB NEWS

*BOW & SWING* is "Florida's State Square & Round Dance Magazine", and we would like to hear of anything your club does that would be of interest to the people throughout the state, and elsewhere (we have many subscribers in other states and other countries).

Because space is limited, club news must sometimes be edited to include only the most newsworthy items. However, do not be discouraged from sending in lengthy newsletters. Some of the best hints and tidbits that can be of help to other clubs come from the longer letters.

Please note that there is a **WHERE TO DANCE** section in the back of the magazine. If your club is not listed there, you should discuss this with your club officers. In this section, it lists, by area, where a club dances, its level, in most cases - the caller, and a phone number where a visitor can get more information about your club. (Incidentally, a supply of *BOW & SWING* magazines is sent each month to each of the Florida Welcome Stations for visitors to our State -- and the people who request information about Square or Round Dancing are given a copy, so your listing in **WHERE TO DANCE** is a worthwhile investment. The cost is only \$12.48 per year -- \$1.00 per month.)

Because we have this **WHERE TO DANCE** section, we will, in most cases, delete addresses, times, dates, etc., from your newsletters. This information more properly belongs in your **WHERE TO DANCE** listing. An exception to this is that we may give more information for a brand new club.

If you are planning a special dance, we will be happy to mention this in the Club News, but not prices of tickets, where to get them, or other items that should be in an ad. It would be unfair to our many advertisers if all this information would be included "free" in Club News.

Mentioning names of people celebrating special anniversaries or birthdays is fine, but we cannot list EVERYONE in EVERY club for each anniversary or birthday. There just isn't enough space. Many clubs have their own newsletters where they can give this kind of individual recognition. If your club does not have its own newsletter, why not plan to start one in '81?

Finally -- *every time* you send in your club news, please identify it with the name of your club, the city or town where it dances, and sign it. If you don't want to use your name, a nom de plume will do. (We all wonder who "Robinson Crusoe, the Original Castoff" is.) When you see "Anonymous" after a club news item, this means the contributor did not sign it. And your editors often have to play "detective" to find out where a club dances -- and even to find out a club name where it has been omitted.

Club news should arrive at the *BOW & SWING* office, 54 East Main Street, Apopka, Florida 32703 by the first of the month to be included in the following month's magazine. For instance, we should receive it by the 1st of March for the April magazine.

Some mail is still going to the old *BOW & SWING* address in Palm-etto. That post office box has been closed, and mail going there may never reach us.

We hope the above will be of some help, and we eagerly await your news. *It's the backbone of BOW & SWING!*

A sincere "thank you" to all the club writers who are so faithful with their club news month after month.

And we look forward to hearing from all the other clubs.

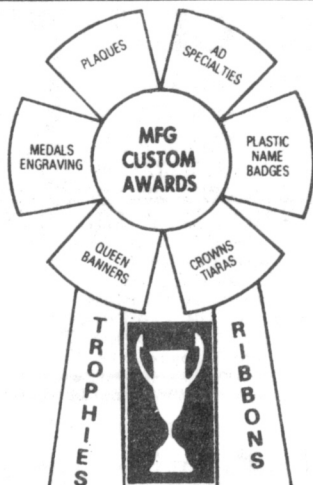

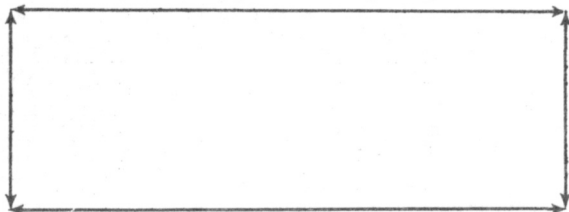
