President's Message

» SOUARE DANCING IS FUN «

At a recent meeting of the F. C. A. Executive Board administrative procedures for processing applications for membership were adopted. These procedures are summarized below for the edification of present and of potential members.

- 1) All applications for membership should be sent directly to the Secretary of the Association.
- No money is to be sent with the application. Any money received will be returned to the applicant.
- 3) Upon receipt of the completed application the Secretary will notify the applicant of the date of receipt and will inform him/her of the procedures to be followed in completing the application process as stated in the by-laws of the Association. Briefly, these steps are as follows:
 - A) Meet with the President of the Association at the next scheduled meeting of the Association. (Applicants not able to attend the next Association meeting will be expected to fulfill this requirement at the following meeting. If they fail to attend either of these meetings their application will be voided.)
 - B) After meeting with the President, and prior to the next Association meeting, the applicant must submit to the President a statement signed by at least one of his/her original sponsors certifying that the applicant has begun fulfilling the requirements for membership in the F. C. A.

Following the completion of these steps, the applicant will be accepted as an Associate Member of the F. C. A.


- 4) Upon acceptance as an Associate Member a statement of acceptance and a bill for dues will be sent to the applicant. The treasurer will order an Associate Member's (Green) badge for the new member upon receipt of dues. (This badge is the property of the Association.)
- AN EXAMPLE: Application received in August 1981. Applicant meets with the President at the Fall Clinic in October 1981. Applicant submits a letter to the President before the State Convention in May 1982. Applicant is accepted as an Associate Member in May 1982. Statement for dues is sent and badge is ordered upon receipt of dues. Bow & Swing subscription begins upon receipt of dues.

New application forms are being designed to facilitate these procedures. These new forms should be available from the Secretary (Art Wilson) by late July.



Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami

THE PLUS PROGRAM



The major changes in the plus program are really not in the content as only two simple calls, 3/4 tag and Grand Swing Thru are additions... The major change is that the Plus I program is now 17 calls and the plus II program is only 9 calls...This will, perhaps, encourage callers to add the 9 calls to their plus program and become a Plus II club.... This may be good in the long run as the Callerlab convention of 1982 plans to combine the lists into one PLUS PROGRAM....Hopefully this will slow down the rush of new graduates into Plus I workshops and Callers who are THINKING and CARING will plan to start new clubs for NEW DANCERS!!!!!

One way to teach the 3/4 Tag the Line is to call a 1/2 tag the line, hesitate and tell the dancers to extend, leaving a wave thru the center and outfacing dancers at each side of the set...Tell them they are now in a 3/4 tag position and that will mean to tag the line 3/4 of the way thru leaving the last dancers in the line forming a wave thru the center and the lead dancers facing ahead as if they had completed a full tag....There is limited choreo available but here are a few ideas....

ADVERTISERS WHAT'S THE DANCE LEVEL?

CALLERLAB has been urging callers, clubs, festivals, conventions and camps to advertise the level of their dances and then stick to the advertised level. LEGACY V at Denver adopted a proposal in favor of the very same practice.

In a recent issue of BOW & SWING there were 54 display ads advertising specific dances. Twenty-three (40%) did not advertise the level of the dance. BOW & SWING could help CALLERLAB and LEGACY reach their goals if the publication would refuse ads that dance.

Advertising the level is the first step to making good use of the levels established by CALLER-LAB.



HOME SEWING FASHION

We saw this frothy, dainty dress at the Golden Nuts Reunion at Strawberry Square at the end of March, and it certainly was an eye-catcher. Millie Pfantz is the designer and seamstress.

The material is a yellow floral chiffon with matching Polyester solid. The bodice is fully lined and has a scooped neckline with a four inch ruffle, one inch edging at the top. The sleeves are puffed, with a four inch ruffle at bottom and one inch edging at the top to match the neckline.

The underskirt is made with the solid material and is eight gores, with an eight inch chiffon ruffle at the bottom. The overskirt is also eight gores.

Millie tells us how to obtain the fluffy look of the overskirt. At the

bottom of each gore, stitch up about an inch and a half, one fourth inch across and then down. Draw the threads up as tight as you can and then stitch it again. This makes a kind of little puff.

The final touch, "framing the picture" is the emerald green trimming of three-fourths inch lace.


