Dear Fellow Caller:

It is often assumed that a Caller's College is for the new caller, and once you've been to one you've had the course and don't need to go back. While it is certainly true that a Caller's College can help the new caller avoid many mistakes, it is also true that a College can help the more experienced caller recognize mistakes and bad habits he has developed. It is also likely that parts of a College which seemed unimportant to the inexperienced caller (Business Aspects of Calling, Long Range Programming, etc.) may seem more important as the caller gains experience.

I would like to call your attention to the fact that the Florida Callers' Association will be sponsoring a Callers College August 6 - 9 in Orlando. This College will be conducted by Johnny Walter and Skip Smith and will provide training for new callers as well as an opportunity for more experienced callers to improve their skills.

The F. C. A. Caller's College will cover the CALLERLAB Curriculum. Topics will include Leadership, Equipment Choice and Use, Mechanics and Techniques of Calling, Choreography, Singing Call Techniques, Programming, One-Night Stands, Teaching, Business, and Self-Study Techniques and Resources. It will be a comprehensive College, and I am sure all who attend will benefit from the weekend.

The cost of the College has been kept to a minimum. Registration will be limited to 30 callers and their spouses. Full information on costs and registration can be obtained by writing Johnny Walter, Rt. 7, Box 363, Okeechobee, Florida 33472.

Whether you are a new caller or an experienced caller (or even an "I'm thinking about trying calling" caller), I hope you'll consider this College when making your summer plans.

CALLERLAB proudly presents the newly revised lists for the Mainstream and Plus Programs. Your attention is called to several changes the lists will be used as intended that reflect significant differences to aid in a logical teaching profrom previous lists. The Mainstream gression and thorough coverage of list consists of 2 segments. 1) The basics in classes and to provide an Basic Program (B) reflects a combin- enjoyable modern Square Dance for ation of the previous Basic & Extended Basic Programs. The calls are the same but there are some changes in suggested teaching order. The narrative below provides suggested guidelines on the use of levels and makes some additional suggestions on that proper teaching to include classes and logical progression to other levels when dancers are ready to try some additional plateaus. 2) The Plus lists reflect some major changes. Several Quarterly Selections were added to the +1 List and two +II calls were moved to the +I list. The end result is that the +I list is now 17 calls long. CALLER-LAB members voted to drop 3 calls from the +II list in addition to the calls moved to the +I list. Swap Around, Curley Cross and All Eight Swing Thru have been dropped from the +II list. Grand Swing Thru and 3/4 Tag the Line have been added. It is anticipated that the two lists teach the full MAINSTREAM PROGRAM. will be combined at the CALLERLAB Convention in 1982.

Also note that the Mainstream list has been frozen for a period of 3 years. Additions to the Mainstream list can only be made to the list in the calls 49-68 and only if the calls recommended meet the eligibility requirements of having been on the QS list for a period of 3 years. CALLERLAB feels this stability will benefit square dancers all over the world and hopes that all clubs and callers support this new designation.

WHY LISTS AND LEVELS?

CALLERLAB lists have been developed to provide guidance to those who teach Square Dance Classes, to Callers for programming the appropriate level of the dances they call and to dancers for scheduling dances they will enjoy the most. The levels or programs are not intended to segregate dancers into exclusive groups or to indicate that one who chooses to dance at his or her own aged to take their time, enjoy preferred level is any better or any what they are doing and learn to chooses to dance at his or her own worse than any other dancer. Dancing skill can be achieved at many

REPORT

levels, and the quantity of calls is not necessarily an indication of dancer proficiency. It is hoped dancers of all inclinations. addition, CALLERLAB'S intent is that approved styling and timing of Square Dance movements will be an integral part of all classes and dance programs. It is also hoped timing and styling will result in smooth flowing dancing to the music for the greater enjoyment of all.

BASIC / MAINSTREAM - HOW LONG?

The new BASIC PROGRAM (B), which consists of the previous BASIC and EXTENDED BASIC PROGRAMS, may well be an excellent first year program in many areas. 29 sessions of 2 to 2½ hours each are recommended to teach the BASIC PROGRAM properly and that fits well into the 30 weeks often available in many areas. It is recommended that 41 sessions of 2 to 2½ hours each be used to

WHAT NEXT?

Quite a few responsible leaders within and outside of CALLERLAB recommend that dancers dance regularly at the level at which they graduate for at least one year before entering workshops for additional levels of dancing. This means that if you graduate at the Mainstream or QS level, stay there for a year before going into Plus levels. If you graduate at the Plus Level, stay there for a year before going into Advanced, etc. Stay at each level as long as you are enjoying it and having fun.

GREATER ENJOYMENT

Proper execution of the Basics at the BASIC and MAINSTREAM level will result in more comfortable and enjoyable dancing and make entry into other levels that much easier. There should be no pressure for movement from one level to another once a dancer has graduated. Dancers should be encourdance well at their chosen level.





The callerlab quarterly experimental will no doubt be liked by some callers and disliked by others..REMEMBER if you and your dancers don't like or need Release Recycle, you are under no obligation to use it... BUT in all fairness give it a try, it is not a bad dancing figure and after trying out many experimentals it surely will dance a whole lot better than the rest of the junk floating around.....I would like to see the Quarterly Selections become selections for the PLUS Dance programs and not push any more calls on our Mainstreamers!!!!! We covered the call and how it works last month.

GOLDEN AGE MARATHON DANCERS

Old cartoons of a tailor usually depict a little man sitting crosslegged on a hassock mouth full of pins and sewing a fine seam, with 'the little woman' in the background tending the children and picking up the cuttings Not "sew" with Leon & Frances Bauernfeind. This couple, finally semi-retired,

moved to Avon Park, Florida, where Leon frequently does highly customized tailoring for such notables as Johnny Cash, as well as a

few regular customers.

Leon & Frances became fascinated with the world of square dancing, and in May, 1980, graduated from "Lefty" Tidd's class, joined the Ridge Rollaway's Mainstreamers, and by late fall were dancing the Club's +2 level.

Along the way, they heard about the many serious and humorous badges dancers worked for such as Knothead awarded for dancing 100 miles from home base, the Rover Badge for dancing 1000 miles from home....Then there was that intriguing Diehard Badge for dancing 5 days in a row.

And so they started on January 16, 1981...the 5 days stretched on to 6, and 6 days to 6 weeks...at which time, while dancing in Lakeland, they met Ronnie Lake of Apopka, who, in his mid-fifties, had danced 74 days consecutively, and was claiming the record for his age group.

That was just the challenge the Bauernfeinds needed. With 41 days of consecutive dancing already accumulated, it seemed here was a

Golden Age record since they are both over 65. Just for fun, they decided to try for one day more than their friendly competitor (who was by then 'egging' them on), for a total of 75 days. With a cheerful squad of fellow club members and surrounding area callers backing them, on they went, dancing daily wherever there was a bonafide dance open to the public and called by professional square dance callers, who each signed that important little record book attesting to their attendance and full participation.

The whole adventure culminated March 31, 1981 with a gala "75th Day of Dance" celebration tendered this determined couple by their own club, the Ridge Rollaways of Sebring. After dancing to 20 different callers, in 12 different locations within an 85 mile radius, and racking up 3000 miles of driving plus carpooling, Leon & Frances were ceremoniously presented special badges designating them as "GOLDEN AGE WORLD CHAMPIONS of 75 square dances".

As they can attest, the world of square dancing is not only a marvelous place to enjoy great fun exercise, but a place to be enveloped into the warm friendliness that exists there. They would love to hear from any Golden Agers who are into a similar event and will happily join the cheering squad of dancers who supported them so heartily.






