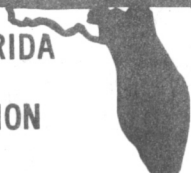

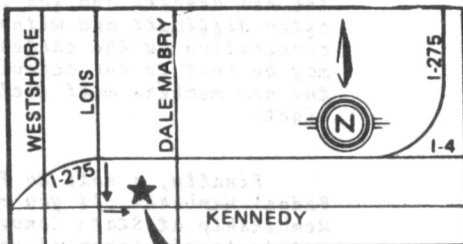


# President's Message

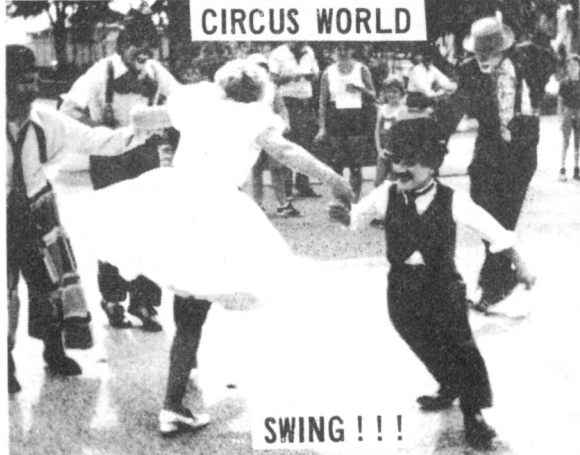

In March, 1956, Fun & Frolic was started under the auspices of the City Recreation Department with Edith Ford as caller/teacher at Woodstock Community Center. It was thought by this group that the heads remained heads and the sides remained sides until they attended the Knothead Konvention.

When the old Woodstock building was torn down in 1962, several different halls were used until returning to the new Woodstock Community Center, completed in 1965, and they remain there to this day.

Edith Ford called through November, 1961 and Jack Griffiths was at the mike from then through December, 1977. Both left because of poor health. Tom Hidding then took over and is the current leader.

It is remembered that in 1957 the club gave Edith Ford a surprise "This is Your Life" party. Many events of her life were recalled and filmed on a movie camera which was later presented to her as a gift. It is also remembered that when Jack was expecting his first grandchild, he was given a grandfather baby shower. It was fun to watch him open all the baby gifts. Another event this club

was involved in was a parade in 1959, when the members decorated the float and a square danced to Edith Ford's calling through the streets of Jacksonville.

Fun & Frolic is proud to celebrate its 25th Anniversary March 16, 1981 as the longest continuous dancing club in the Northeast Florida Square Dancing Association. All area square dancers are cordially invited to join the celebration of this event.

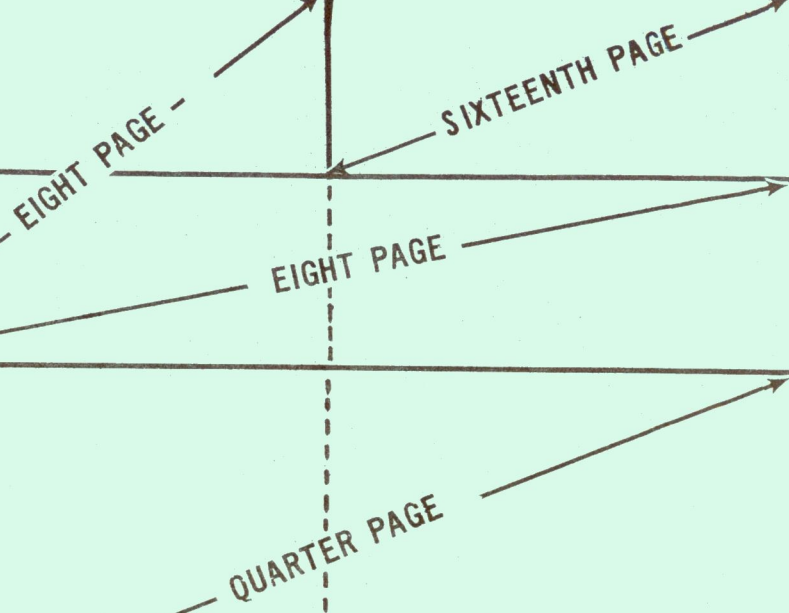

Some of the "other likes" were; travel, weekends, conventions, and no alcohol. The most often mentioned "other dislikes" were; too many calls, cliques, and rough dancers. One small group of people who read and discussed the comments agreed that the most frequent complaint was that present dancing consisted of too much work and not enough fun.

## EXPERIMENTAL WITH MAINSTREAM POSSIBILITIES

### CHAIN DOWN THE LINE .... Don Beck

To those of you who danced and called 25 years ago you may recall a singing call HURRY HURRY HURRY in which from lines of four the ladies chained across the set then the ladies chained down their own line then across the set and again down the line to end back in a zero formation .... Well, Don has picked up on the term Chain Down The Line, but has given this old idea an updated action .... From a two faced line, the action implies the centers trade (that is the chain) then the ends of the line with courtesy turn the centers to end facing the couple that was in your same line ... A 3/4 courtesy turn if you will... The action can also start from left handed ocean waves and again the ends courtesy turn the adjacent center after the centers trade and end facing the couple that was in your wave.. From waves, be sure that you have a Dixie Style left handed wave and for mainstreamers that the centers of the wave are girls.

### EXAMPLES OF CHAIN DOWN THE LINE...MAINSTREAM APPLICATION

- BOX 1-4: Right & Left Thru..Veer Left..Chain Down the Line..  
Slide Thru..Left Alle..(zero)
- BOX 1-4: Swing Thru..Boys Run..Couples Circulate..  
Chain Down the Line..Star Thru..Pass Thru..  
Trade By..Left Alle...
- 1P-2P: Pass the Ocean..Ladies Trade..Recycle..Veer Left..  
Girls Circulate..Chain Down the Line..Star Thru..  
Pass to the Center..Square Thru 3/4..Left Alle...

### FROM OCEAN WAVES

- 1P-2P: Right & Left Thru..Dixie Style to a Wave..Boys Trade..  
Left Swing Thru..Chain Down the Line... (boys have the  
girls by the left hand so boys will place right hand  
in their back and complete the 3/4 courtesy turn)  
LEFT ALLE... (zero back to 1P-2P line)...
- 1P-2P: Right & Left Thru..Dixie Style to a Wave..Boys Trade..  
Left Swing Thru..All 8 Circulate..Chain Down the Line..  
Flutter Wheel..Sweep 1/4..Pass Thru..Left Alle....

Give this a try, the strange feeling comes with the 3/4 courtesy turn especially from the left handed wave....It will dance smoothly and looks nice also.....
