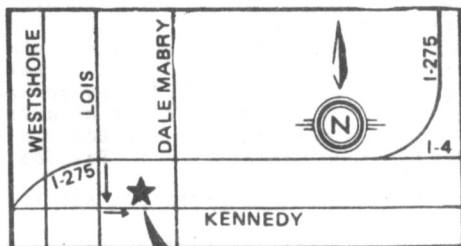

• SQUARE DANCING IS FUN •

May is always a big month for square dancing in Florida. It is in May that most classes are graduated and we welcome new dancers into our clubs. It is to be hoped that club leaders and callers have planned for this and that the new dancers will be made to feel welcome when they first attend club dances. After spending thirty or more weeks teaching someone to dance, it is most disheartening to see them leave the activity because: 1) they could not dance the level called the first night they visited the club, or 2) people were not friendly or would not dance with them. If somebody leaves the activity with a bad taste-in-their-mouth concerning it, not only will they never be back; they will also discourage others from coming into the activity. Be patient with your new graduates; welcome them, help them, dance with them. Your best friend may be among those new dancers and you just haven't met them yet; you never will if they quit dancing.

The other big event in May is the State Square and Round Dance Convention. The Convention this year will provide halls for dancing from Mainstream to Challenge II. There will be workshop opportunities for new and experienced dancers alike. We hope to see all of you in Lakeland on May 22-24. It is sure to be a great time for all.

ATTENTION GREEN BADGE CALLERS:

As you know, one of the requirements for Full Membership in the Florida Callers Association is attendance at a Callers College during your two years as an Associate Member. The FCA will sponsor a college this summer which will cover the CALLERLAB approved curriculum and will meet the membership requirement for FCA. CONVENTION INFORMATION

THE 1981 GRAND MARCH

The Grand March planned for the 28th State Square Dance Convention will be different from previous ones. All speeches, recognition of guests, committees and individuals, and the Invocation, will be accomplished from the stand prior to the Grand March. All dancers may remain seated in the stands during these proceedings. Only after all pre-dance functions have taken place will the Grand March begin. A short period will be required prior to the March to permit dancers to exit the stands and assemble at the four side entrances (STARTING POINTS) to the main floor. Dancers from North East may assemble at Entrance 1 if you care to; from the West Coast at Entrance 2; from Central at Entrance 3; and from Northwest and Southeast at Entrance 4. These entrances will be marked.

The two lead couples from each starting point have designated personnel. These are: Federation, Round Dance Cuer, and Florida Caller officers, and the Convention Chairmen and their respective partners. Other dancers line up behind the lead couples (4 abreast) outside in the hallways. The two lead

couples at Entrances 1 and 3 will march around the perimeter of the arena to Entrances 2 and 4 where they will be joined by the other two lead couples (forming lines of 8 dancers) and march around in decreasing circles, forming spirals in their respective ends of the arena. These couples will be followed by other couples at five second intervals. When the lead couples reach the center of their half of the arena, the Caller will announce "Form Squares". Each line of 8 marchers forms a square. Then the Caller says, "Let's Dance", and that is what they do - dance - dance - dance.

The Grand March will be limited to 80 squares (40 each side of the arena, due to limitation of 8 abreast marching space). Other dancers not in the Grand March may form squares and join in.

We think that you will enjoy this march. It is beautiful to watch and eliminates the necessity for dancers to stand during opening ceremonies.

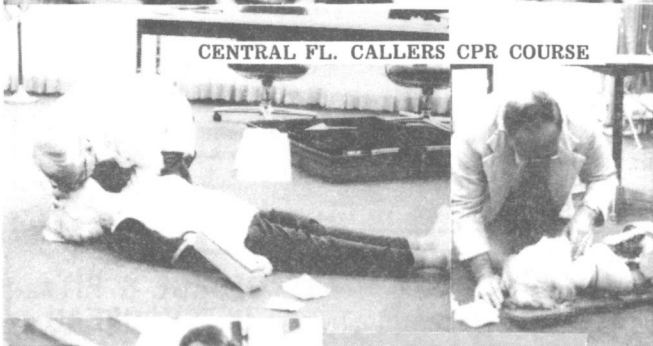

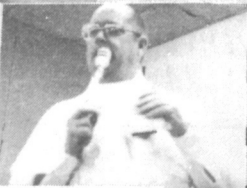

...Dick Kenyon From a 1/4 tag formation (standard position) the boys on the ends of the center wave will extend to the outside girl as the boy in the outside couple extends to the ends of the center wave, now the wave will recycle as the outsiders also recycle ending in a double pass thru formation.... The styling is that of a basic recycle and it takes 6 beats to dance the figure.... From standard position this call should prove to be easily danced and popular with the dancers....As an all position figure I urge caution as recycle as an apd figure can create problems for many mainstreamers or dancers not familiar with apd.....
