THE LIFELINE OF SQUARE DANCING

In my opinion, after many, many years of watching the Square Dance Movement progress, and in some instances, regress, I have come to the decision that "Dedicated" Square Dancers are the "Lifeline", or "Lifeblood" of the entire square Dance Movement. When I say "Dedicated" I do not mean someone that attends regularly, or someone that is an officer in a club.

I mean the really dedicated dancer.

The one who is always there when you need them. The

ones who are at the door waiting when the Caller arrives.

They want to help out anyway they can because,

to them, Square Dancing has changed their entire life style.

They are having "Fun", and they are meeting

new friends, and they love every minute of it. But let's go further than that. Let me explain what I mean. The dedicated folks that I am referring to are not the BEST Dancers in the club. That is, they are not always the best dancers. They are not even real good dancers. Still they are the most dedicated members of the club. Let me give you an example of this.

Many years ago, back in the mid 40's, I had a club in the San Fernando Valley in California. We had a very nice group of 10 squares. We danced every Friday night. In this group there was one couple that were not good dancers. They were not even "Fair" dancers. However, not one person there enjoyed it more than this couple did. They would goof up squares, always trying their best of course, but they

would always, at some point, goof up. The other dancers would get them through it all right and the way their faces would light up would make you feel proud that they had made it through the tip. This went on week after week, month after month, and year after year - for a couple of years, that is. Now here comes the stickler.

One night four couples came to me. They had been appointed as a committee of eight to ask me to ask this couple to resign from the club. I said "Why Me"? They said "Because you are the Caller". I was burned up about it but I kept my cool and said, "Let me think about it awhile".

Later on during a break I asked that this group meet me at the stage and we would talk about it. They came up to me and I said, "I have been doing a lot of thinking and I have decided not to do your dirty work for you".

They asked, "What do you mean by that"? I said, "Well this couple are real good friends of yours. They like

all of you very much, and you all like them very much. You wouldn't think of hurting their feelings by telling them that you do not want to dance with them so you ask me to get rid of them for YOU". They

said, "We didn't mean it that way at all". I said, Well that's the way it looks from where I am standing". We stared at each other for a few minutes, no one knowing what to do next. Finally, I said, "Why don't we all think it over for a week and see if we can't come up with a better answer"? They agreed, not wanting to push the issue any further and not wanting to tell the couple that they were not wanted in the club.

The next week rolls around. This committee of eight were waiting for me when I arrived at the hall. They said, "We think that we have an answer. We want to see what you think about it". They continued by saying, "Here is what we have come up with. We have 10 squares in the club. We figure that you call about 10 tips during an evening. We have made up little date books or TIP books. We have a place for four couples on each page. This is to set up our tips for each dance. Always dancing with others and mixing up during the evening as we have been taught to do. However, we will see that "this" couple are asked to dance in a different square for each tip. We will not wait for them to ask us. We have set a different couple for each tip to go and ask this couple, along with two other couples to be in their tip. This way we are making the couple wanted, not tolerated." They went on and explained to me, "We have had meetings every night this past week and we have decided that this couple are just

too nice and too beautiful to see their feelings hurt over a square dance." They then explained, "If we do it this way, there are 10 squares in the club. We dance 10 tips during the evening, and this way each couple dances in a square with "this" couple just once during the evening. We make them feel wanted, we all feel better about it, no feelings are hurt and everyone here are still the best of friends. What do you think of the idea?" I was too stunned to speak for a few seconds.

Finally I said, "I am really astounded. If I had some sort of an award I would sure give it to you folks, but since I don't have an award, I feel sure that I can promise that there will be an extra "Star" in your crown some day."

I am sure that I must have called the best dance of my career that night because I was on Cloud 9 all evening, feeling so proud of this group of dancers. I wish that all dancers would come up with ideas like this to keep their groups together instead of resenting others who have trouble, and not wanting to dance with them.

Friendship is a valuable asset and you cannot replace it with a better dancer. Think about it.

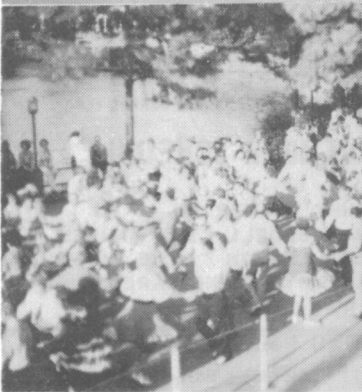

CALLERLAB QUARTERLY SELECTIONS FOR MAINSTREAM EXPERIMENTATION:

The Callerlab Quarterly Selection has made their choices for the last quarter of 1981 and they came up with two selections for us to try out and evaluate so we can vote next April at the Callerlab convention.....

CHAIN DOWN THE LINE:.....Don Beck.

Last January we presented Chain Down The Line as an experimental, you may wish to refer to that issue for additional information....

Chain Down the Line can be presented from two basic formations...The most practical will be a standard two faced line with boys as ends and girls as centers of a right handed set up... The CHAIN is accomplished by having the girls trade (exchange places....The men open up a bit and courtesy turn the adjacent girl to end facing the couple in their own line, a 3/4 courtesy turn if you will.....You can lead into a Chain Down The Line easily from

1. swing thru..boys run..
2. Couples Circulate..
3. Veer Left...

Follow up calls that work well are...

1. Pass Thru
2. Two ladies chain..
3. Flutter Wheel.
4. Dixie style to a wave....

You can also use Chain Down The Line from a Dixie Style wave after a left swing thru, the girls can trade easily and the men can easily accept them into a courtesy turn 3/4 to end facing and it will dance very nicely..... I might add an idea for you to explore here...From a basic dixie style to a wave...you have the boys as centers holding right hands...You can legally call a SWING THRU here....The action will have the boys turn 1/2 by their right hands then the turn left 1/2 with the girls.....An odd swing thru but it follows the RULES of 1/2 by the right then 1/2 by the left.....The reason I bring this up at this time is that from a basic dixie style to a wave, a swing thru followed by a Chain Down The Line is really a very smooth and nice dancing action....

DANCING CHAIN DOWN THE LINE:

ZERO BOX..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..VEER LEFT..COUPLES CIRCULATE..
CHAIN DOWN THE LINE..STAR THRU..PASS THRU..
TRADE BY..LEFT ALLE...

ZERO BOX..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..VEER LEFT..FERRIS WHEEL..
CENTERS VEER LEFT..CHAIN DOWN THE LINE...LEFT ALLE...

ZERO LINE..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..DIXIE STYLE TO A WAVE..
BOYS TRADE..LEFT SWING THRU..CHAIN DOWN THE LINE...LEFT ALLE....zero..

ZERO LINE..SQUARE THRU 3/4...COURTESY TURN YOUR GIRL..
LADIES LEAD..DIXIE STYLE TO A WAVE,..(boys start) SWING THRU..
CHAIN DOWN THE LINE..FLUTTER WHEEL & SWEEP 1/4 MORE..
SWING THRU..TURN THRU..LEFT ALLE....

STAR THE ROUTE...Don Williamson:

Callerlab Quarterly Selection.

We published this call in March 1977....Our comments then are the same, A fun memorized type routine which will be most suitable with basic level dance clubs and even one night stands....I feel that it dances well but is not suited for more than an occasional change of pace usage....You cannot fit the call into the type of choreo around which we spend most of the evening dancing....Again as a break or a relaxer it will be fine once or twice a night but thats about allAs we see it.....

THE ACTION : The command would be HEADS STAR THE ROUTE or Sides Star the route.....Pronounce the word route to rhyme with out not root...Sounds better!!!!

Heads will right hand star 3/4 which will place them into a left hand star with the couple to their right from the static square....With the side couple you will left hand star a full turn allowing the original heads to reform a right hand star in the center of the set as the sides end back at home....The heads will right hand star 1/2 in the center taking them to the other side of the set to form a left hand star with the other side couple...Heads then come back into the center for a 3/4 right hand star to home....The entire action when danced to the music should take 32 beats.... Once the action is learned, try to give the command Heads Star The Route and then push up the music and you keep quiet,,, a nice effect and will work well as the break in a singing call.... You can get a bit challenging with the call by having the heads rollaway 1/2 sashay....and circle eight.....Four boys star the route or girls star the route.....

EXPERIMENTAL CALL FOR PLUS LEVEL (not a quarterly selection)

ROLL FROM THE DIAMOND Bill Harrison;

The name of the call I feel is to long and could easily be changed to Roll THE diamond... The action also should be preceeded by a Diamond Circulate so the roll becomes part of a moving motion....The basic action is that the points of the diamond will 1/4 right (roll) from a right hand diamond as the centers of the diamond extend...Right hand diamonds end in right hand waves....Left hand diamonds end in left hand waves....Point to point right hand diamonds end in right hand columns and point to point left hand diamonds end in left hand waves.....I suggest that your initial experimentation be from standard twin right hand diamonds.....

ZERO BOX...SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..GIRLS HINGE 1/4..
DIAMOND CIRCULATE..ROLL THE DIAMOND..
BOYS RUN..PASS THE OCEAN..RECYCLE..LEFT ALLE... zero.

ZERO BOX..SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..TAG THE LINE RIGHT..
BOYS HINGE..DIAMOND CIRCULATE..ROLL THE DIAMOND...

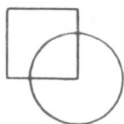

MARSHALL FLIPPO AT CIRCUS WORLD THIS MONTH

Flippo started square dancing in 1951, calling in 1952, and instructing in 1953. He taught square dancing for the Abilene, Texas Recreation Department and YMCA and called regularly for clubs in the Abilene area until 1961 when he became a permanent staff member at Kirkwood Lodge in Missouri. He is at the Lodge 6 months each year and travels throughout the country the other 6 months, calling. He records for Merrbach Records on the Blue Star label and has made over 100 single recordings, plus albums and tapes.

The highlight of his career was being selected in 1970 to the American Square Dance Society's Hall of Fame. He is a charter member of Callerlab, served on its Board of Governors since its beginning and also served on the Executive Committee. This year at the Callerlab Convention in Kansas City, he was presented the Milestone Award, the highest award given.

31st NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION

The 31st National Square Dance Convention will be held June 24-26, 1982 in Detroit, Michigan at Cobo Hall. One of the largest conventions and exhibit facilities in the world, it fills 17 acres in the 75 acre Civic Center at the hub of Detroit - all for use of the square dancers.

Here's good news - the northern 3rd of the Lower Level is the two-floor Parking Lot Garage, with space for 618 cars. Adjacent to the Hall, Arena Underground Garage provides two parking levels with 430 stalls. Roof Deck parking holds 1,217 cars. There are an additional 4,285 spaces within 3 city blocks of the Hall and another 5,112 spaces within 7 blocks. Motorists may drive from eastern and western freeways of neighboring states directly to Cobo Hall's parking areas, without a stop for traffic lights.

Cobo Hall's ultra-modern cafeteria has four serving lines to speed food service to a capacity seating of 1500 and all levels of the Hall are easily accessible by escalators or elevators to save tired dancers' feet.
