NATIONAL CONVENTION NEWS

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER FOR THE 32nd NATIONAL

An *Emergency Telephone* will be manned from 9 AM until 1 AM each day of the Convention. This line will be connected directly to the Control Center. This number should be left with family members at home in case they need to contact you. The number is:

FIRST AID STATIONS

There will be 3 First Aid Stations open from 9 AM to 11 PM each day, staffed at all times by trained personnel. The rooms will be located adjacent to the main Coliseum, and in the East and West Lobbies. In addition, many of the security people are also trained in First Aid. Hope nobody has to use these facilities, but in the event it's necessary, the Convention Committee wants to take good care of you.

LOST AND FOUND

The Lost and Found Department will be located just off the main Coliseum lobby. This lobby is the main entrance to the Fairgrounds, so if you lose something (or somebody) check the Lost and Found room as you enter or leave.

PARKING

There are 20,000 parking spaces within the boundaries of the Kentucky Fair and Exposition Center. There is a charge for this parking, collected by Fairground personnel (the 32nd National does not receive any of this money). If you intend to leave the Fairgrounds and return later in the day, *you must ask for a pass when you pay the parking fee* in order that you may re-enter without paying an additional fee. This must be done each day as the passes will be honored for only the day the fee was paid.

CAMPERS CB CHANNEL

As you drive to Louisville, monitor CB Channel 4 for the latest information on how to get to "The Place to Be in '83." They don't want to lose anyone, because they have plenty of air-conditioned dancing room just waiting for you!

The KFEC is the largest facility of its kind on the North American Continent — more than 600,000 square feet under one roof, all air conditioned, one level, with over 20,000 parking spaces on the grounds. The entire facility from fence to fence, including the stadium, has been reserved by the sponsoring organization, the Kentuckiana Square Dance Association, Inc.

All of us can be proud of the evolution of the effective voluntary leadership which has made square dancing more available, more affordable, and most

recognized as the national folk dance in the country many of us still believe to be the "best place to live" in the world.

Organizations and Functions/Procedures of the Northwest Florida Square and Round Dance Association

I. Organization

a. Membership

1. Membership in this association is open to all area associations, clubs, and/or individual square, round, or folk dancers geographically located in the north western counties of Florida.
2. Associate membership-carrying no entitlement to vote - is open to all out-of-state organizations and individuals, qualifying as above, who wish to participate in association activities.

b. Delegates (Board of Delegates)

1. Each member club will have one voting delegate and may only vote in person at the meeting.
2. Delegates-at-large shall each have one vote. Delegates-at-large will consist of past presidents of the association in good standing and delegates chosen by groups of at least 25 individual members whose clubs or associations are not affiliated with the Northwest Square and Round Dance Association.

c. Executive Board

The executive board consists of President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer. The board is elected for a term of one year, and no officer may succeed himself more than once.

II. Procedures/Functions

a. Affiliation with the Florida Federation of Square Dancers: The Northwest Florida Square and Round Dance Association is affiliated with the Florida Federation of Square Dancers and is entitled to send voting delegates to meetings. Delegates are chosen as follows:

1. The current president of the Northwest Florida Square and Round Dance Association is a delegate.
2. One delegate is appointed by the president of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers.
3. Two members of the association are elected each year to serve as delegates.

b. Meetings

Five meetings are held each year. These meetings are held at different locations throughout the district so that, in addition to the delegates, interested members may attend and observe.

c. Newsletter

A bulletin of Northwest Florida Square and Round Dancing news is published six times a year. Each individual member or member-couple receives a copy and each member club receives five copies for general distribution. The newsletter committee also provides the members, associations and clubs with a chronological list of the open dances in the area and encourages clubs and associations to help in avoiding conflicts by making use of this list.

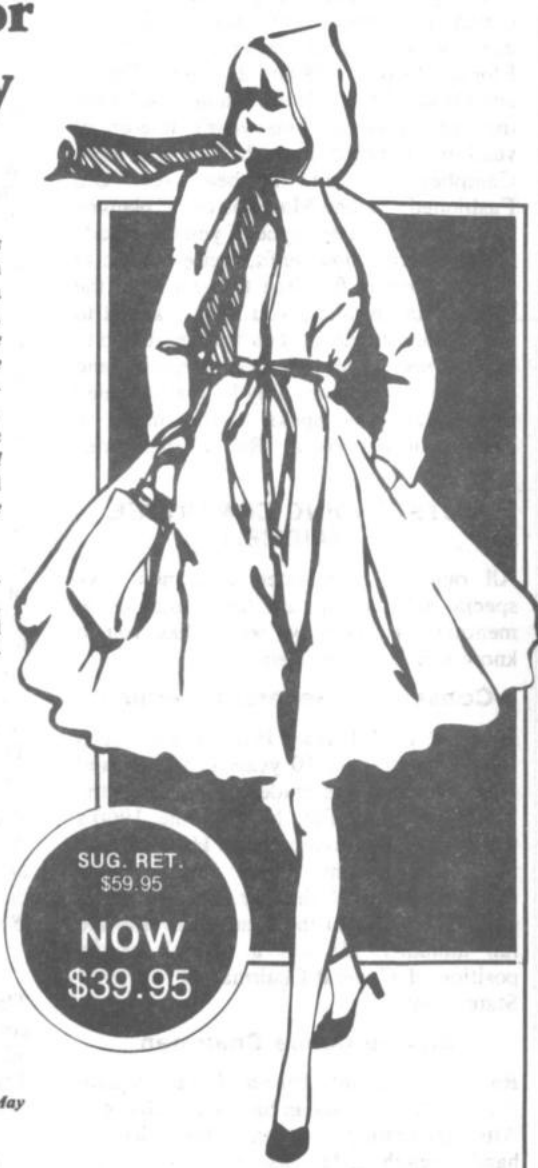

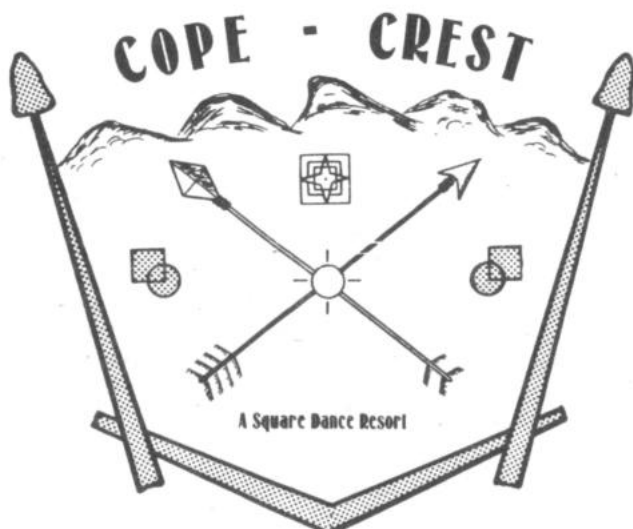

CHUCK KESSLER HONORED



The February, 1983 issue of *SQUARE DANCING*, official magazine of the Sets in Order American Square Dance Society, named Chuck Kessler as the "Caller of the Month". Chuck, a Clearwater resident, began his

calling in 1967 in Baltimore and moved to Florida in 1973. He rapidly became a popular caller with a very large following.

A few years ago he had chemotherapy treatments for Hodgkins Disease which is now in remission, then he had a heart attack, followed by open heart surgery in 1981.

All of his followers are happy that four weeks after surgery he resumed calling and now has recovered his strength and calls for four Advanced and one Plus workshop, one

Intermediate Round Dance workshop, three Beginner Round Dance classes, and three dances, to record crowds, mostly at Stirling Hall in Dunedin.

Chuck is also a staff caller for Cope Crest (formerly Andy's Trout Farm) in Dillard, Georgia, a past member of SDLBA, past president of the Suncoast Callers Association, member of CALLERLAB, and the Florida Callers Association.

Besides the "Caller of the Month" honor, the city of Clearwater issued a proclamation naming February 4th as Chuck Kessler Day.

This makes the second Florida caller within two months being nationally recognized. We reported in the February *BOW & SWING* that Jack Lasry of Hollywood was honored in the January, 1983 issue of *AMERICAN SQUARE DANCE MAGAZINE* as their "Professional Profile Personality."

The response has been overwhelming. Yes, the dancers do want to be heard and LEGACY is proud to provide this opportunity. JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



THE PLUS PROGRAM:

The PLUS program has become the "Mainstream" in many areas. Several recent surveys have shown that there are more plus dances advertised than Mainstream dances, this seems to be a fact in the big cities and less true in the rural areas...No matter where the dance many dancers are learning the plus program and enjoying what it has to offer...I keep hearing that several plus basics are not used very much, crossfire, 3/4 tag, triple scoot, and most roll actions.. Many of these same folks however are rushing on into the advanced workshops without a complete plus background...If enough callers wish to drop or replace calls on the plus list fine, lets do it thru Callerlab but until that takes place we all should teach & call the full program so all plus dancers can respond well to the basics.

FORMATIONS & COMBINATIONS FOR USING AND SPREAD:

The term And Spread at Plus dancing provides for some common and some uncommon usage.. The common or standard use of the call comes from any basic or combination of basics that will end in a double pass thru formation.. The command AND SPREAD then implies that the center dancers will slide apart as the trailing or end dancers will squeeze inbetween the spreading centers ending in lines of four facing in...

COMMON SET UPS:

1. Heads Star/Slide Thru & Spread.
2. Lines pass thru..Wheel & Deal & Spread.
3. Two faced lines..Ferris Wheel & Spread.
4. Completed Double Pass thru..Cloverleaf & Spread.
5. From the 1/4 Tag formation..The wave recycle & Spread.

SECOND STAGE OF UNDERSTANDING AND SPREAD:

1. Heads Touch 1/4 & Spread...(Ends in three & one lines)
2. An eight chain thru box formation...Such as Heads Star Thru..Calif. Twirl & Spread (ends in inverted lines)

THIRD STAGE OF DIFFICULTY:

This area has as its ending formation two faced lines and ocean waves, as the ending formation is approached the centers will spread apart as the ends move up and into the center position...The degree of difficulty is much greater for the dancers and requires a certain type of dancer who enjoys being challenged. I don't feel there is much need for these at the average plus dance..

1. Spin the top & Spread.
2. Coordinate & Spread.
3. All 8 Circulate & Spread.
4. Spin chain thru..Ends circulate Once or Two positions & Spread...

Some Examples using the Second Stage Of Anything & Spread:

HEADS TOUCH 1/4 & SPREAD..CENTERS PASS THE OCEAN..
THE WAVE SWING THRU & CAST OFF 3/4..COUPLES CIRCULATE..
BEND THE LINE..CENTERS SQUARE THRU FOUR..ENDS STAR THRU..
SQUARE THRU 3/4..LEFT ALLE...

HEADS STAR THRU..CALIF. TWIRL & SPREAD..
ENDS TRADE..LINES UP & BACK..STAR THRU..CENTERS PASS THRU..LEFT ALLE..

HEADS STAR THRU.. CALIF. & SPREAD..CENTERS SQUARE THRU FOUR..
ENDS TRADE & STAR THRU..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..
PASS THRU..TRADE BY..LEFT ALLE....

MORE ON EQUIVALENTS

If we have the *Heads Square Thru Four Hands - Swing Thru - Girls Circulate* - we have moved the head ladies across to the opposite "wave", in the same wave with their partners. We can accomplish this same thing by *Chaining* the Head Ladies to start with, before we Square Thru. If we chain the Head Ladies, then Square Thru four hands, followed by a Right & Left Thru, we can then use it like this, - *Swing Thru - Turn Thru - Left Allemande*. We can accomplish the same thing by calling it thus:

**Heads square thru four hands
Swing Thru - Girls Circulate
Boys Trade - Turn Thru -
Left Allemande . . .**

As I said, we have moved the Head Ladies across to the same wave their partners are in, then when the Men Trade, their partner is right there for the *Turn Thru*. Now we are going to take that same idea and expand on it:

**Heads Square Thru four hands
Swing Thru - Girls Circulate
Boys Trade and - Scoot Back
Now Recycle and - Dive Thru
and Swing Thru - and Turn Thru
There's Corner, Left Allemande . . .**

We can use this same idea, moving the Gents across to the opposite line by having Men Circulate and if we have the *Girls Trade*, each Gent will be in the opposite line, and of course the line is now a *Two-Faced Line*, because we put them into a *Two-Faced Line* when we had the Men Run. By having the Ladies do the *Trade* we have each Gent standing beside his original

partner and they are *Out of Sequence*, so we can simply *Bend the Line and Cross-Trail Thru to a Left Allemande*. These

are small things - but important to know because you are now able to throw them in at any point in your tip - You can cut them short or make them last as long as you want. There are no limits when you start putting Equivalents together. Let's just add a little, like this:

**Heads Square Thru Four Hands
Swing Thru - the Boys Run
Boys Circulate - Girls Trade
Wheel & Deal - Dive Thru
Swing Thru - Girls Trade -
Boys Trade - and Turn Thru -
Find Corner, Left Allemande . . .**

As I said, you can go just as far as you want when using equivalents. There is absolutely no limit. In that last call, I used another Equivalent. When dancers are in a wave - Catch this now - when dancers are in a wave, if you *Swing Thru - Girls Trade - Boys Trade* - Those *Two Trades are equivalent to a Right & Left Thru* - I am going to move into that right now and show how you can replace the Right & Left Thru that you might have been using to set them up in a *Swing Thru*. I will set them up like this:

**Head two Ladies Chain across
The same Two Couples Square Thru
Right & Left Thru the Outside two
Turn your girl and Swing Thru -
Then Turn Thru, Left Allemande . . .**

Never mind pride — not wanting people to know you have a problem — better be safe than sorry, as many a dance could be ruined by a rough swing or arm turn. My night was ruined, but it won't happen again. I have my FRAGILE badge and I hope all of you with physical problems will get one too.

MOTEL ROOMS

Mrs. & Mrs. J. C. Thomas wrote from North Ft. Myers, sending a copy of a letter of complaint written to Ramada Inn, Lakeland. They, and many other dancers, with advance registrations for the Sunshine Festival, were not able to get their rooms, and although their money was refunded, they were understandably unhappy about the situation.

Your Editors were near the entrance of the Lakeland Civic Center Arena late Saturday afternoon, when the Manager of the Ramada Inn in question came in and talked with us. He was very upset that dancers had to be turned away, and offered this explanation:

The Inns in the entire Lakeland area were filled to capacity with tourists planning on attending such attractions as Walt Disney World and Epcot, and who had heard that there were no motel/hotel rooms available in the Attractions area. These guests had registered and had their rooms prior to the beginning of the Sunshine Festival, and decided not to vacate. They were afraid they would not get a room closer to Orlando.

Legally, there is nothing a Motel Manager can do in this case. Even if a guest signs a

Statement saying he will vacate his room on a certain day, if he decides to stay, he cannot be forced to leave if he chooses not to.

This kind of occurrence is an everyday happening in motels and hotels. (We personally ran across the same situation when attending a World's Fair.) However, it ordinarily does not happen in such large numbers as happened in Lakeland. It is our understanding that an entire busload of tourists decided to stay at the Lakeland Ramada Inn, which kept a large number of dancers from having their advance registrations honored.

There is no good solution to this problem, but, hopefully, the above explanation will help ease the resentment of those who were turned away that day.

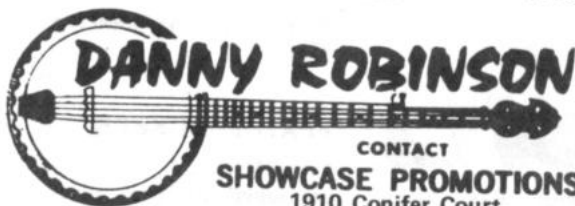

(Continued from page 20)

Instead of putting that Right & Left Thru in, after the Square Thru, we could have used *Trades*. We would do it like this:

Head Two Ladies Chain Across
The same two couples Square Thru
Swing Thru - Girls Trade - Boys Trade
Turn Thru, There's Corner, Left Alle.

Let's expand further on that very same set-up. . . You will notice in the above that I very simply chained the Head Ladies. I would never do it that simple when calling to a group. I would more than likely have *Heads Right & Left Thru - Turn on Around and Flutter Wheel* - This would be the same as Two Ladies Chain. Then I would pick it up from there. . . This also applies when you have just the Head Couples doing a Swing Thru in the center of the set, sides inactive at the time.

Head Couples a Right & Left Thru
Turn your girls and - Flutter Wheel
Same four - Star Thru - Swing Thru -
Turn Thru - Left Allemande. . .

Now we will add the Trade -

Head Couples Right & Left Thru

Turn your girls and - Flutter Wheel
Same 4 Star Thru - Right & Left Thru
Turn your girls and - Swing Thru -
Girls Trade - Boys Trade - Turn Thru
Allemande Left with your left hand. . .

What we actually did there was to add a Right & Left Thru, then we Zeroed it out by adding the Girls Trade - Boys Trade when we did the Swing Thru. Of course there are many, many ways you can set this up. Instead of that first Right & Left Thru, you could simply have Heads Flutter Wheel - Same Four *Star Thru* - Same Four *Swing Thru - Girls Trade - Boys Trade - Then Turn Thru* Left Allemande, etc. Going just one step further - you can get the same thing working with the outside couples (sides), like this:

Heads Flutter Wheel - Star Thru
Pass Thru - Swing Thru -
Girls Trade - Boys Trade -
Turn Thru, Left Allemande.

These are very interesting set-ups to work with. Try them some time and see what I mean. You can give your dancers quite a workout with this type of calling.

We suggest dancers consult their program books for the exact hour and location.

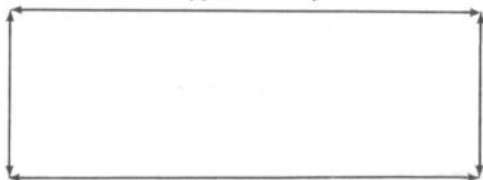
